



#### The majority (70%) of HAVC BA graduates had plans to pursue graduate education.




**Types of Academic Degrees**

#### **UCSC History of Art & Visual Culture BA Graduates** Most Popular Field of Future Academic Study







37% of graduates with a BA degree in HAVC reported being employed within 6 months of graduation.






#### UCSC History of Art & Visual Culture BA Graduates Employed vs Seeking Employment

Of those employed, half of HAVC BA graduates reported working in the Business sector within 6 months of graduation.






#### UCSC History of Art & Visual Culture BA Graduates Median Annual Salary

#### UCSC History of Art & Visual Culture BA Graduates Future Career Plans




More than half (60%) of HAVC BA graduates hoped to have a career in Arts, Audio/Video Technology & Communications after completing their higher education.






Over half (63%) of HAVC BA graduates reported that they plan to work in the Santa Cruz or San Francisco Bay area.

#### UCSC History of Art & Visual Culture BA Graduates When did they start looking for a job? (employed & seeking employment)



#### How many job offers did they receive?





## Of those employed, about one quarter (28%) of graduates with a BA degree in HAVC received at least two job offers.




#### UCSC History of Art & Visual Culture BA Graduates Internships
