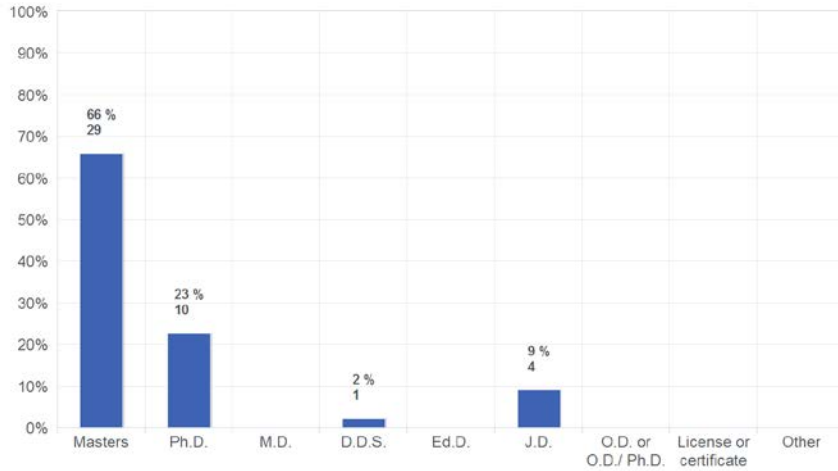

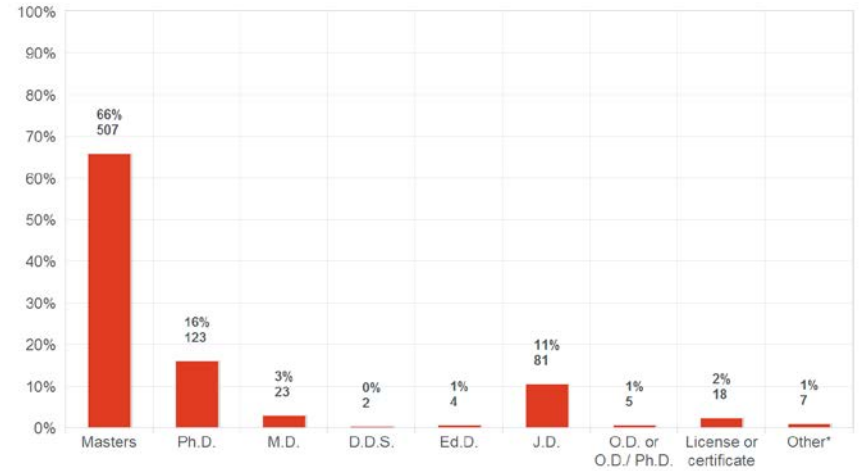
More than half (58%) of Economics BA degree graduates had plans to pursue graduate education.

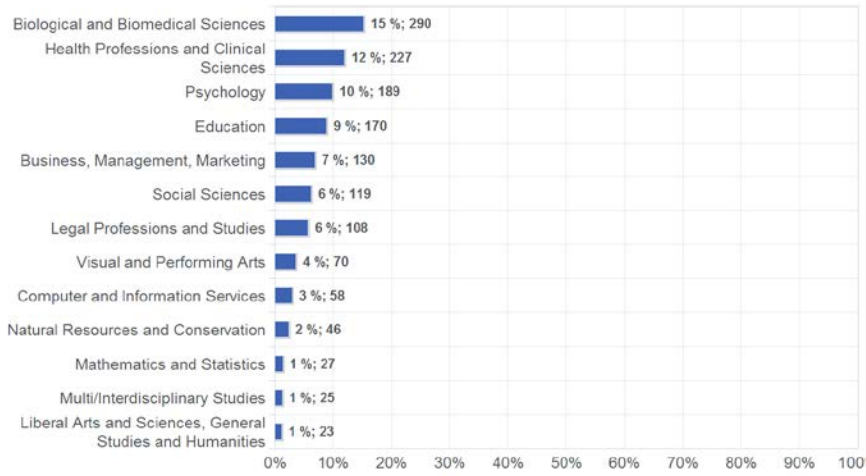

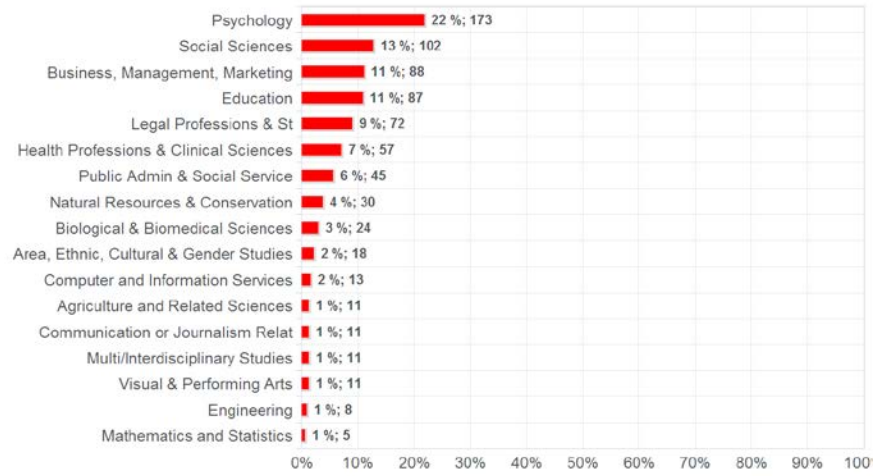
The vast majority (89%) of graduates with a Economics Major plan to obtain either a Masters degree or PhD.

Most Popular Field of Future Academic Study



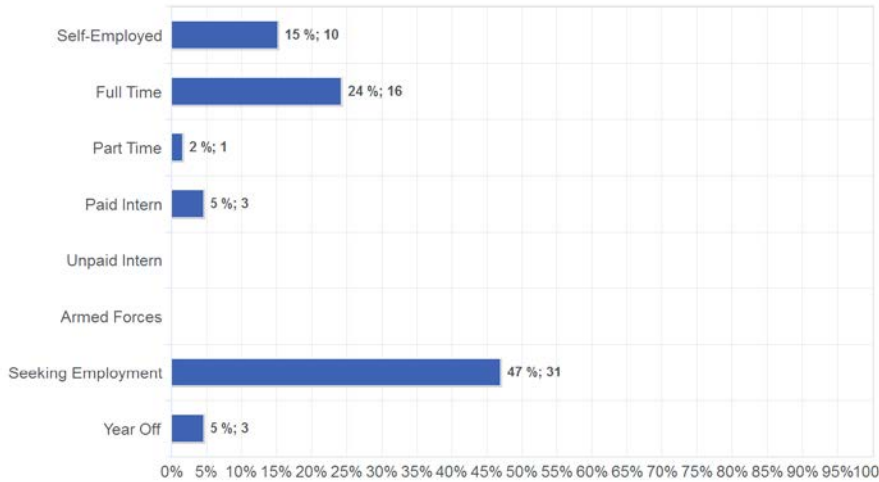

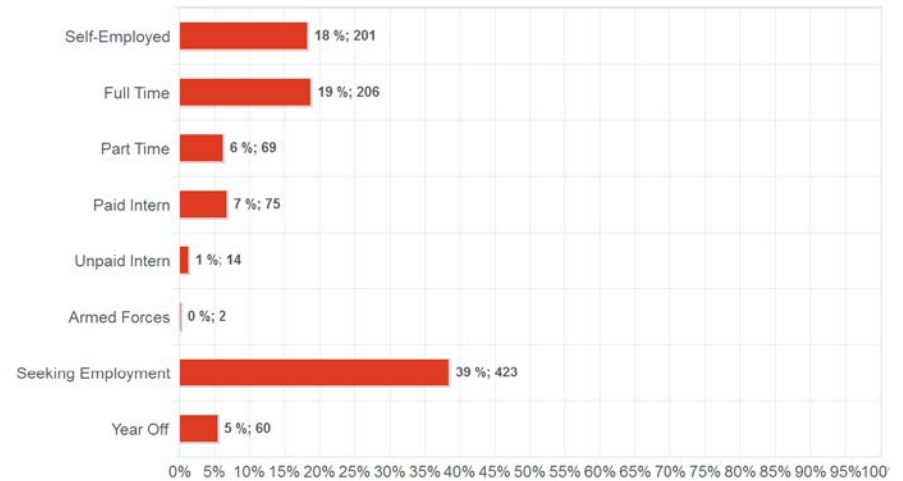

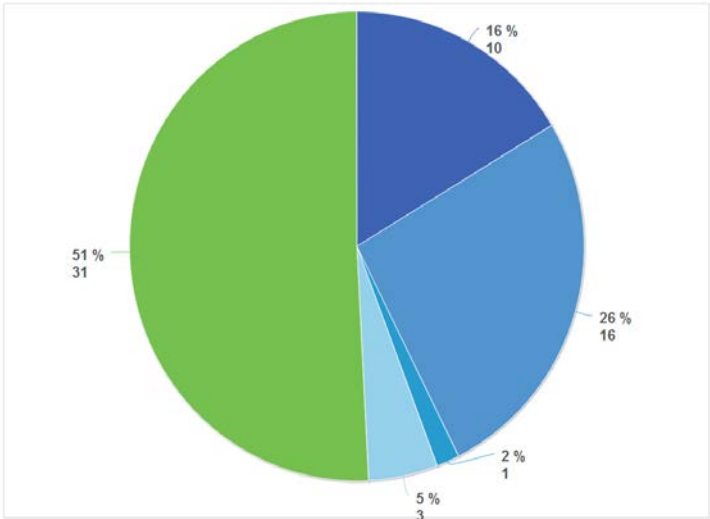
46% of graduates with a BA degree in Economics reported being employed within 6 months of graduation.



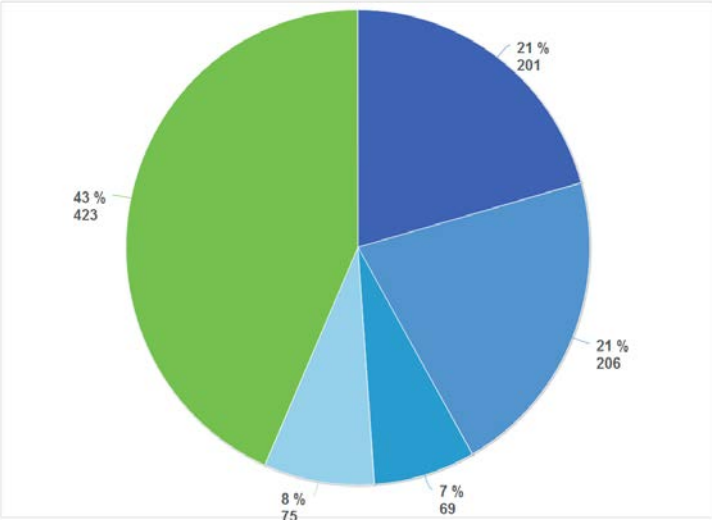

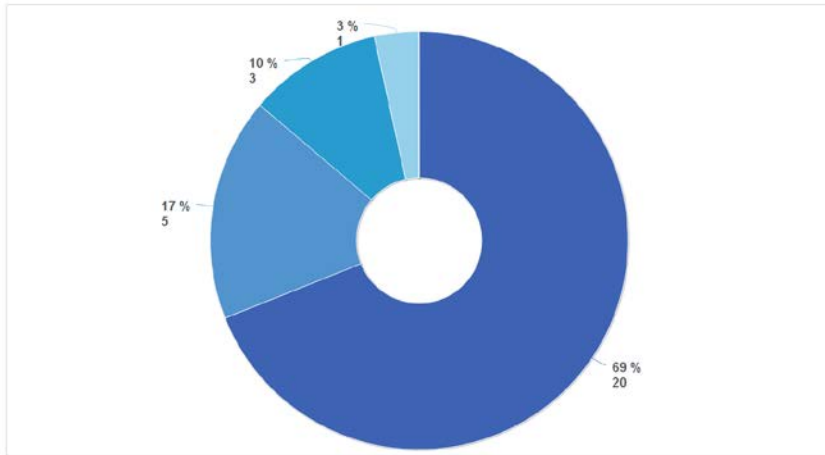

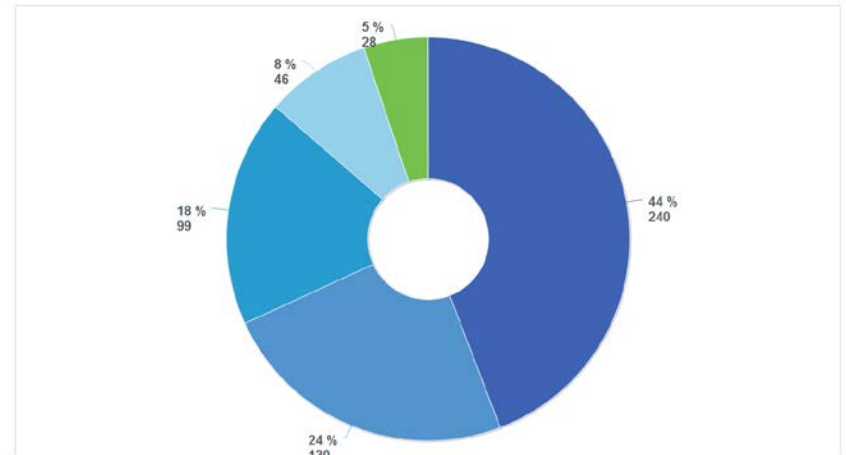
Nearly half (49%) of Economics BA graduates reported being employed than within 6 months of graduation.

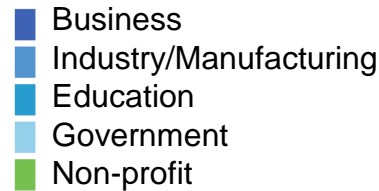
Sectors where students were employed

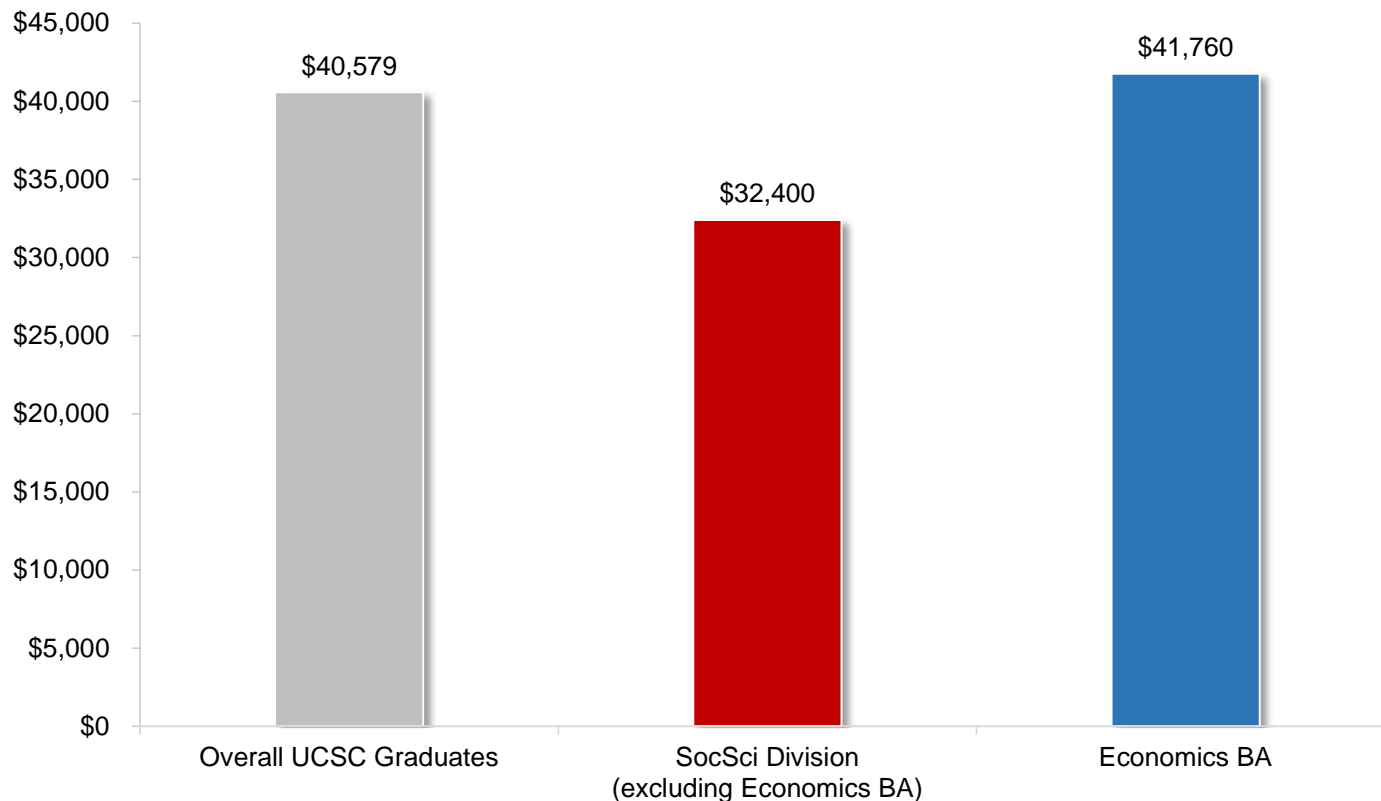
Of those employed, the majority (69%) of Economics BA graduates reported working in the Business sector within 6 months of graduation.

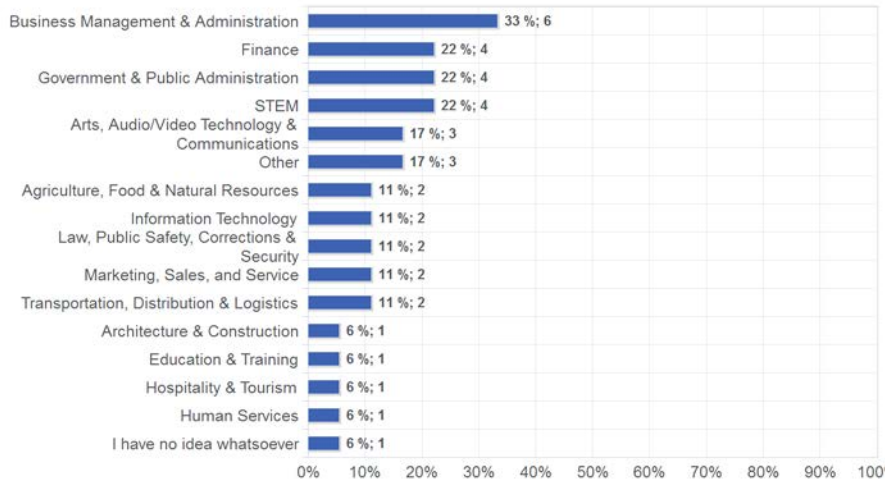


UCSC Economics BA Graduates Median Annual Salary

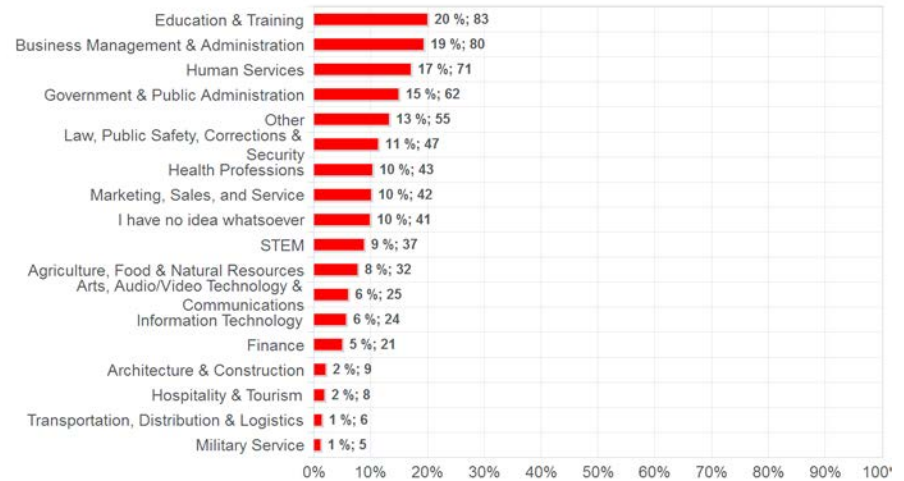


Fifty percent of graduates with a BA degree in Economics reported earning \$41,760 annually or higher within 6 months of graduation.

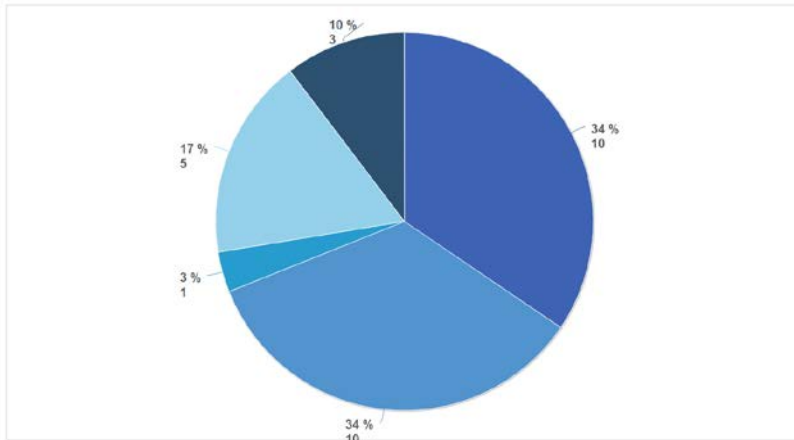

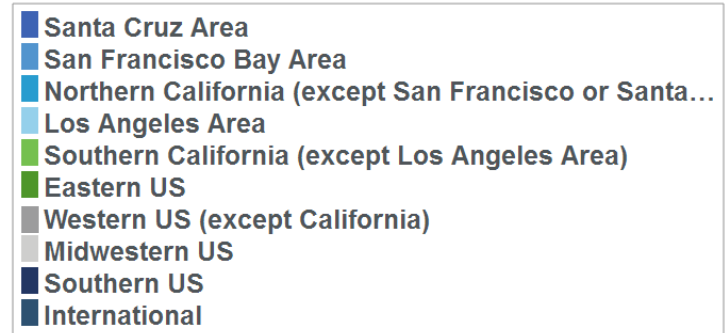
33% of Economics BA graduates hoped to have a career in Business Management & Administration after completing their education.

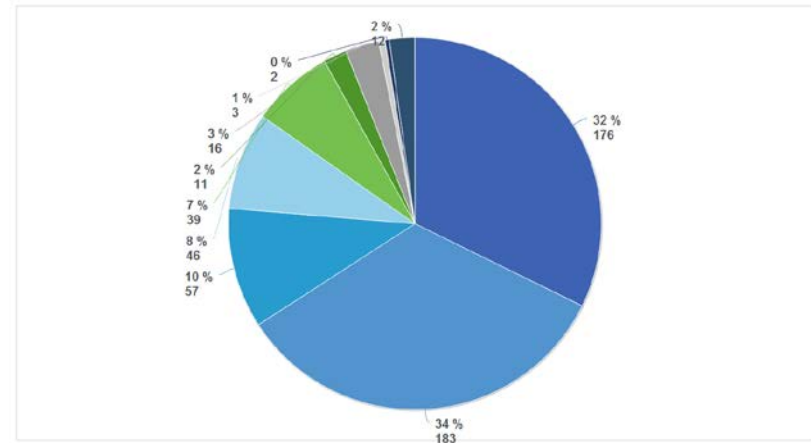
Geographic destinations of those with a job

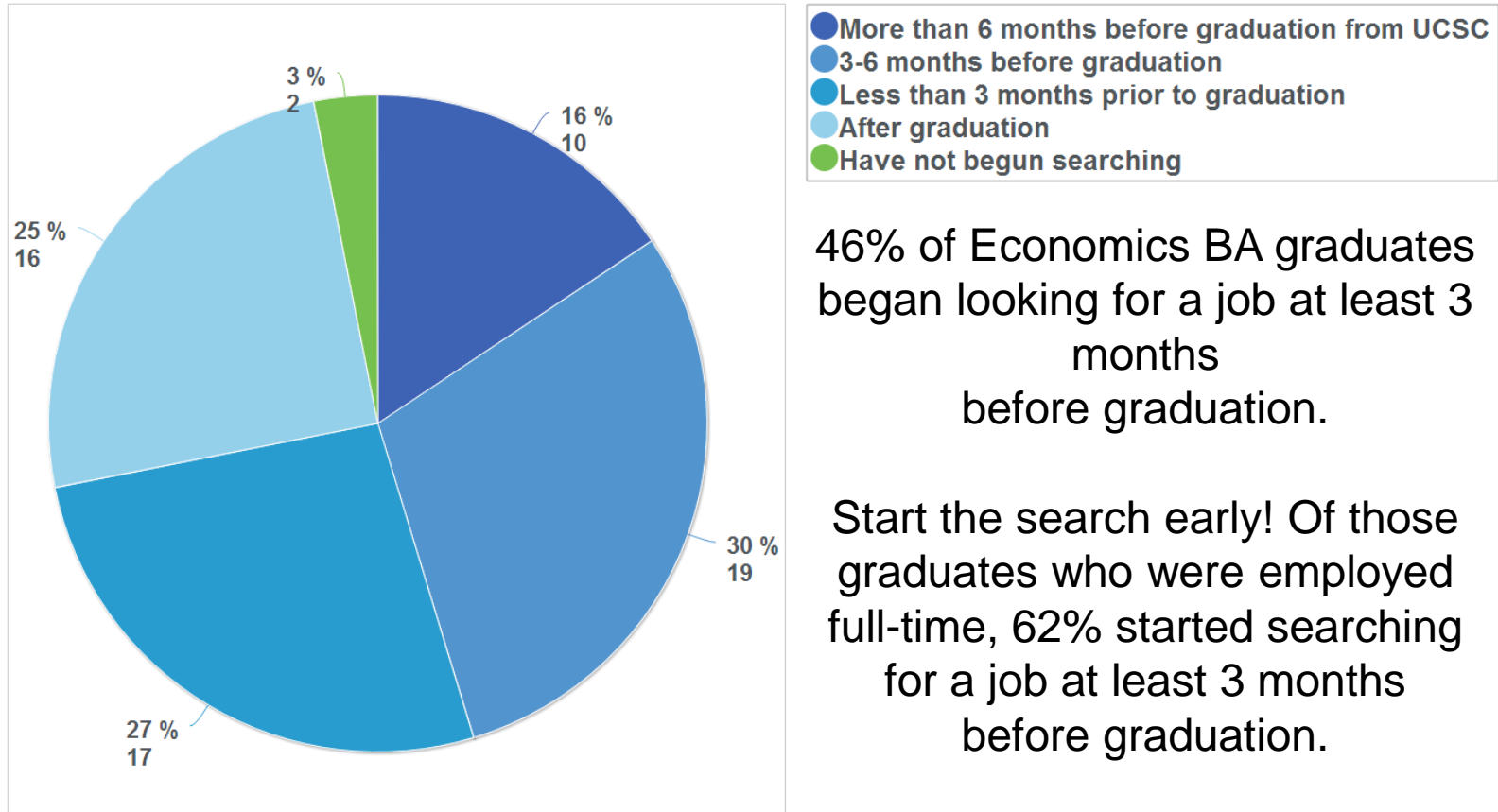
The majority (68%) of Economics BA graduates reported that they plan to work in the Santa Cruz or San Francisco Bay Area.

When did they start looking for a job? (employed & seeking employment)

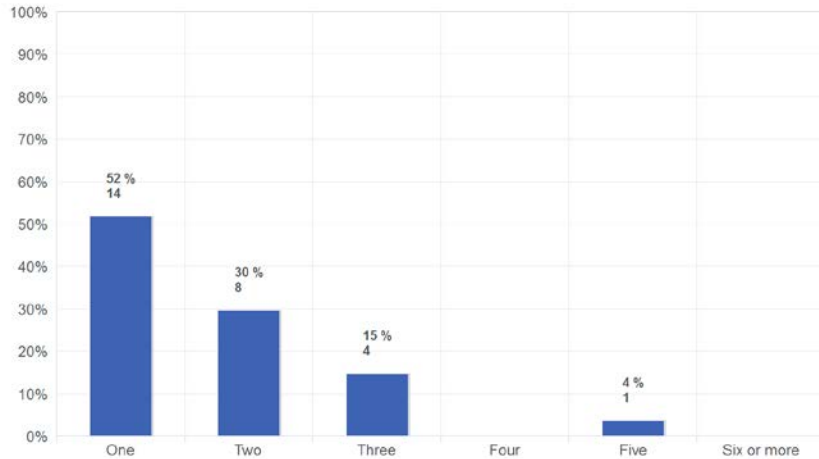


46% of Economics BA graduates began looking for a job at least 3 months before graduation.

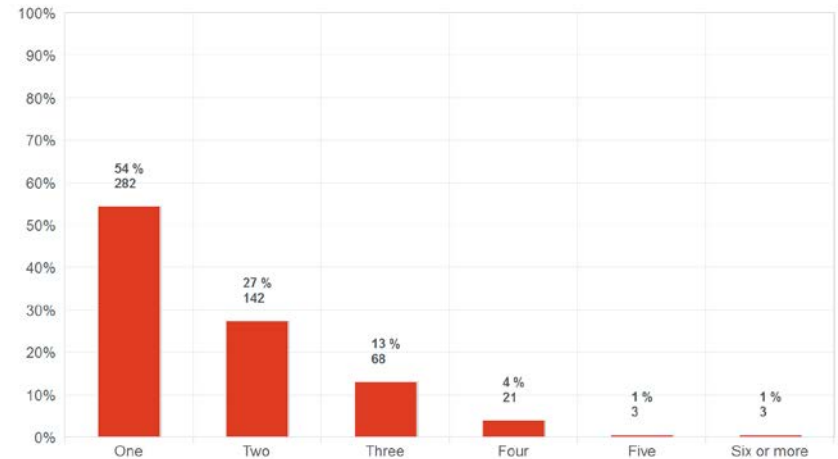
Start the search early! Of those graduates who were employed full-time, 62% started searching for a job at least 3 months before graduation.

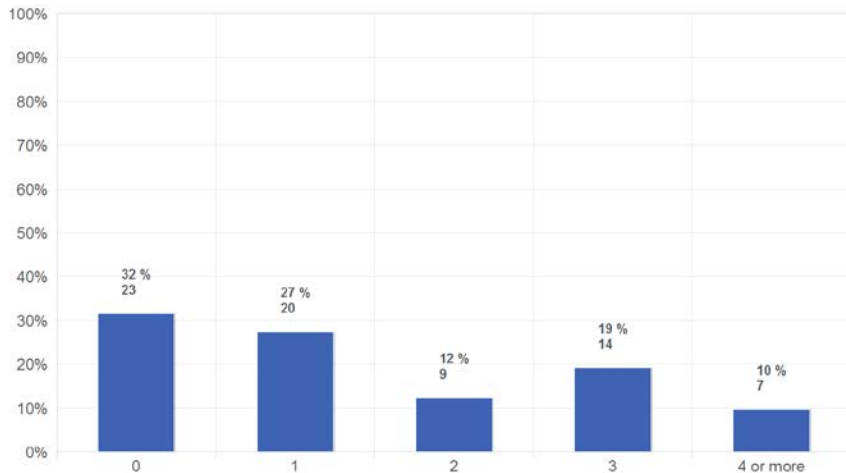
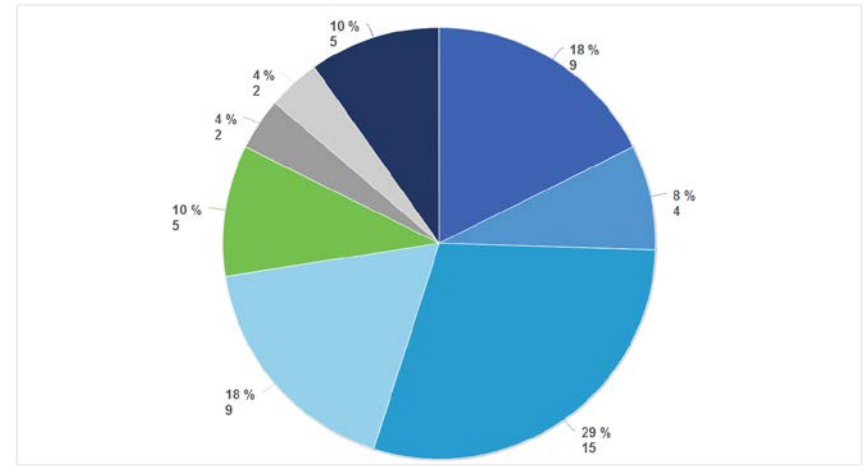

65% of graduates reported that they found their internship either by using SlugQuest, networking with UCSC or personal contacts.
