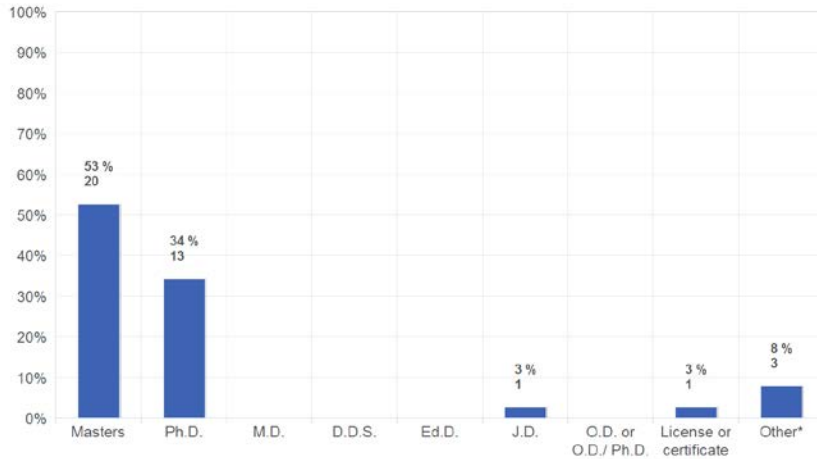

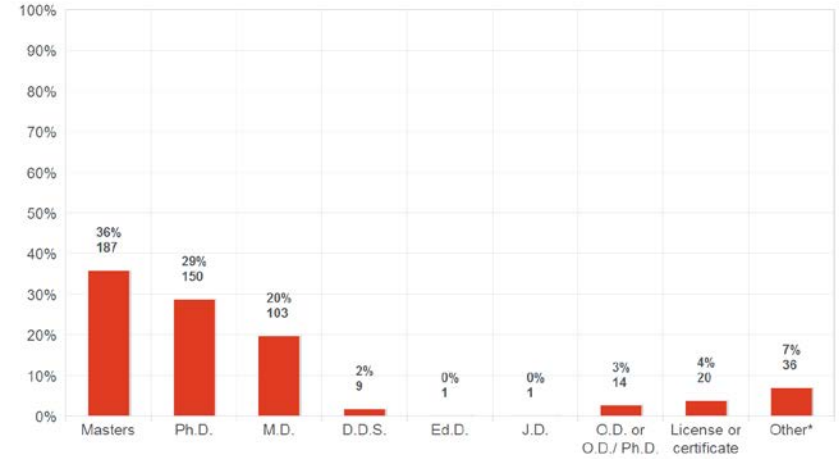
About two-thirds (64%) of Marine Biology BS degree graduates had plans to pursue graduate education.

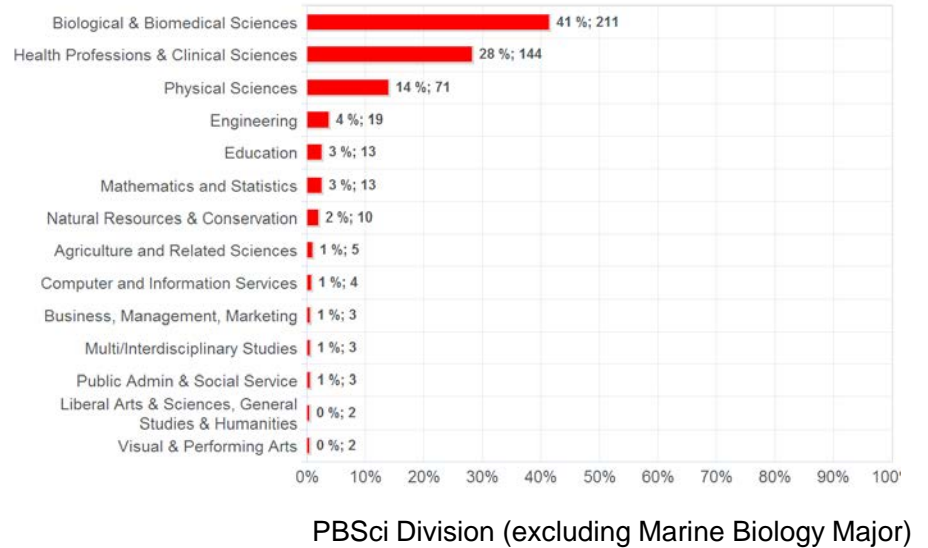
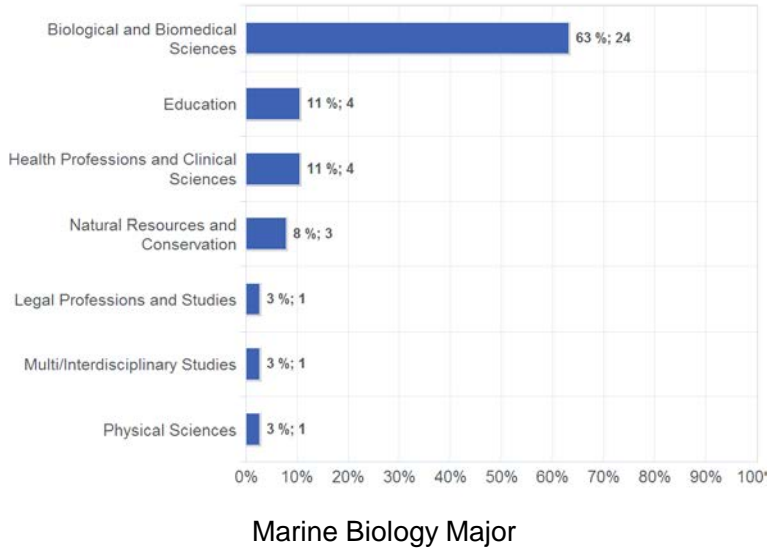

The majority (87%) of graduates with an Marine Biology BS plan to obtain either a Masters degree or a PhD.

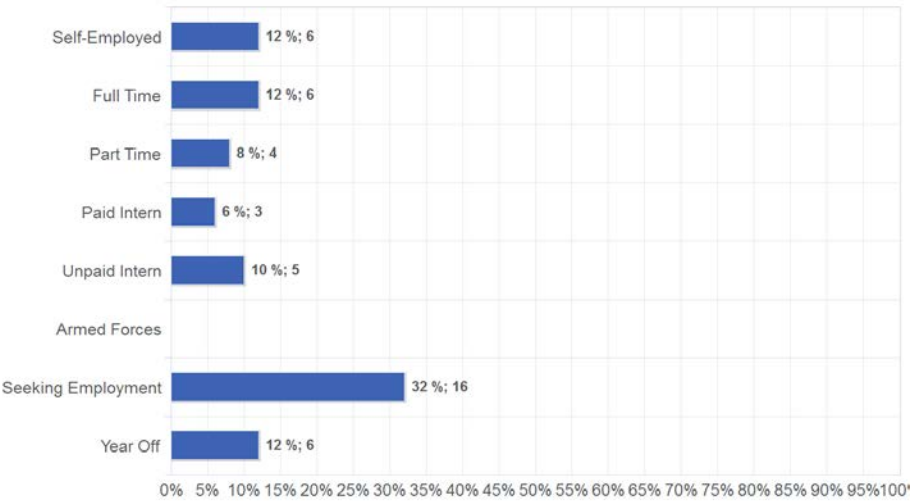

Most Popular Field of Future Academic Study



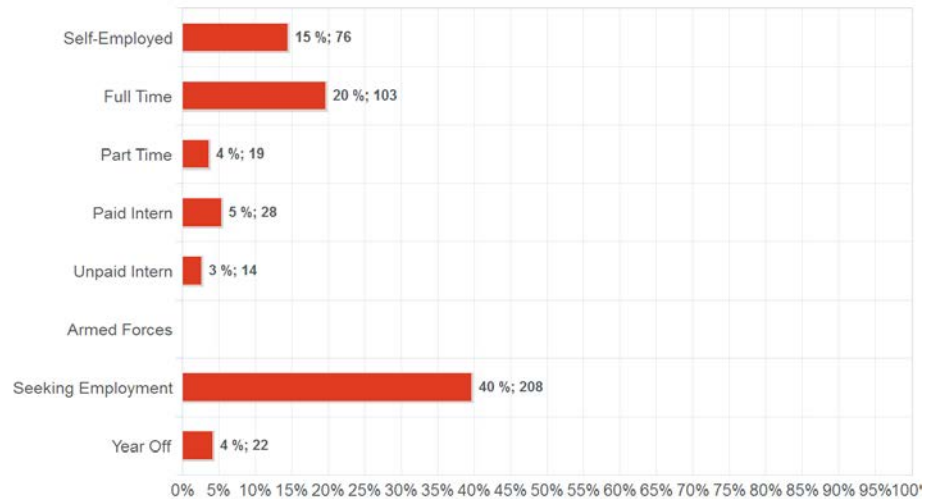
Nearly two-thirds (63%) of Marine Biology BS graduates were interested in pursuing an advanced degree in Biological and Biomedical Sciences.

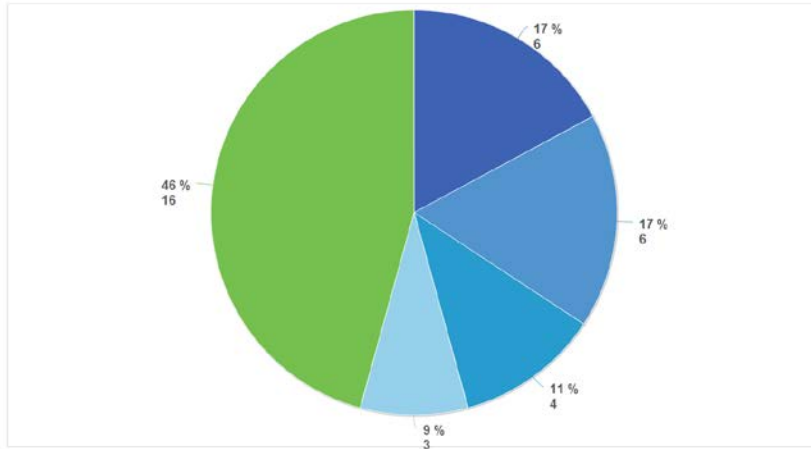
Over a third (38%) of graduates with a BS degree in Marine Biology reported being employed within 6 months of graduation.



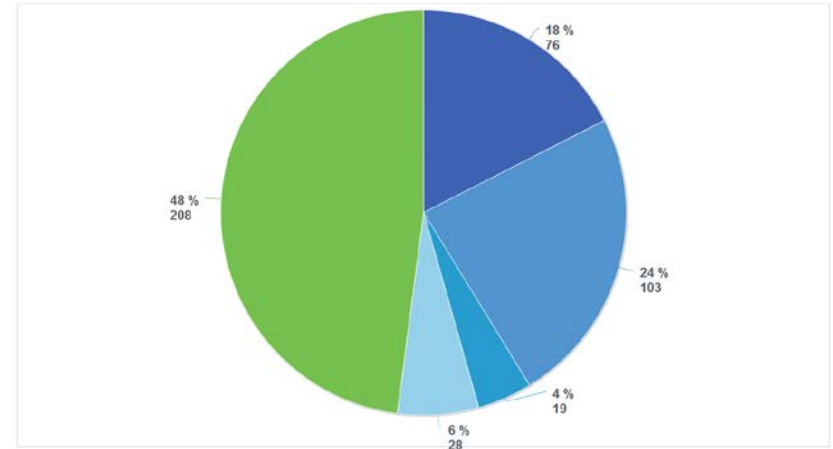

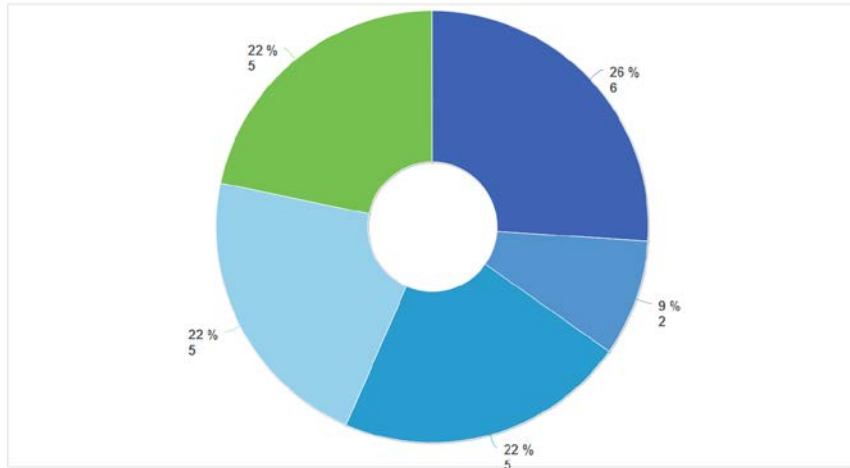

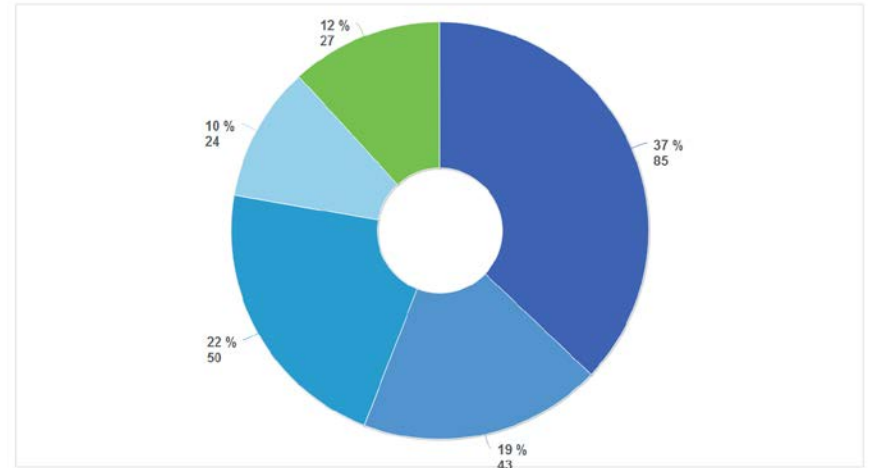


Six months after graduation, more Marine Biology BS graduates reported being employed than seeking employment.

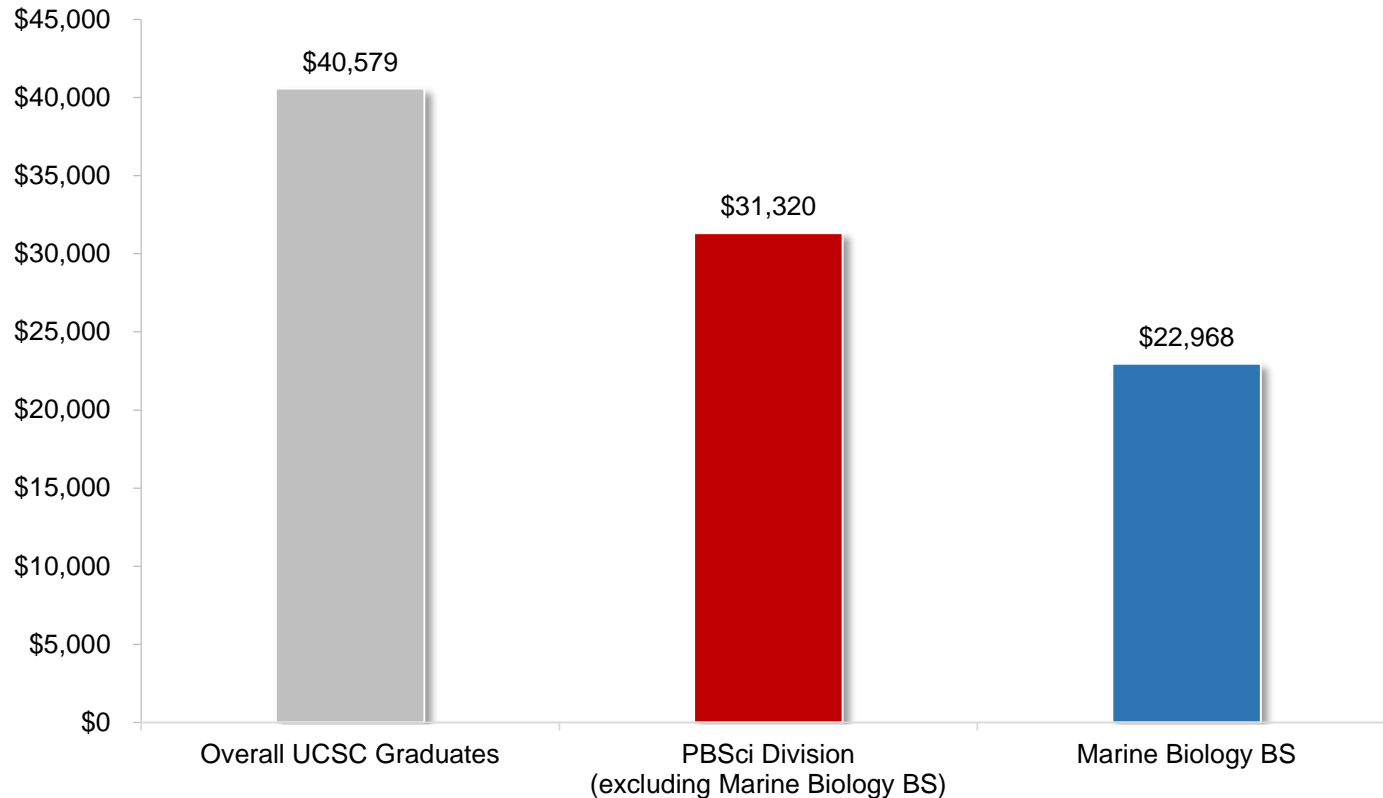

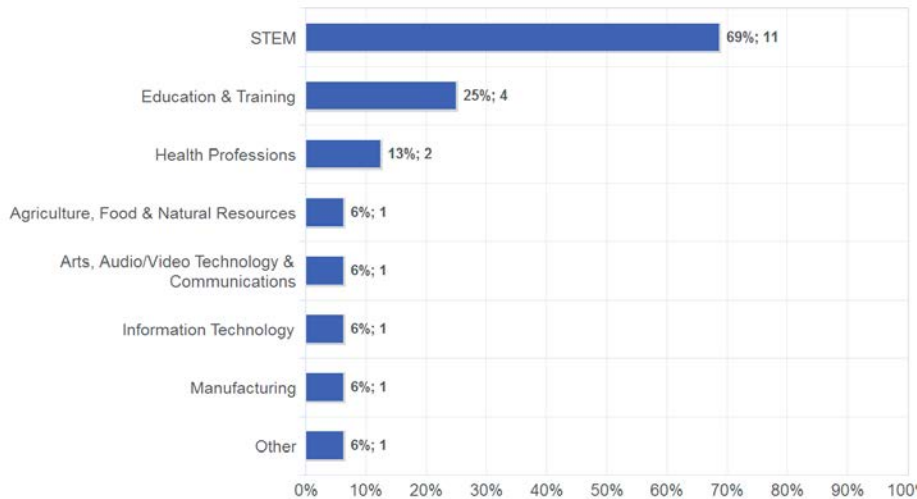
UCSC Marine Biology BS Graduates Median Annual Salary



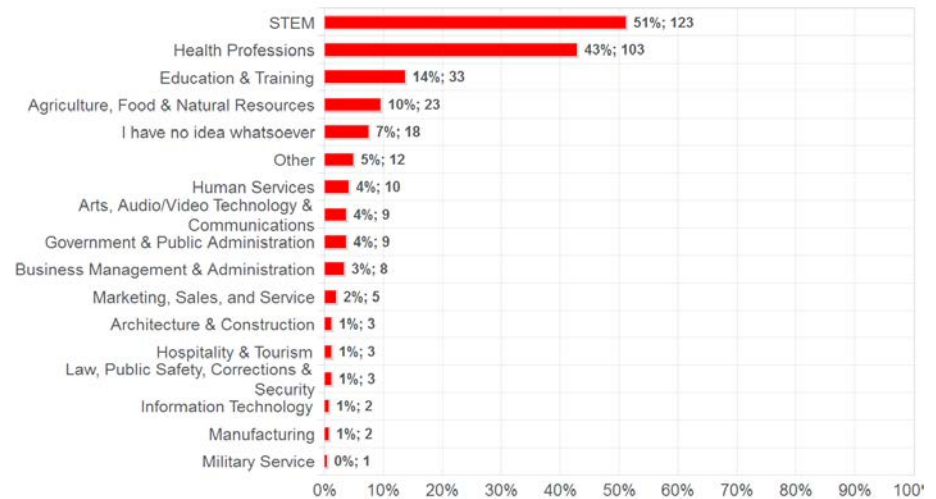
Fifty percent of graduates with a BS degree in Marine Biology reported earning \$22,968 annually or higher within 6 months of graduation.

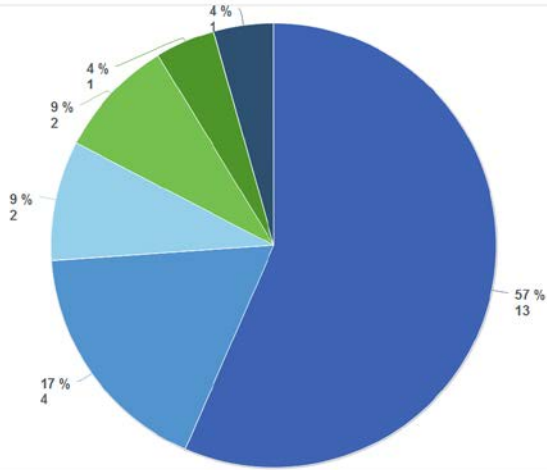

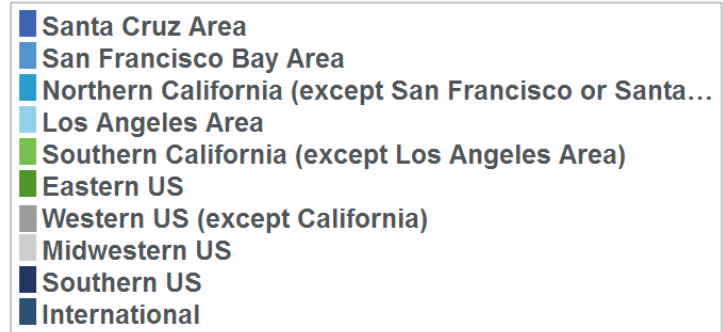
The majority (69%) of Marine Biology BS graduates hoped to have a career in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, & Math) after completing their education.

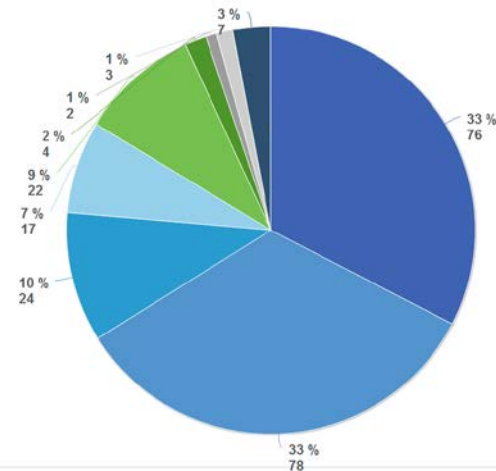
Geographic destinations of those with jobs

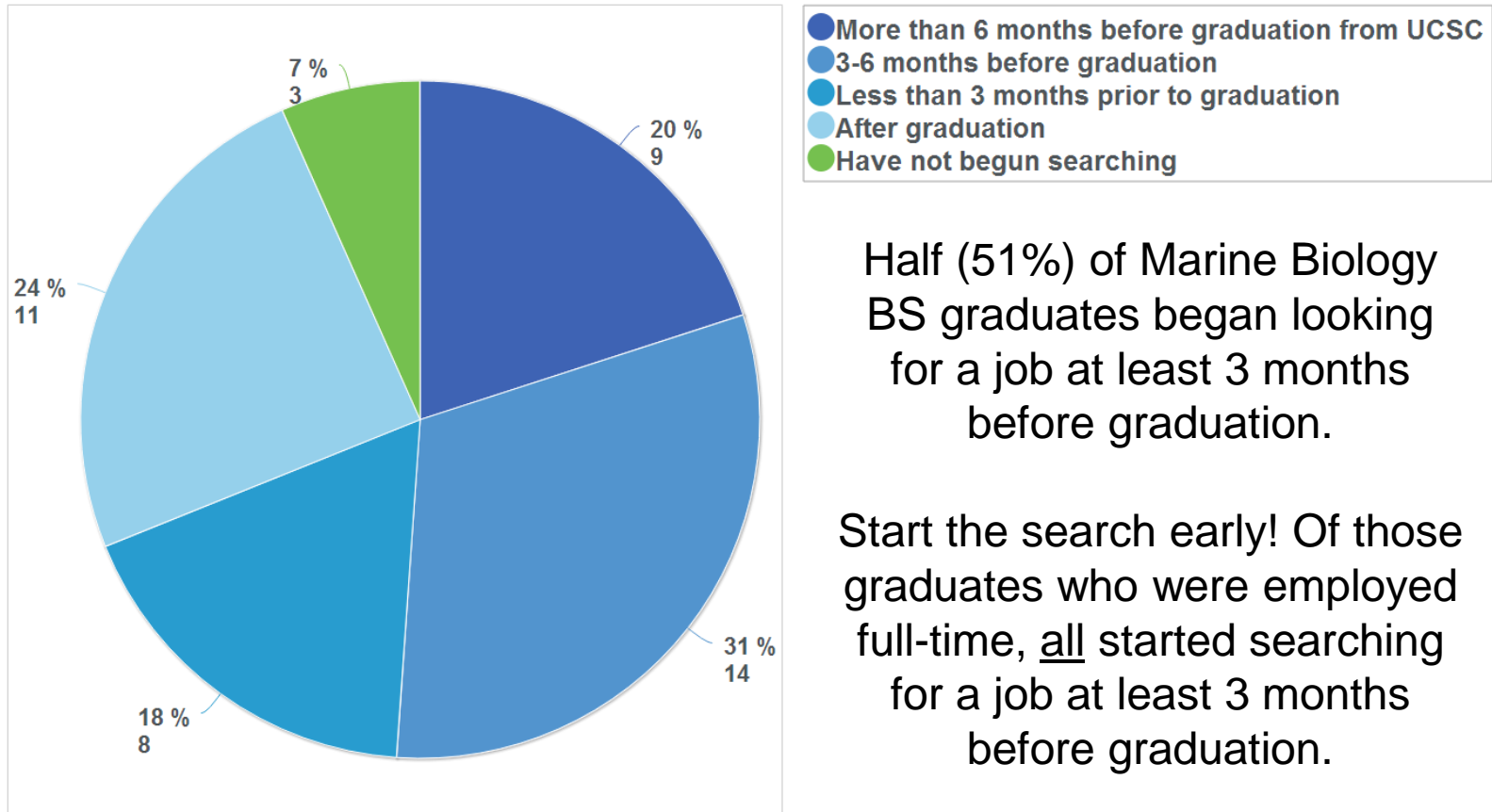
About three out of four (74%) Marine Biology BS graduates plan to work in the Santa Cruz or San Francisco Bay area.

When did they start looking for a job? (employed & seeking employment)

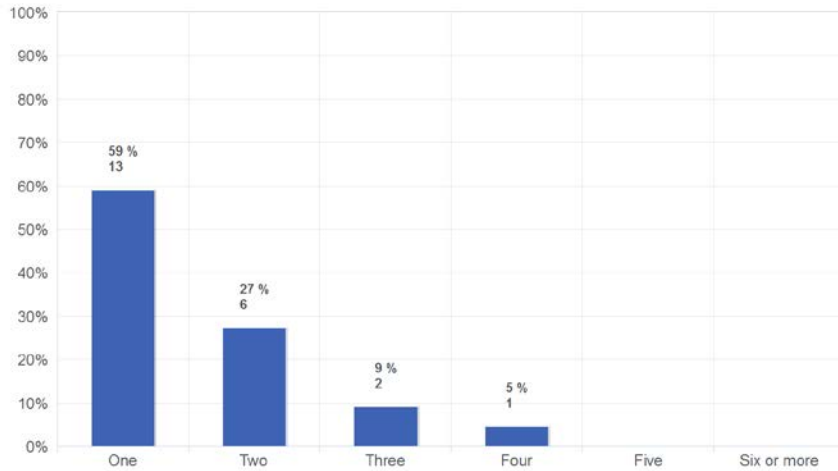


Half (51%) of Marine Biology BS graduates began looking for a job at least 3 months before graduation.

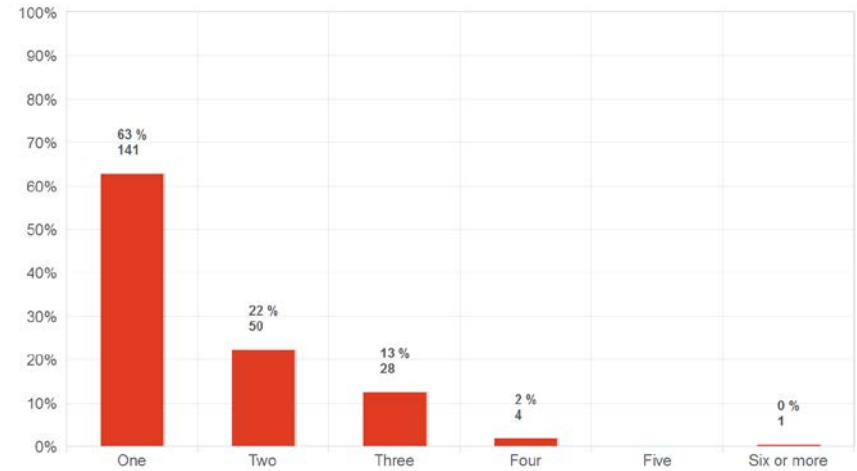
Start the search early! Of those graduates who were employed full-time, all started searching for a job at least 3 months before graduation.

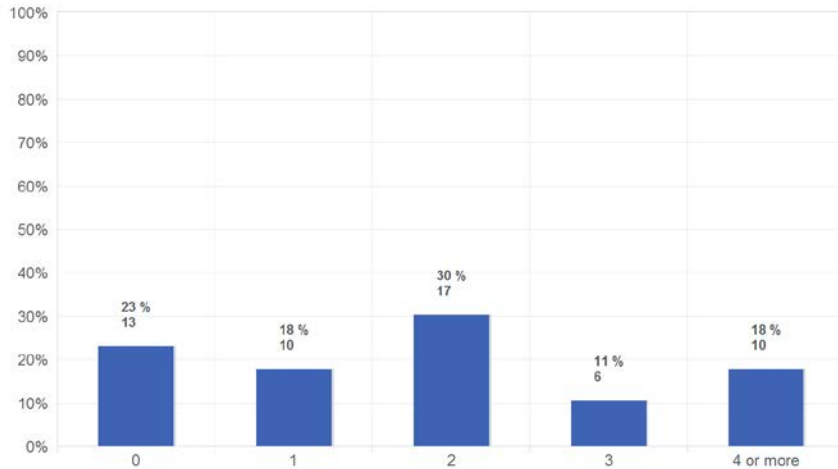
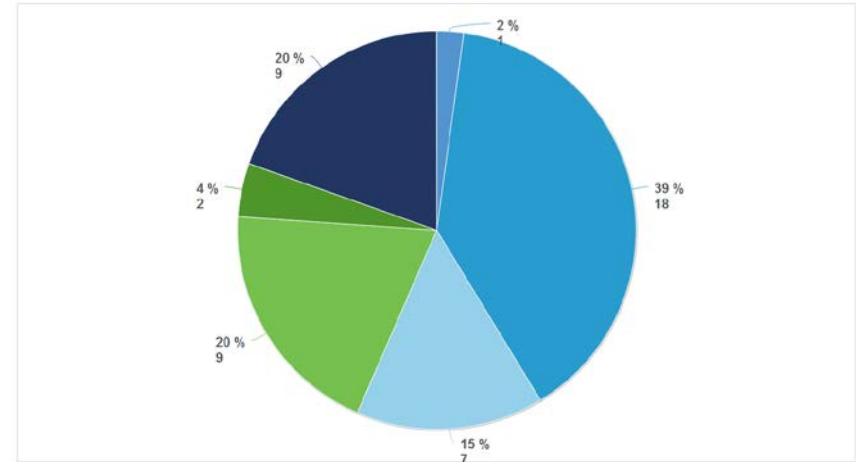
