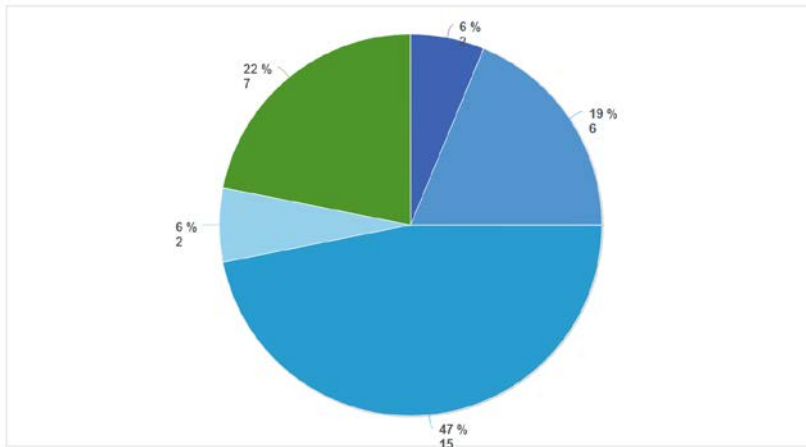


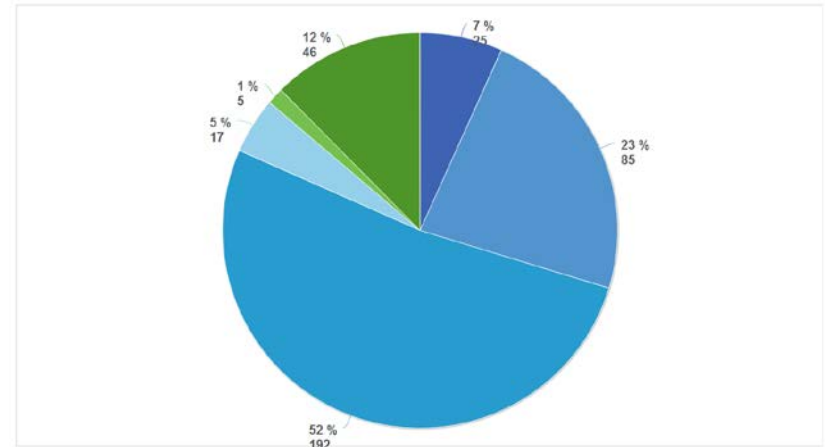
# UCSC Feminist Studies BA Graduates

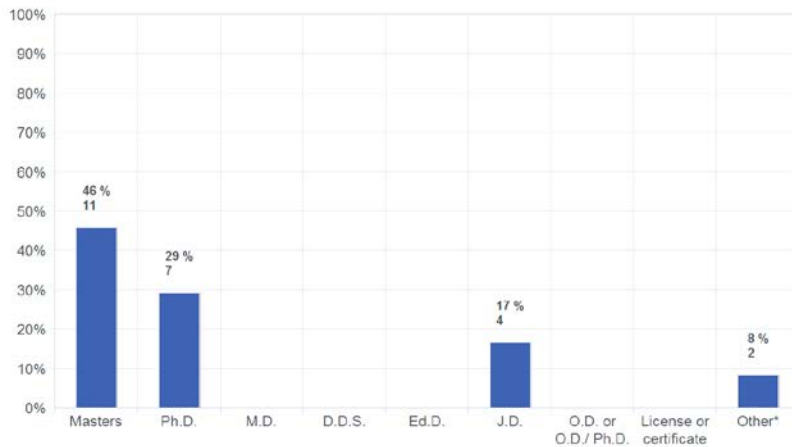

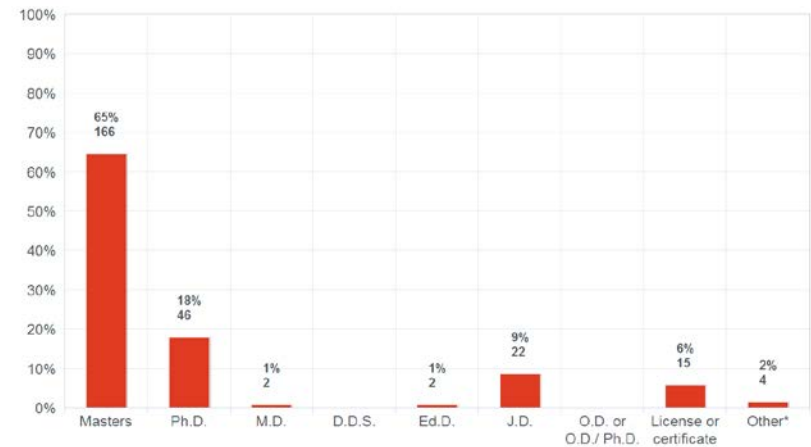
3 out of 4 (75%) of Feminist Studies BA graduates planned to pursue graduate education.

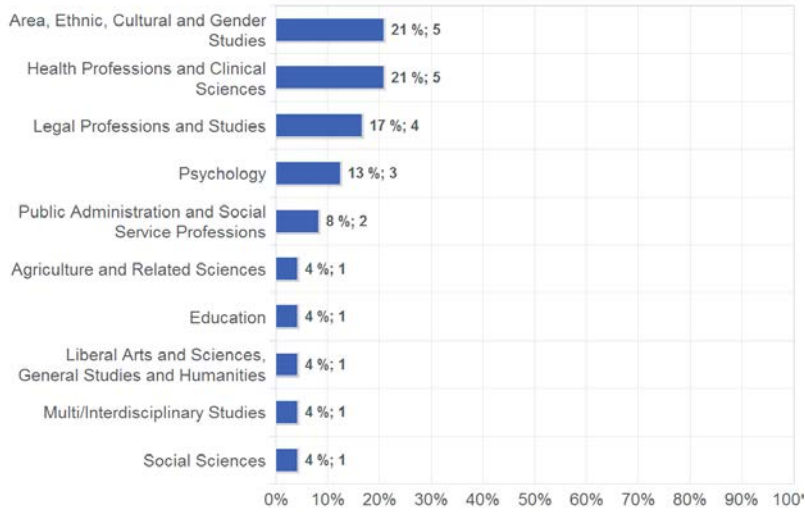

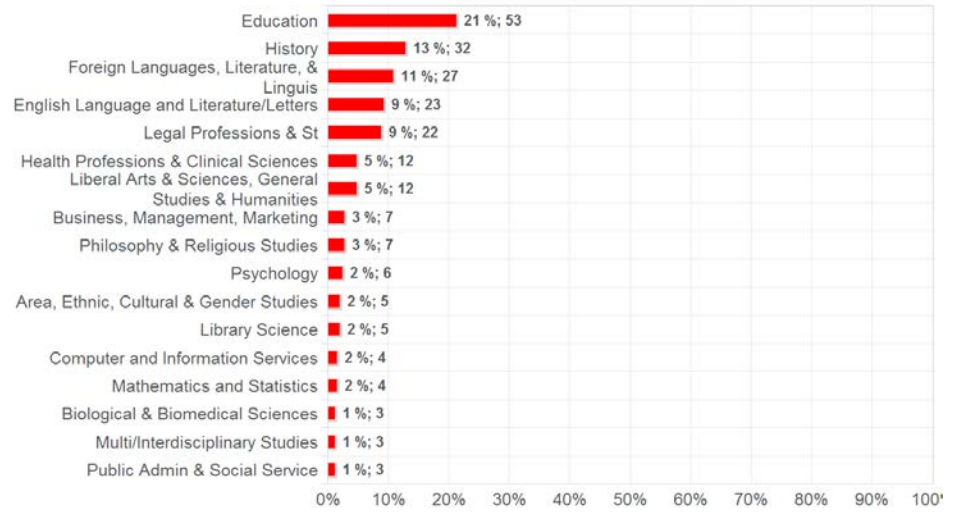
The majority of graduates with an Feminist Studies degree (75%) planned to obtain a Masters degree or PhD.

## Most Popular Field of Future Academic Study



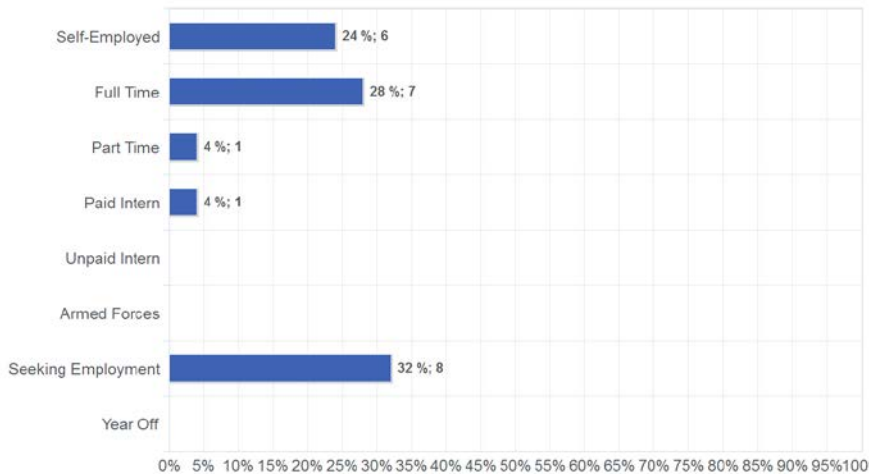

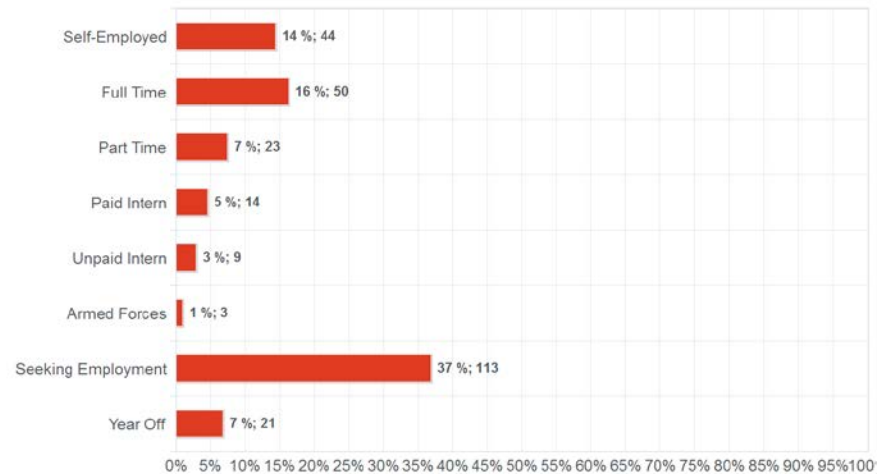

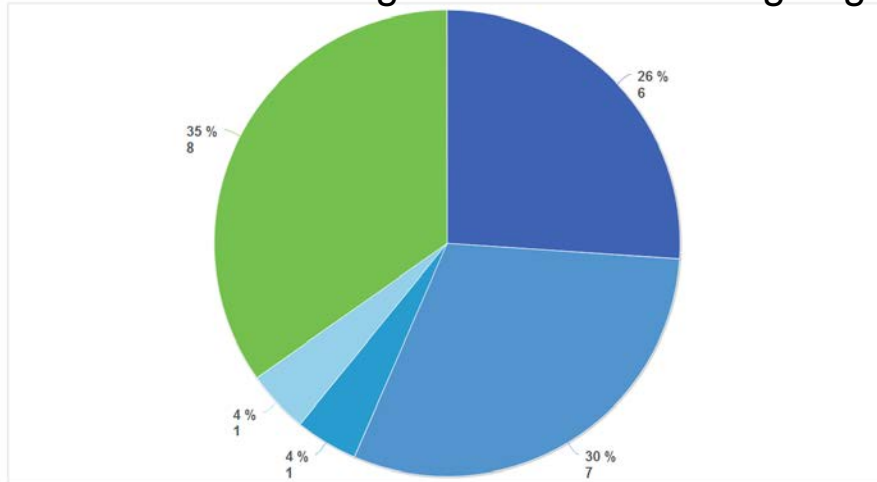
Two out of five graduates with a BA degree in Feminist Studies reported being employed within 6 months of graduation.



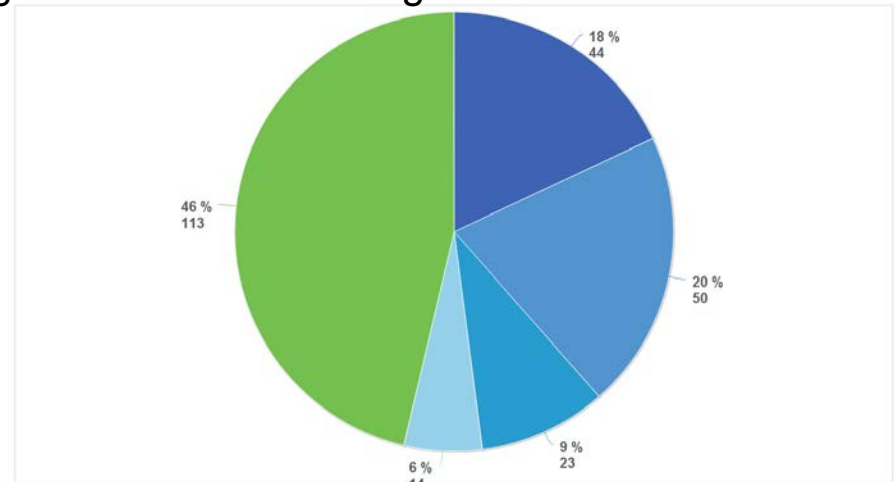

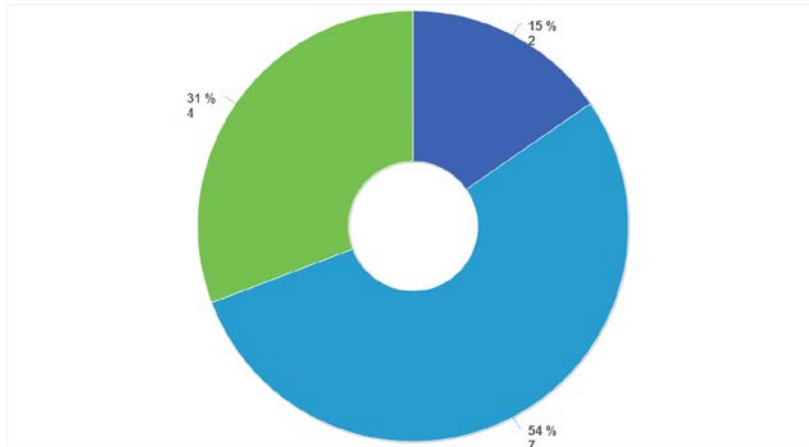

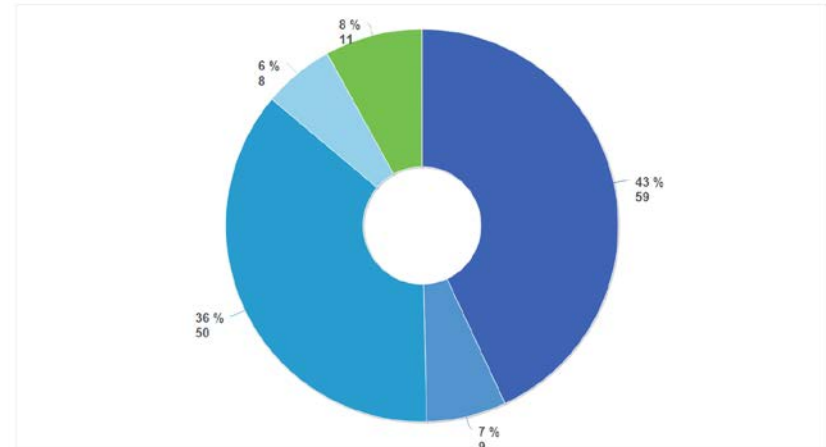
More graduates with a BA degree in Feminist Studies were employed than seeking employment 6 months after graduation.



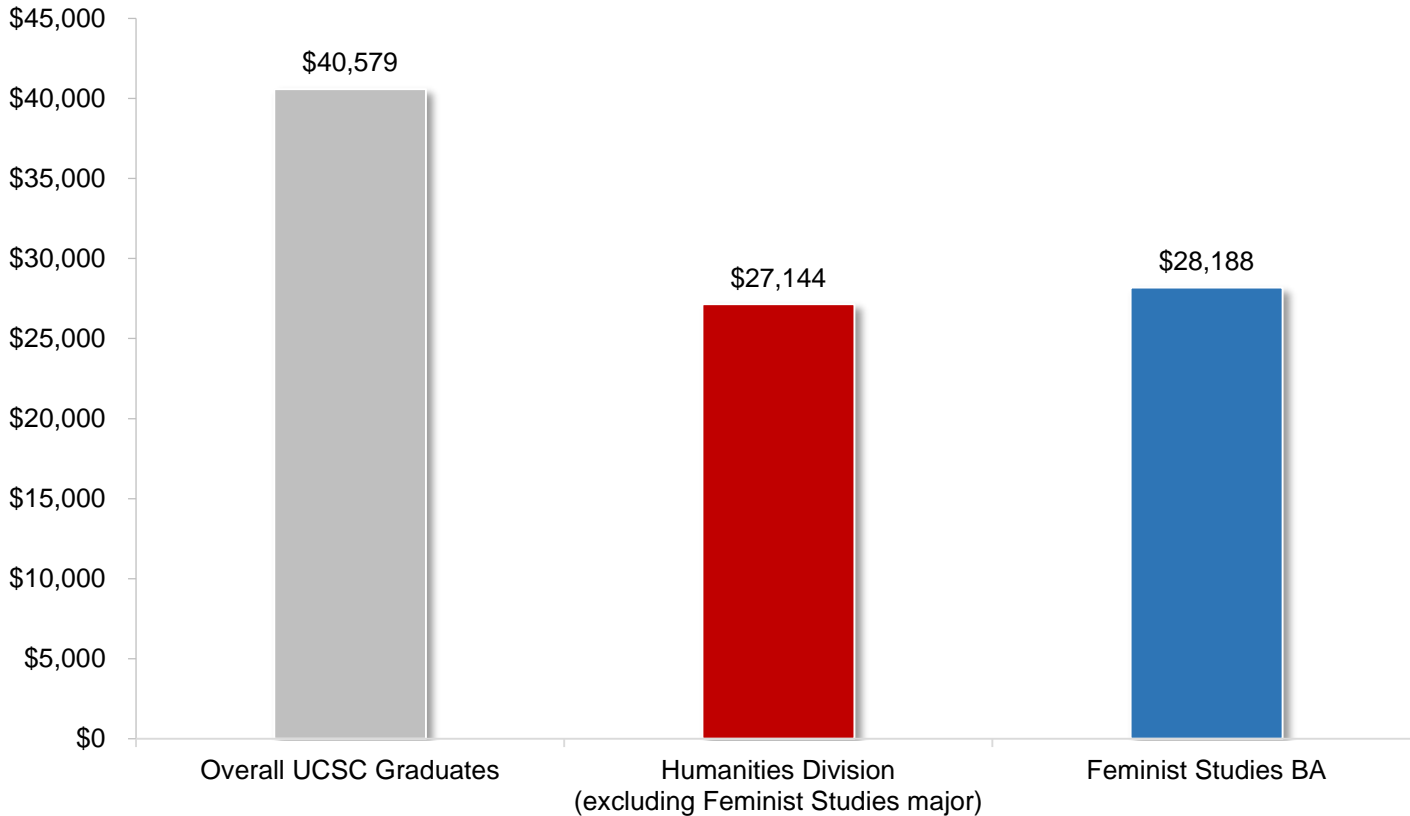

# UCSC Feminist Studies BA Graduates Median Annual Salary

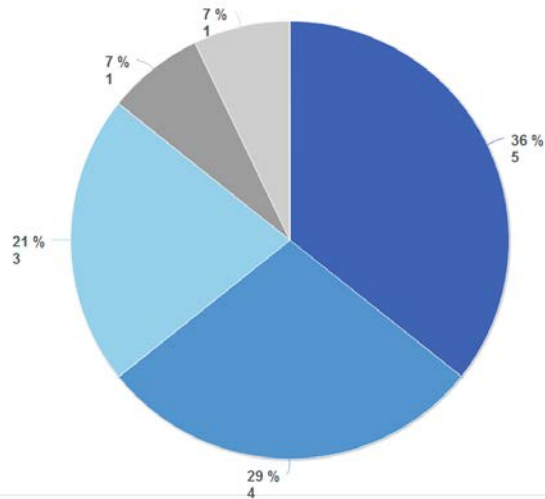


Half of graduates with a BA degree in Feminist Studies reported earning \$28,188 annually or higher within 6 months of graduation.

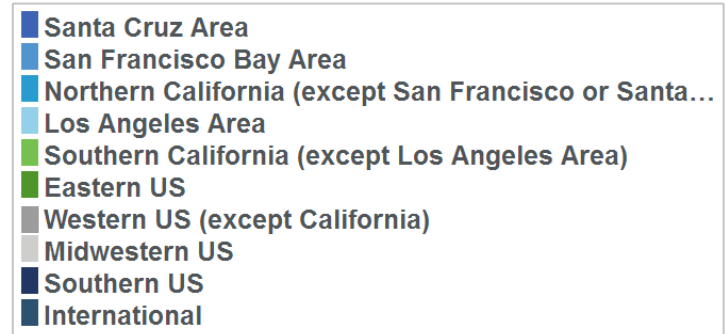

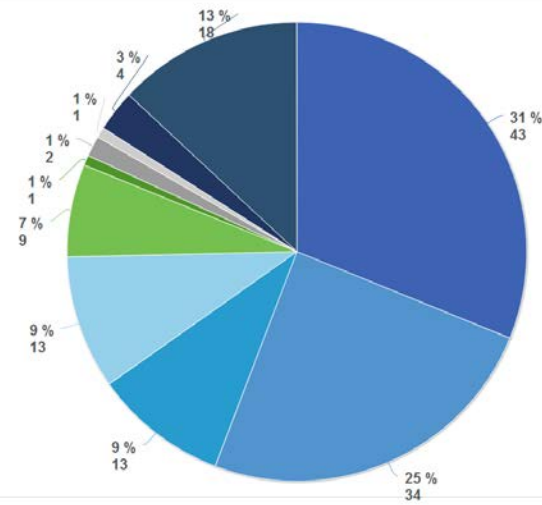
## Geographic destinations for those with jobs

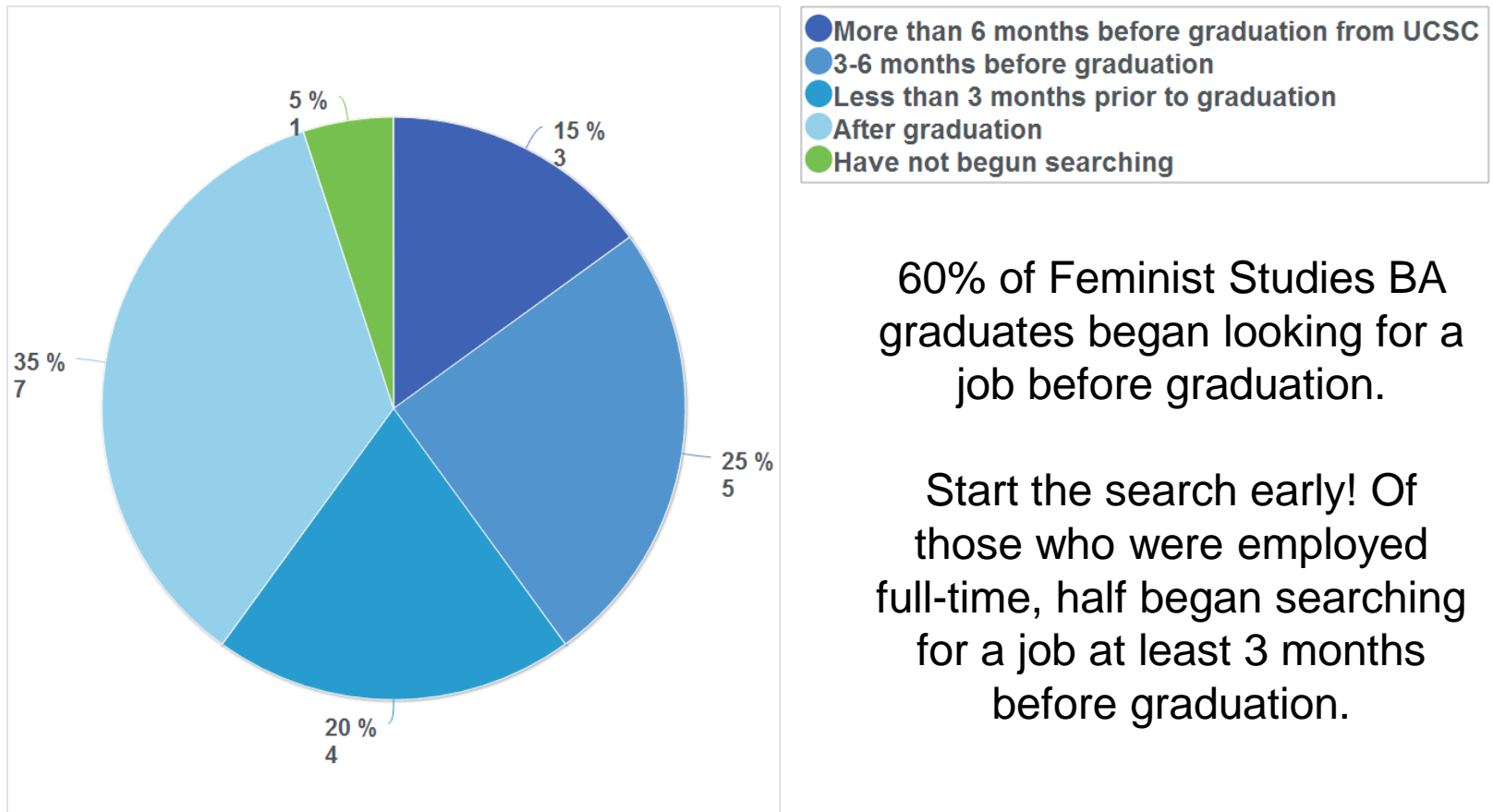
Two-thirds (65%) of Feminist Studies BA graduates planned to work in the Santa Cruz or San Francisco Bay Area.

When did they start looking for a job? (employed & seeking employment)

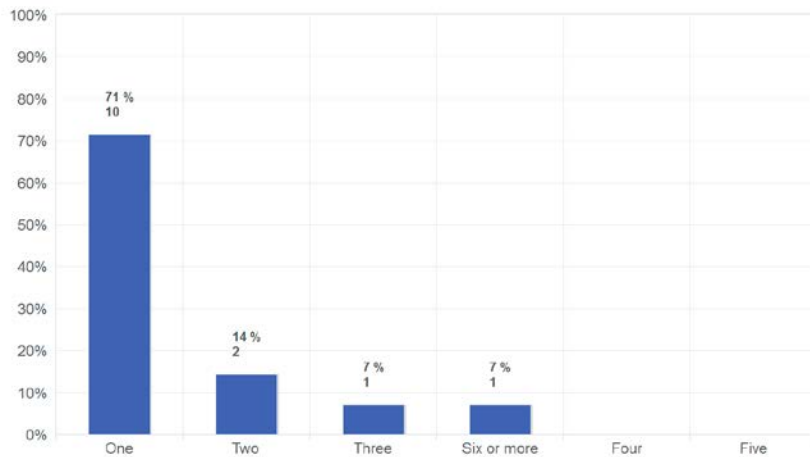


60% of Feminist Studies BA graduates began looking for a job before graduation.

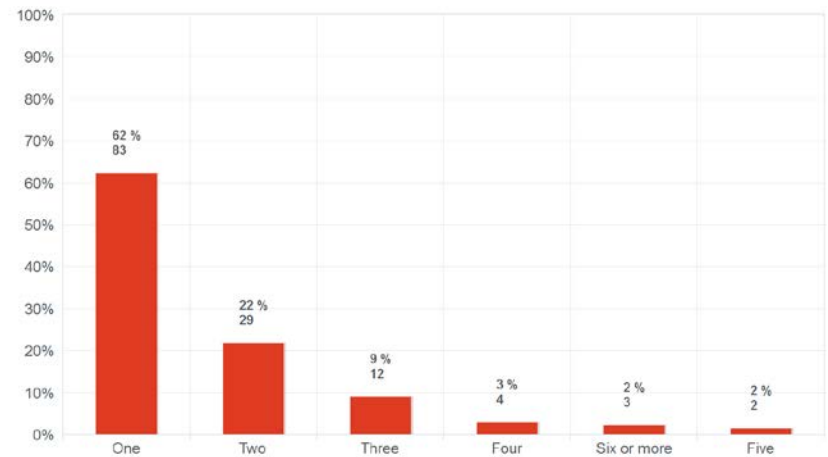
Start the search early! Of those who were employed full-time, half began searching for a job at least 3 months before graduation.

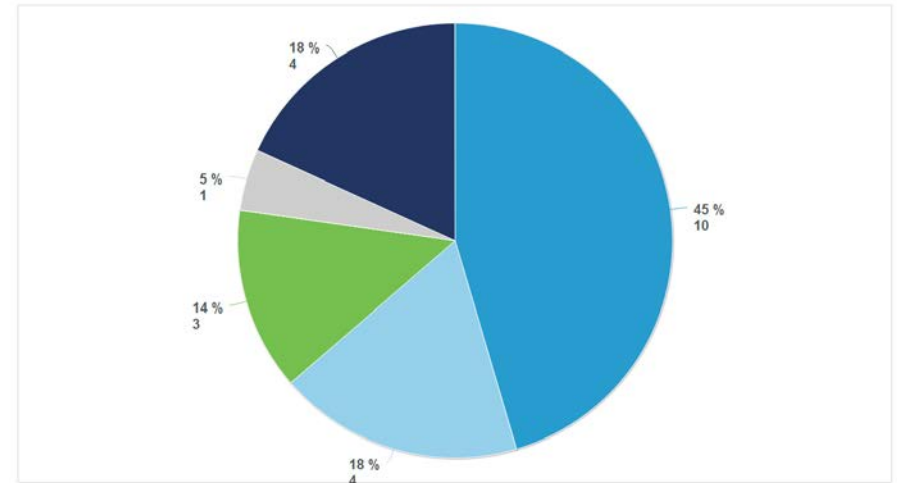

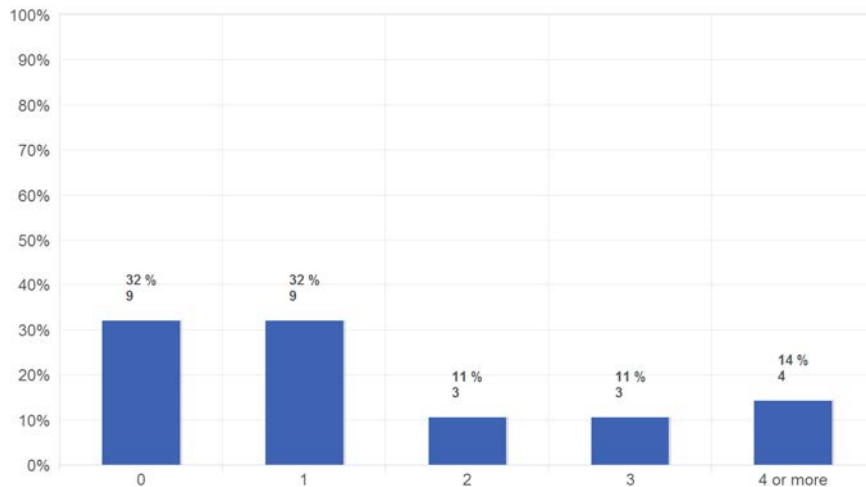
Of those employed, about 1 out of 4 (28%) with a BA degree in Feminist Studies received 2 or more job offers.
