Re: Winter 2016 Enrollment

The total headcount enrollment at the third-week census date for the winter 2016 quarter was 17,170 oncampus and 174 off-campus for a total of 17,344, which is 79 more students than were enrolled in the winter of 2015. This included 15,763 undergraduate and 1,581 graduate students.

The estimated fall-winter-spring three-quarter average FTE for the 2015-16 academic year is 17,230. Projected non-California resident FTE for tuition purposes is 1,440 (1,010 undergraduates and 430 graduates) compared to 1,107 in 2014-15 (721 undergraduate and 386 graduate and professional). Statefunded summer 2015 FTE was 736.
