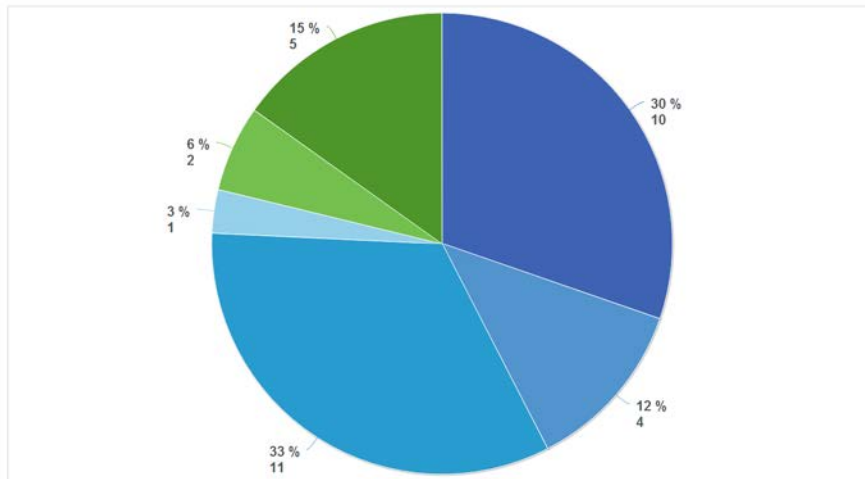


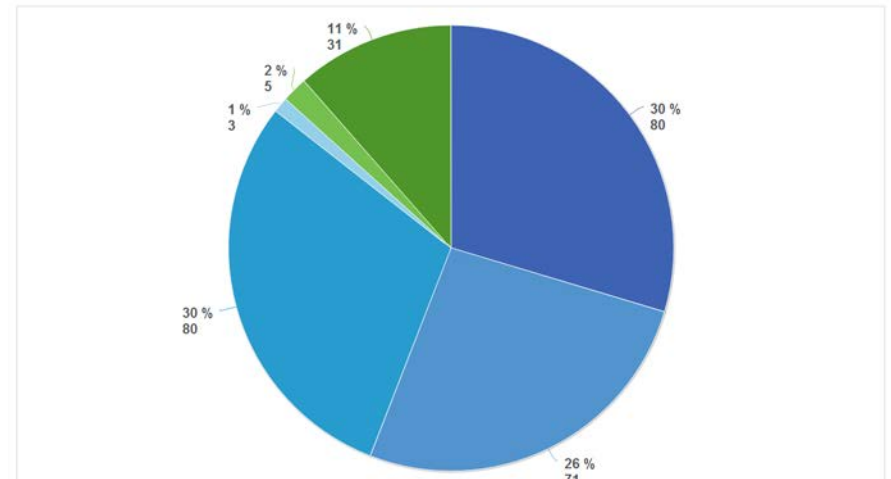
# UCSC Computer Engineering BS Graduates

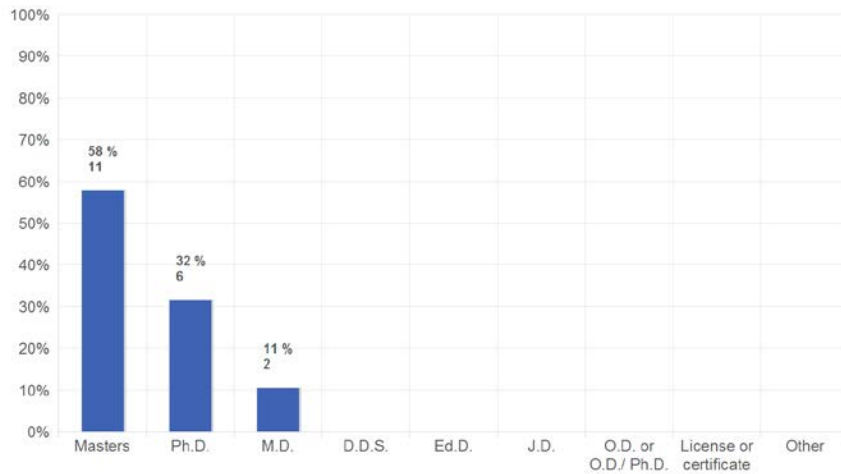

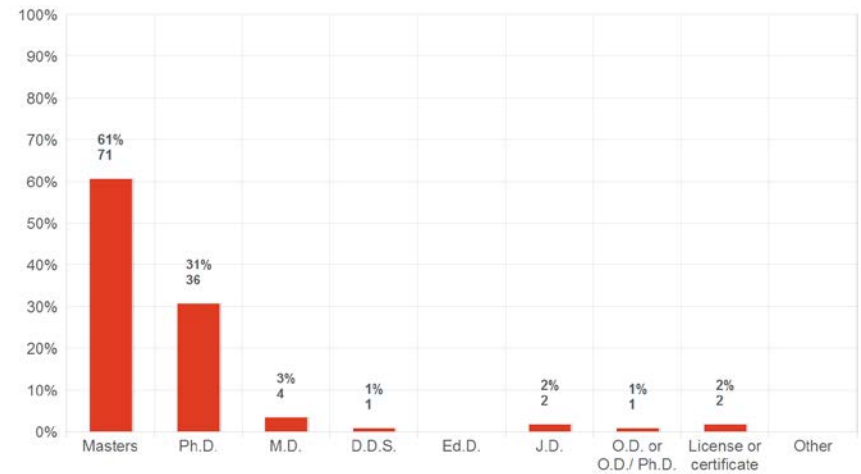
57% of Computer Engineering BS degree graduates had plans to pursue graduate education.

## Types of Academic Degrees



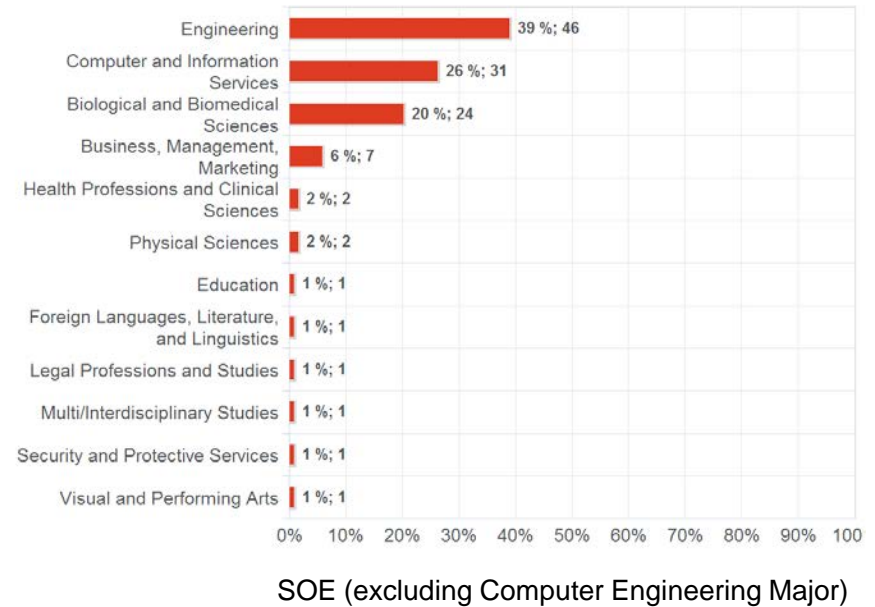
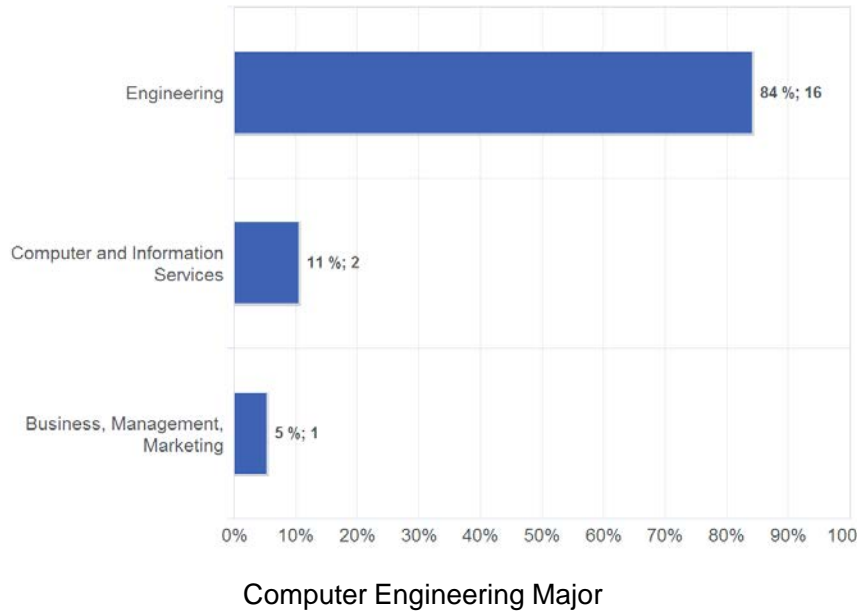

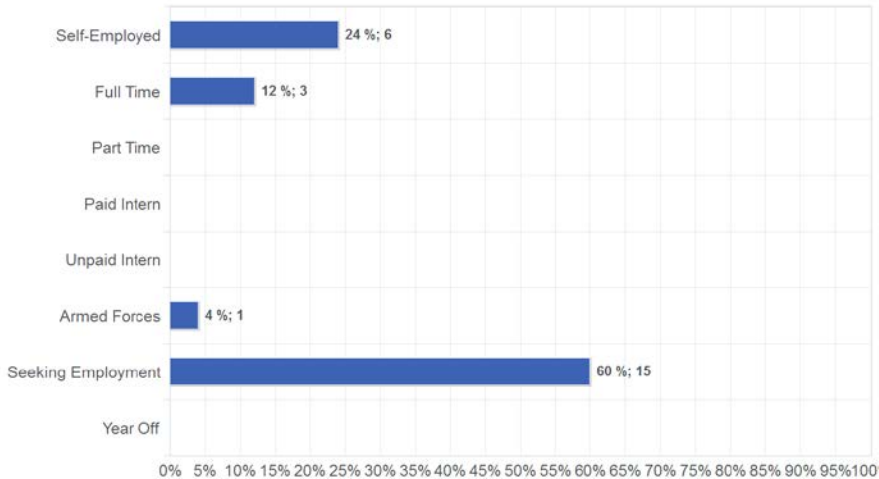
The vast majority (90%) of graduates with a Computer Engineering Major plan to obtain either a Masters degree or PhD.

# UCSC Computer Engineering BS Graduates Most Popular Field of Future Academic Study



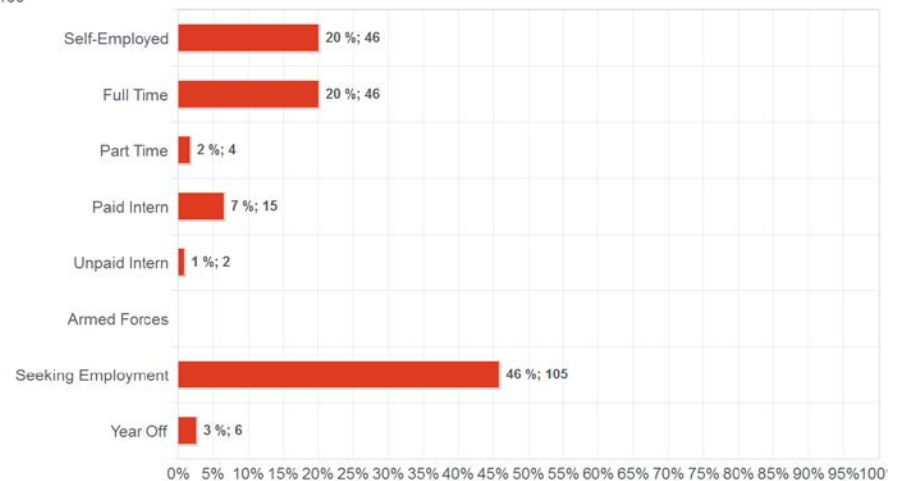
Computer Engineering BS graduates were interested in pursuing advanced degrees in several fields, the most popular of which were related to Engineering (84%).

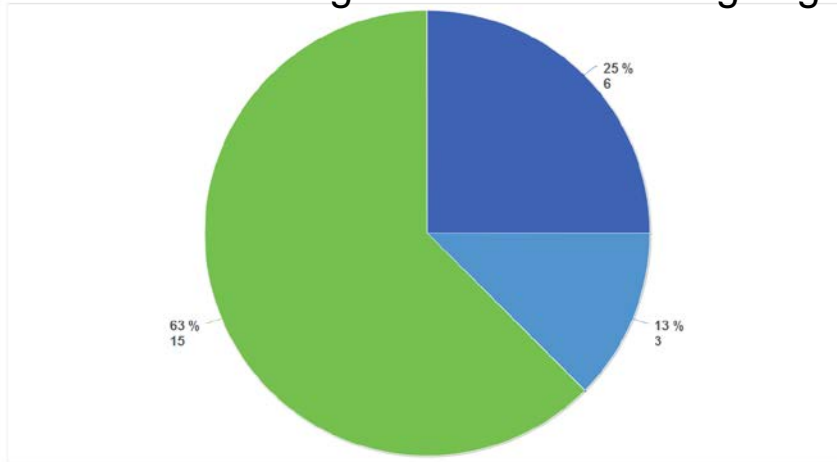
36% of graduates with a BS degree in Computer Engineering reported being employed full-time within 6 months of graduation.



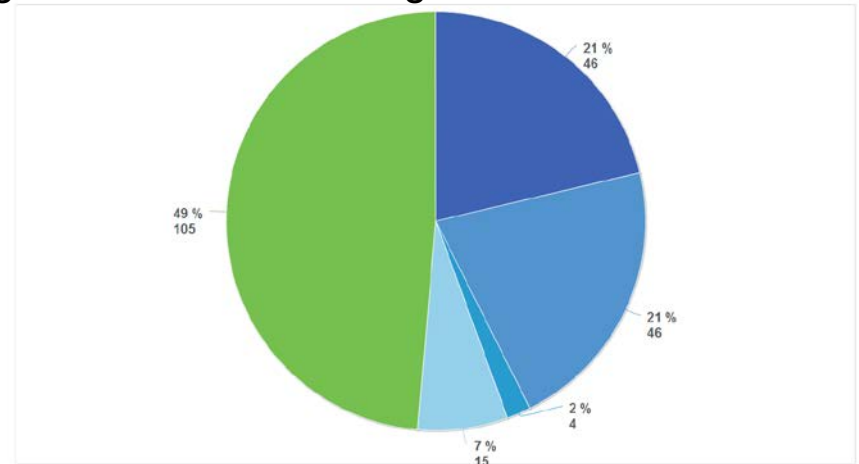

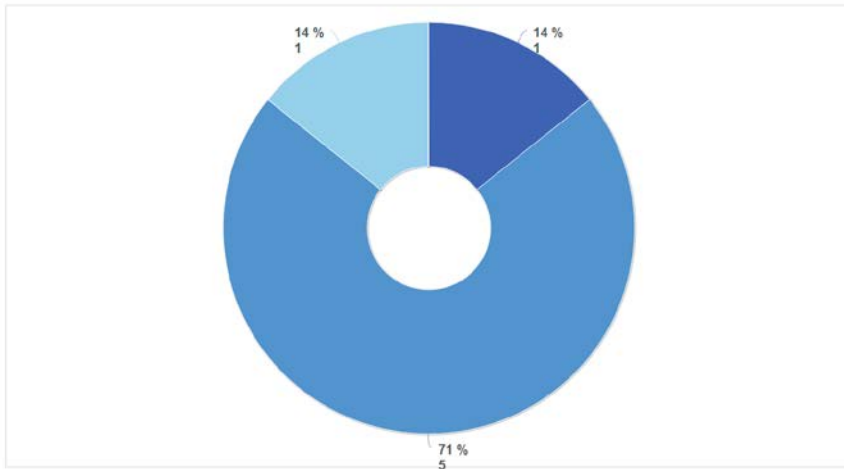

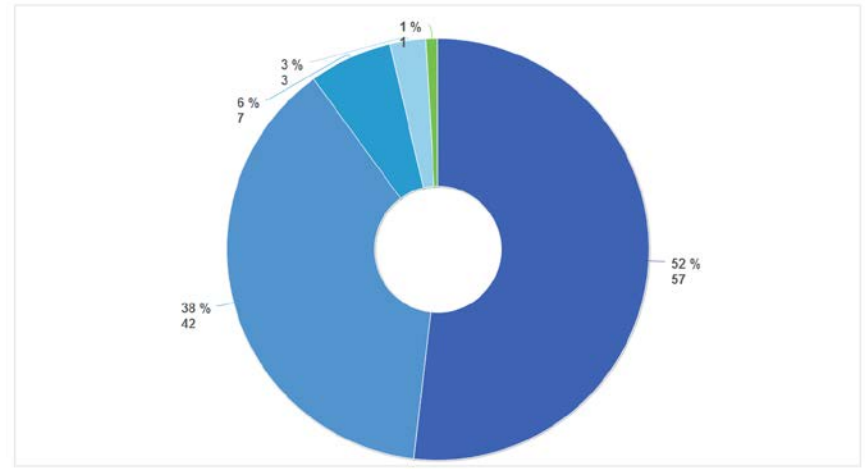


38% Computer Engineering BS graduates reported being employed than seeking employment within 6 months of graduation.

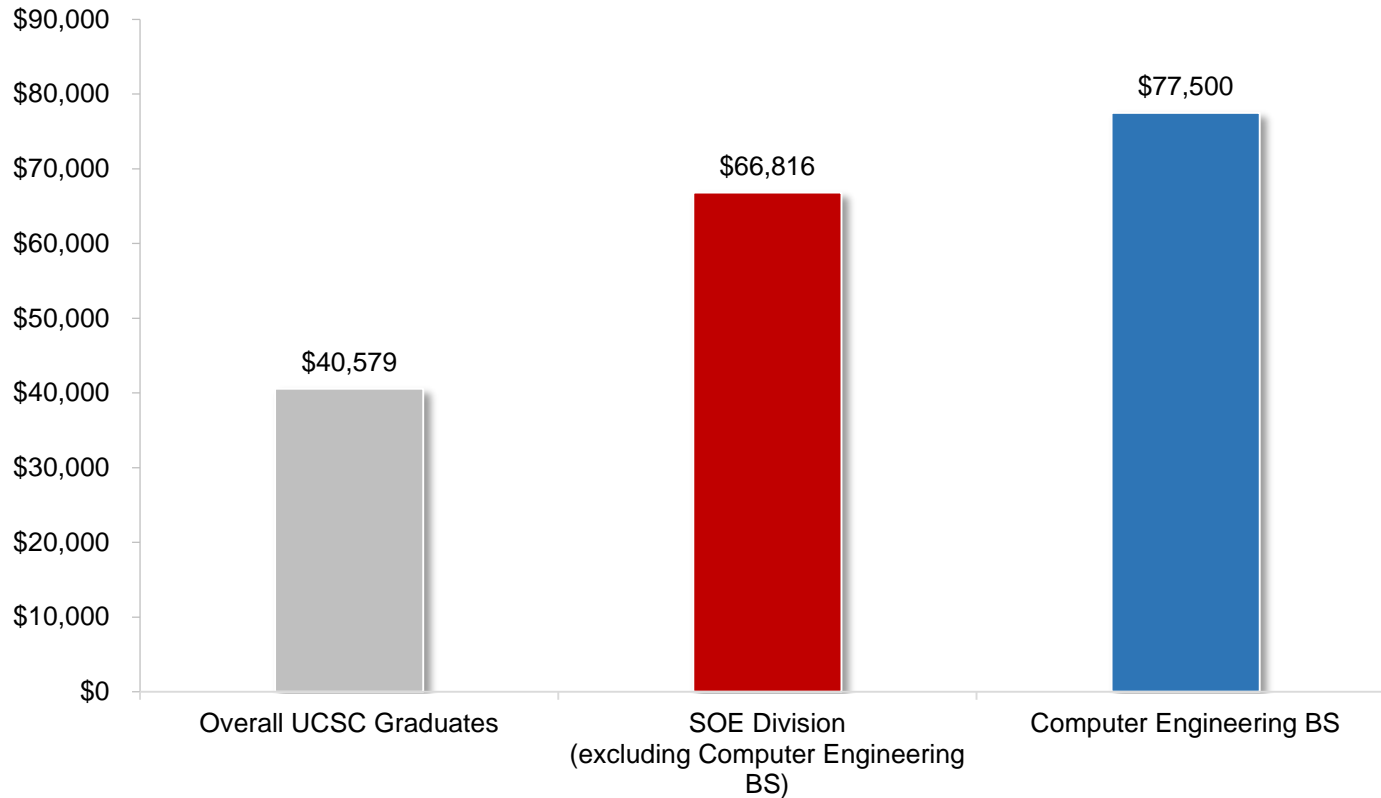
Of those employed, BS Computer Engineering graduates primarily reported working in the Industry/Manufacturing (71%) sector within 6 months of graduation.

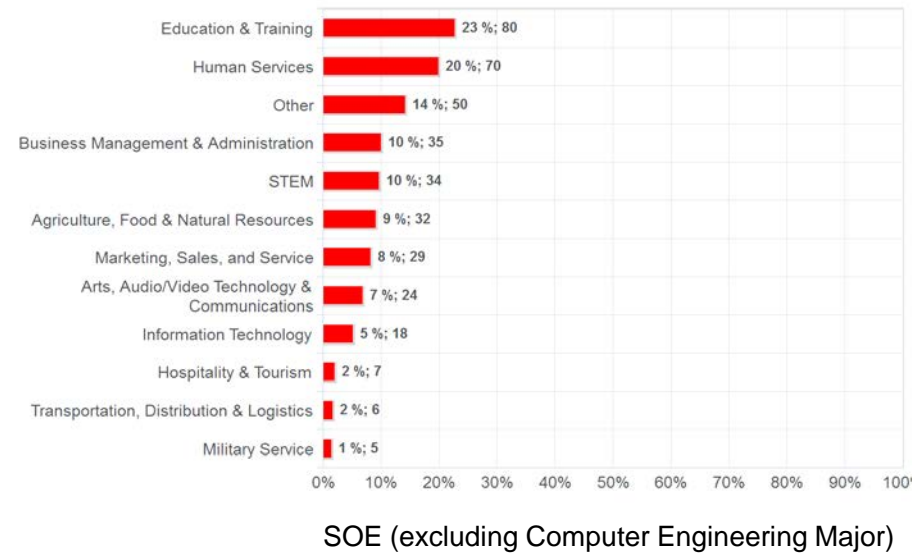
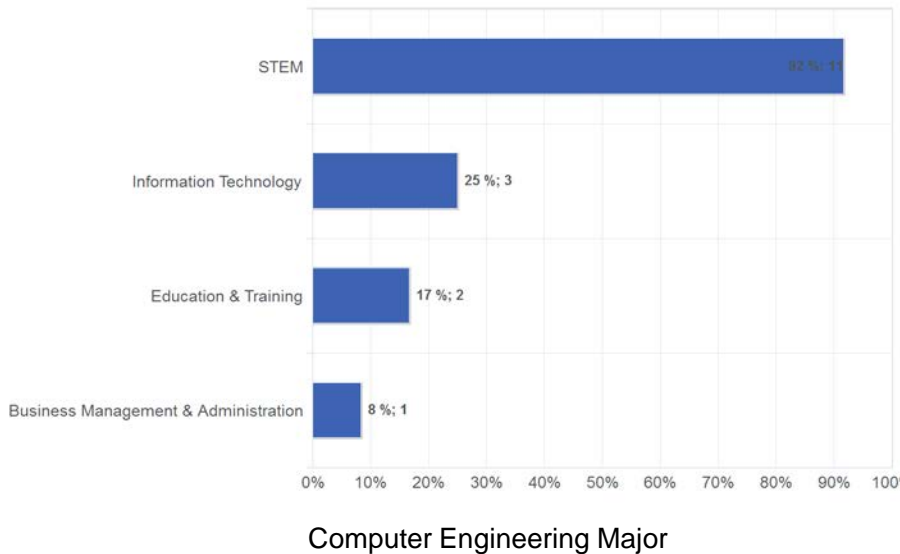
# UCSC Computer Engineering BS Graduates Median Annual Salary



Fifty percent of graduates with a BS degree in Computer Engineering reported earning \$77,500 annually or higher within 6 months of graduation.



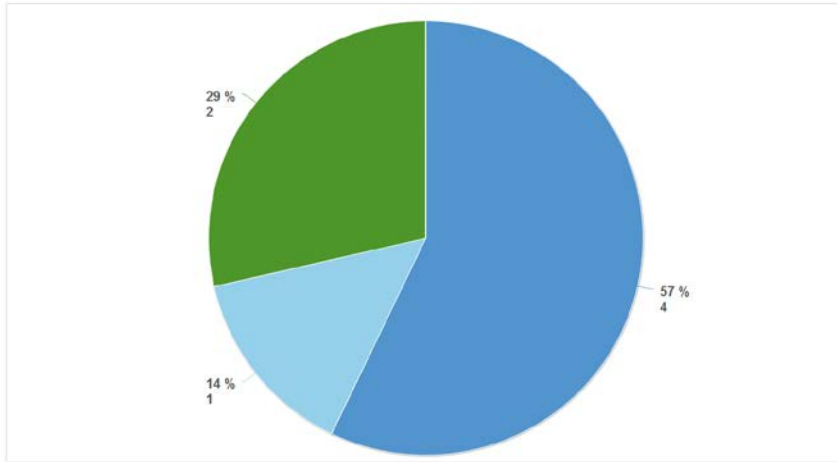
# UCSC Computer Engineering BS Graduates Future Career Plans



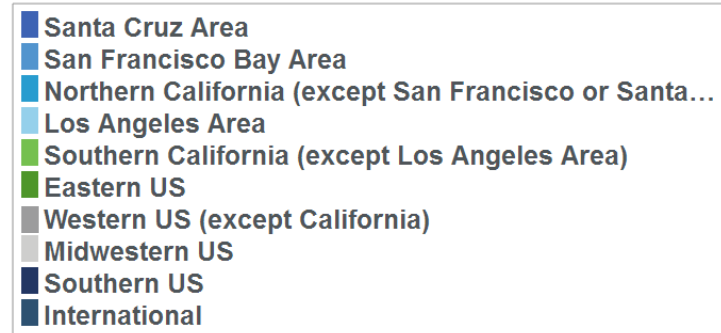
The vast majority (92%) of Computer Engineering BS graduates hoped to have a career in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, & Math) after completing their education.

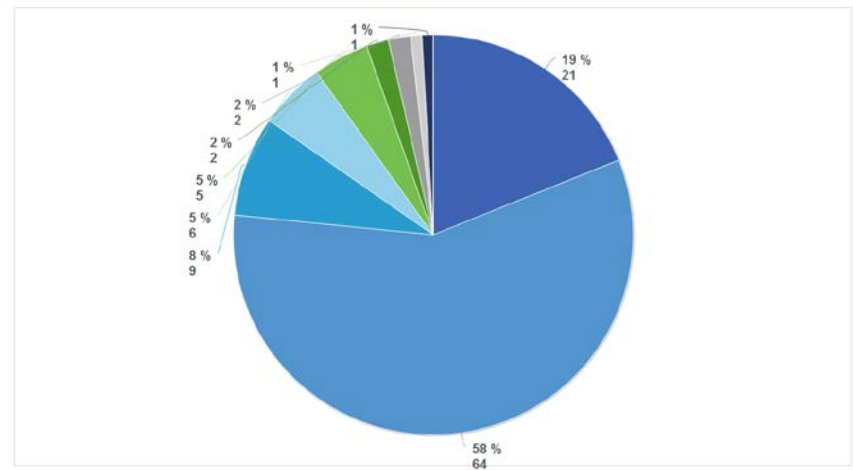
## Geographic destinations of those with a job

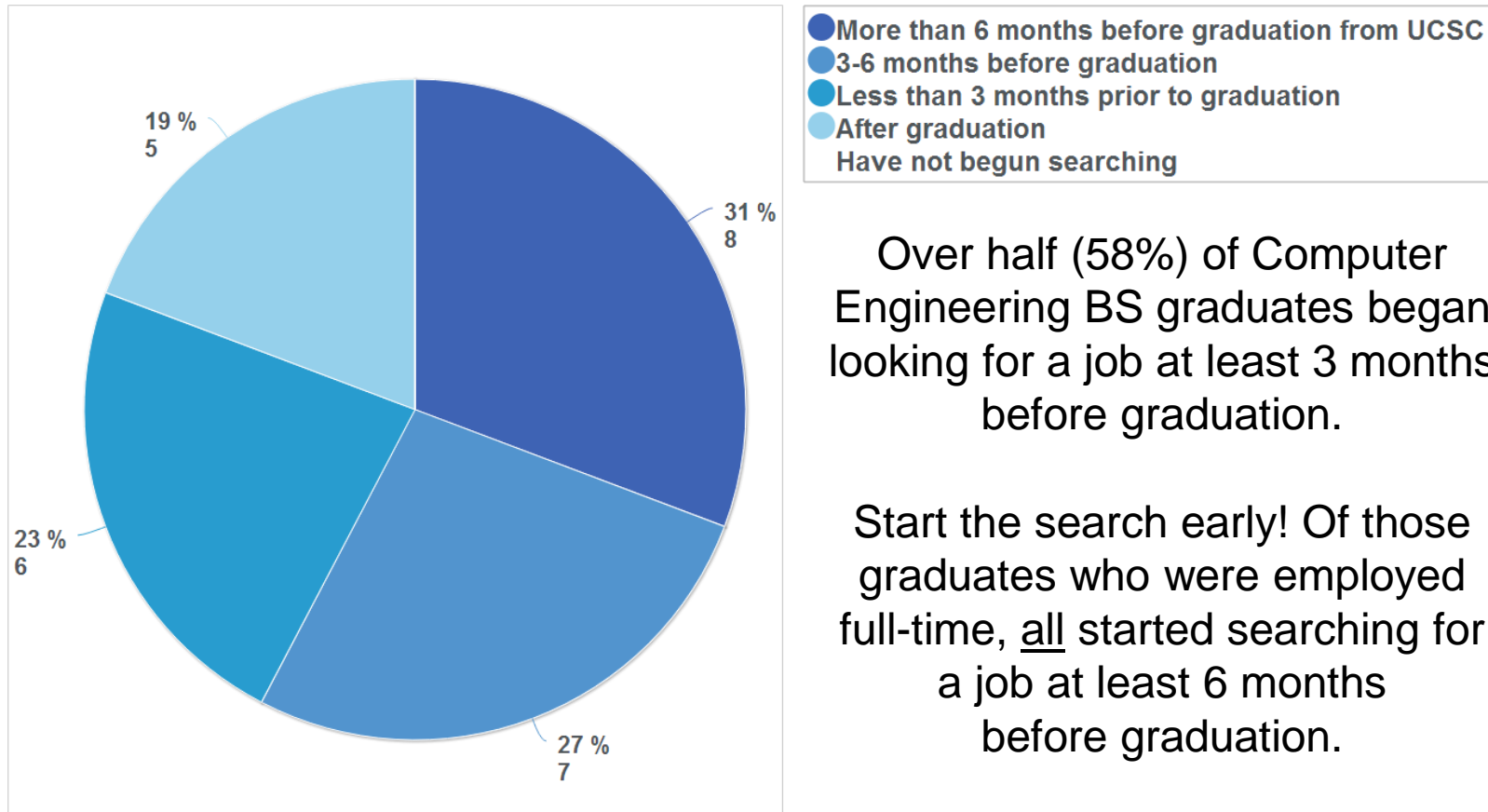
More than half (57%) of Computer Engineering BS graduates reported that they plan to work in the San Francisco Bay Area.

When did they start looking for a job? (employed & seeking employment)

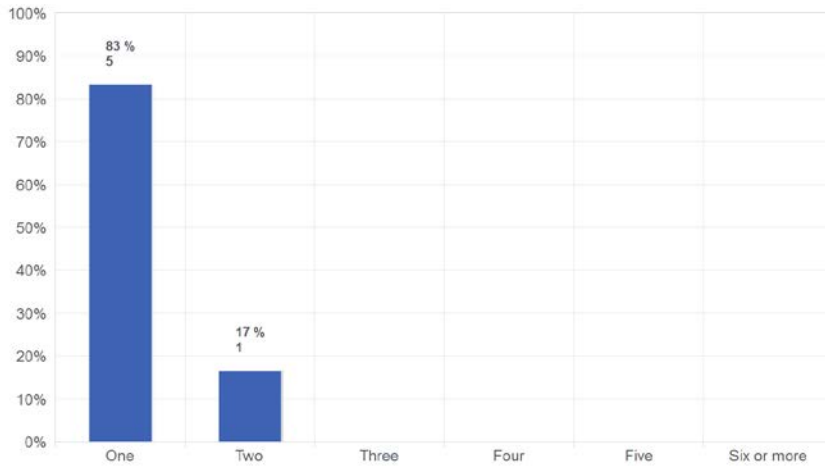


Over half (58%) of Computer Engineering BS graduates began looking for a job at least 3 months before graduation.

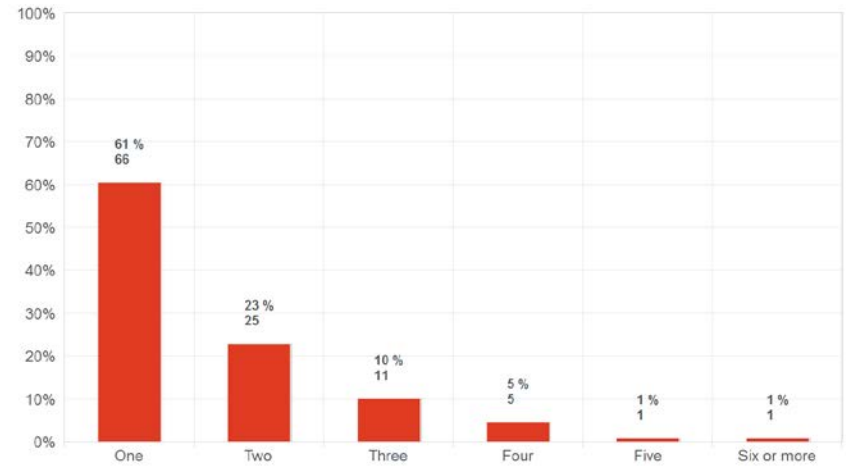
Start the search early! Of those graduates who were employed full-time, all started searching for a job at least 6 months before graduation.

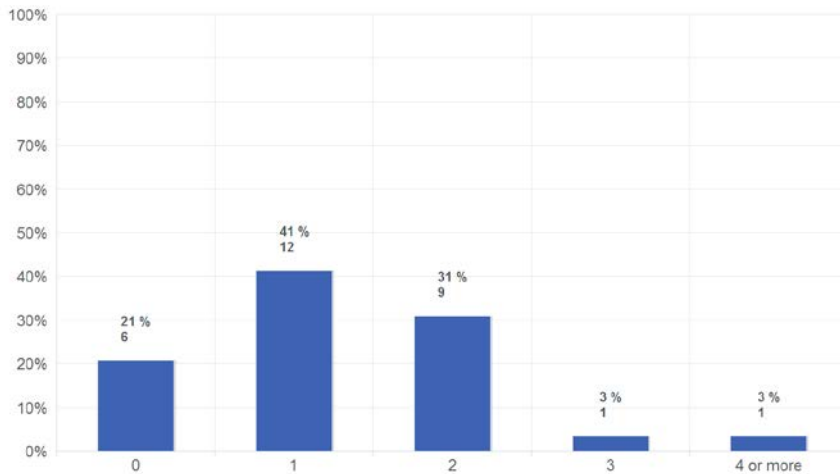
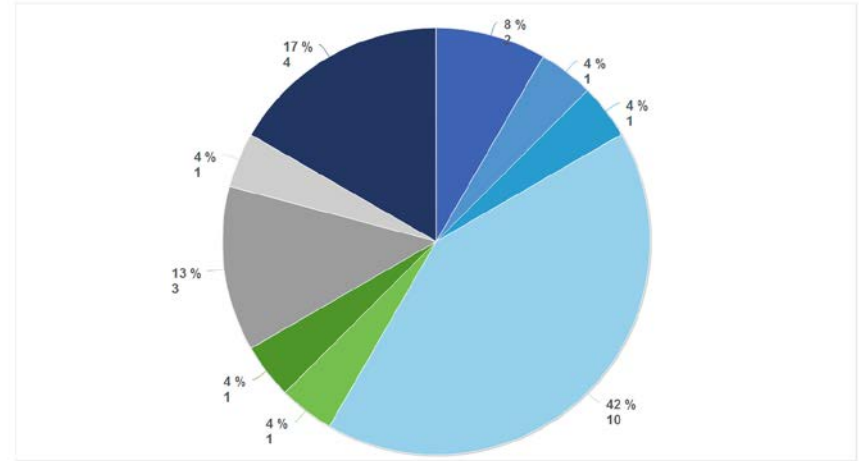

# UCSC Computer Engineering BS Graduates Internships

Nearly half (42%) of graduates reported that they found their internship by networking with personal contacts.
