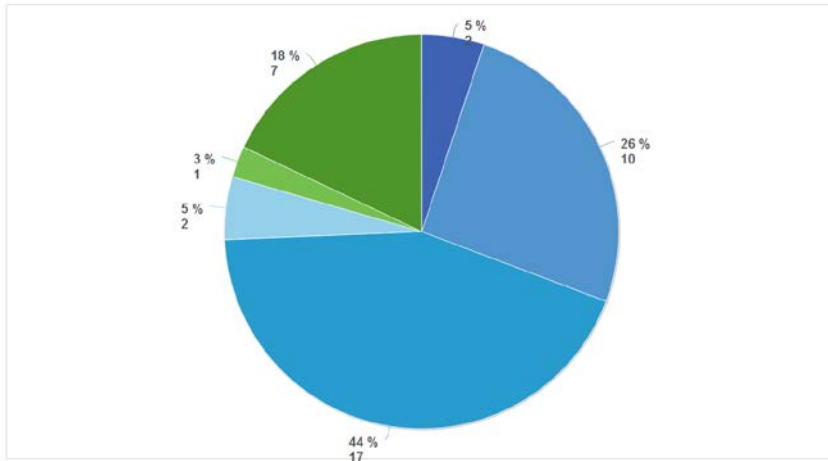


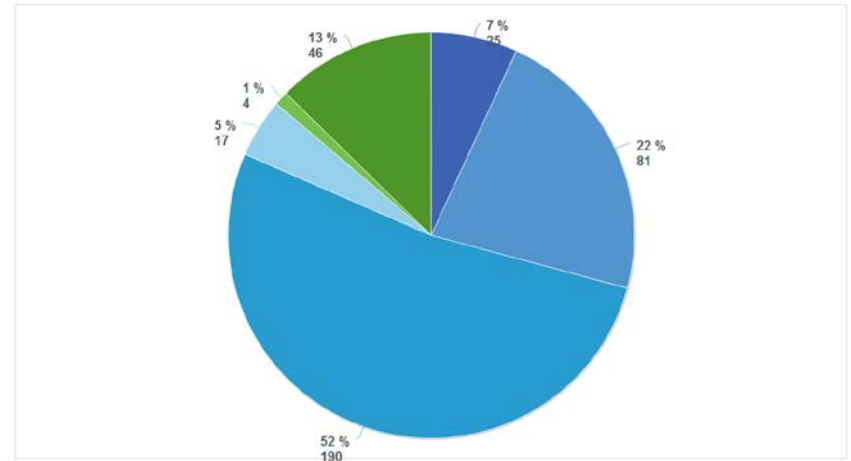
# UCSC Philosophy BA Graduates

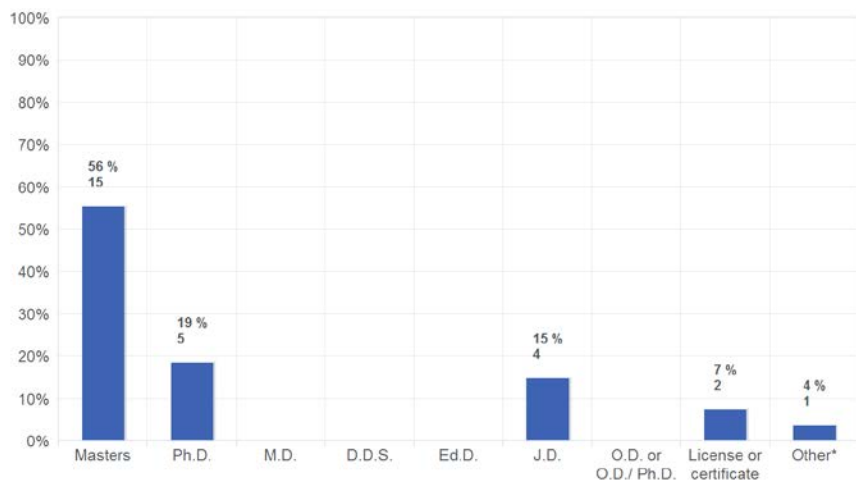

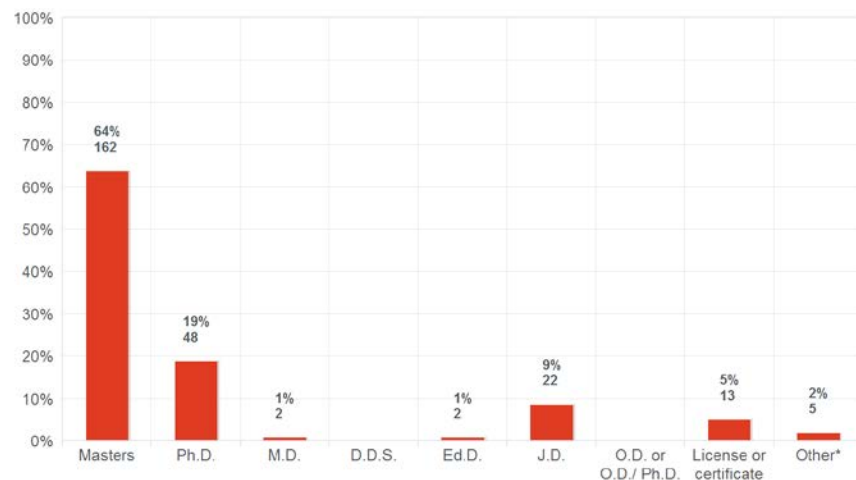
About two-thirds (69%) of Philosophy BA graduates had plans to pursue graduate education.

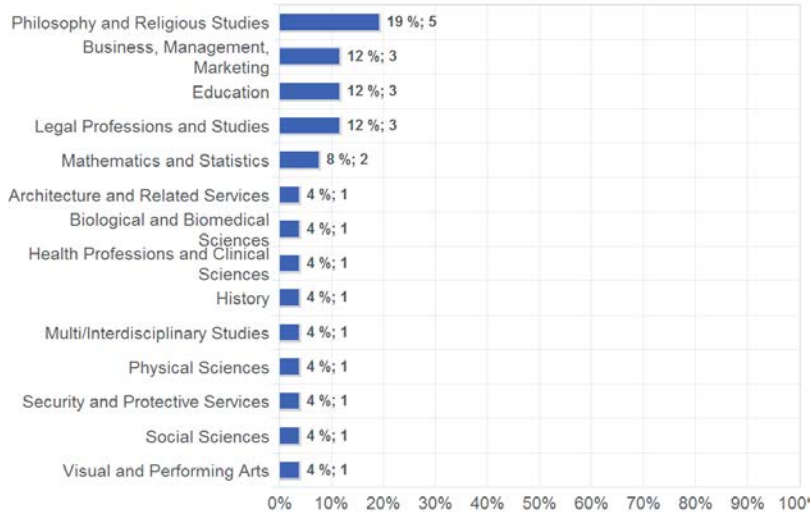

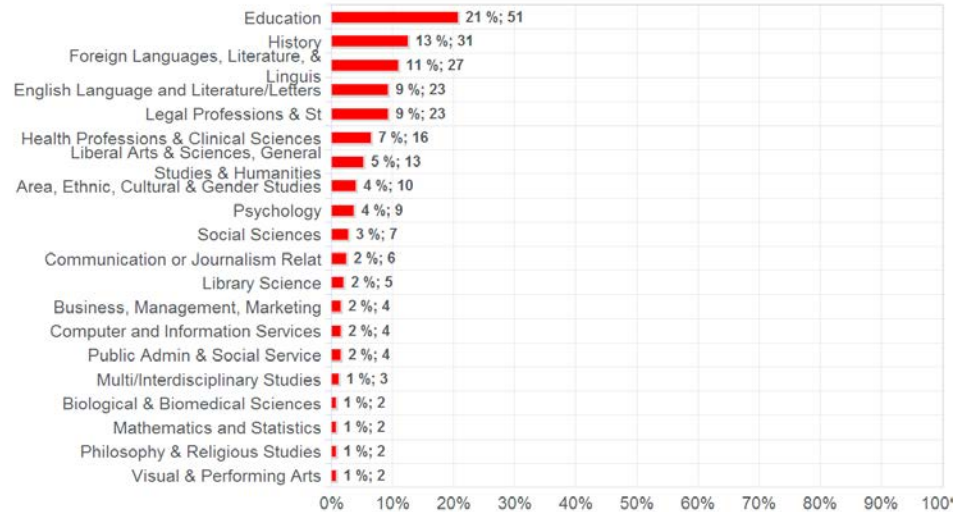
The majority (75%) of graduates with a Philosophy BA planned to obtain a Masters degree or PhD.

## Most Popular Field of Future Academic Study



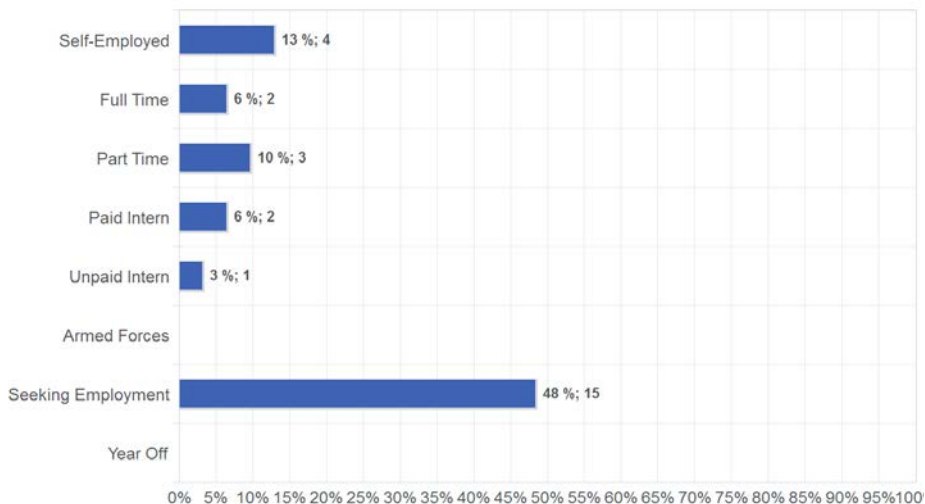

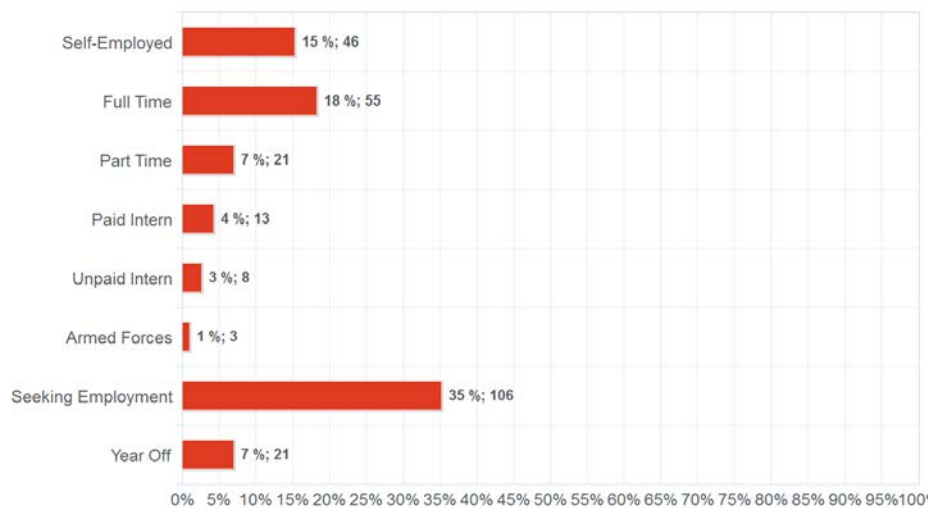
Philosophy BA graduates were interested in a variety of advanced degree fields.

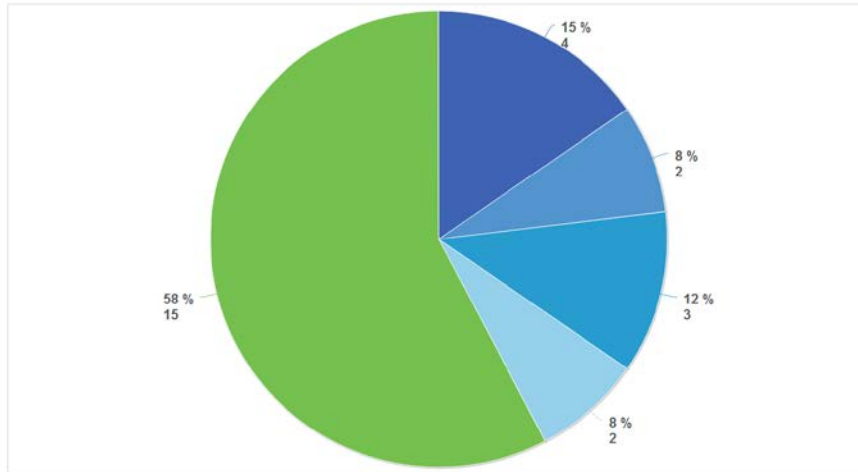
Over a third (35%) of graduates with a BA degree in Philosophy reported being employed within 6 months of graduation.



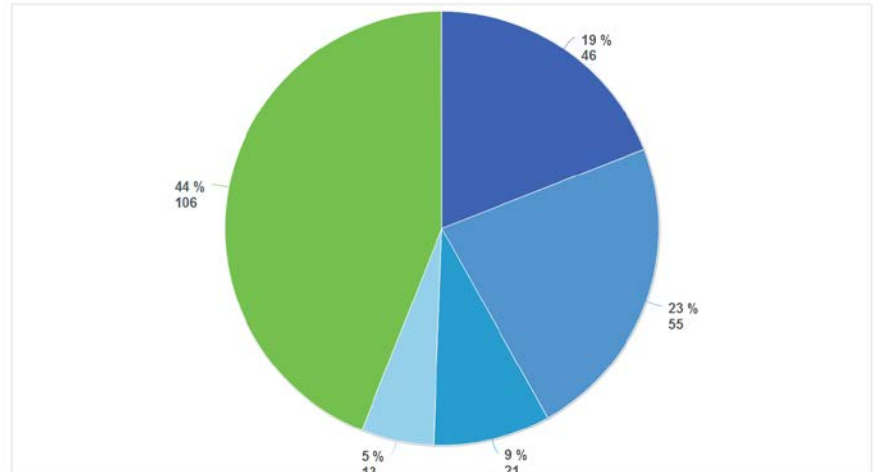

# UCSC Philosophy BA Graduates Employed vs Seeking Employment

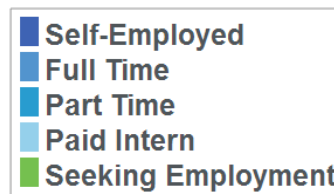
Among those who are not going to graduate school after graduation....

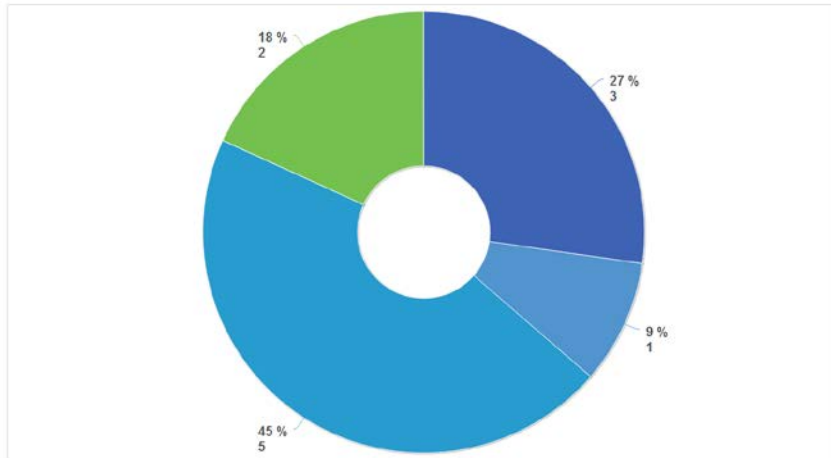

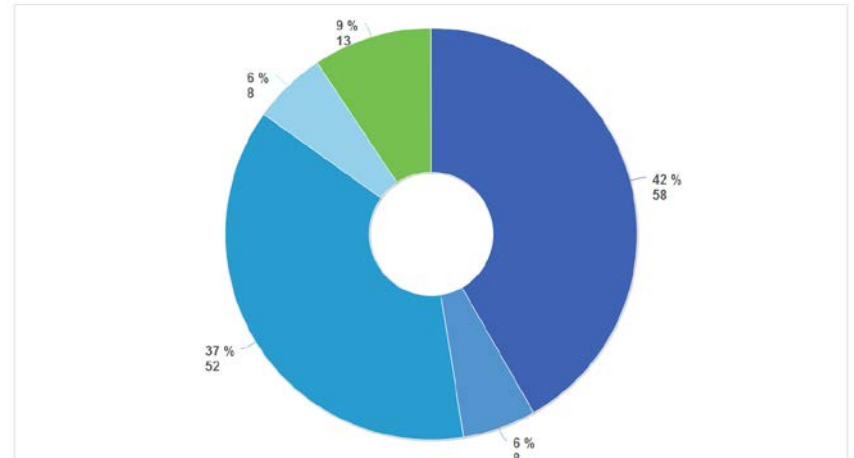
More Art BA graduates reported seeking employment than being employed within 6 months of graduation.

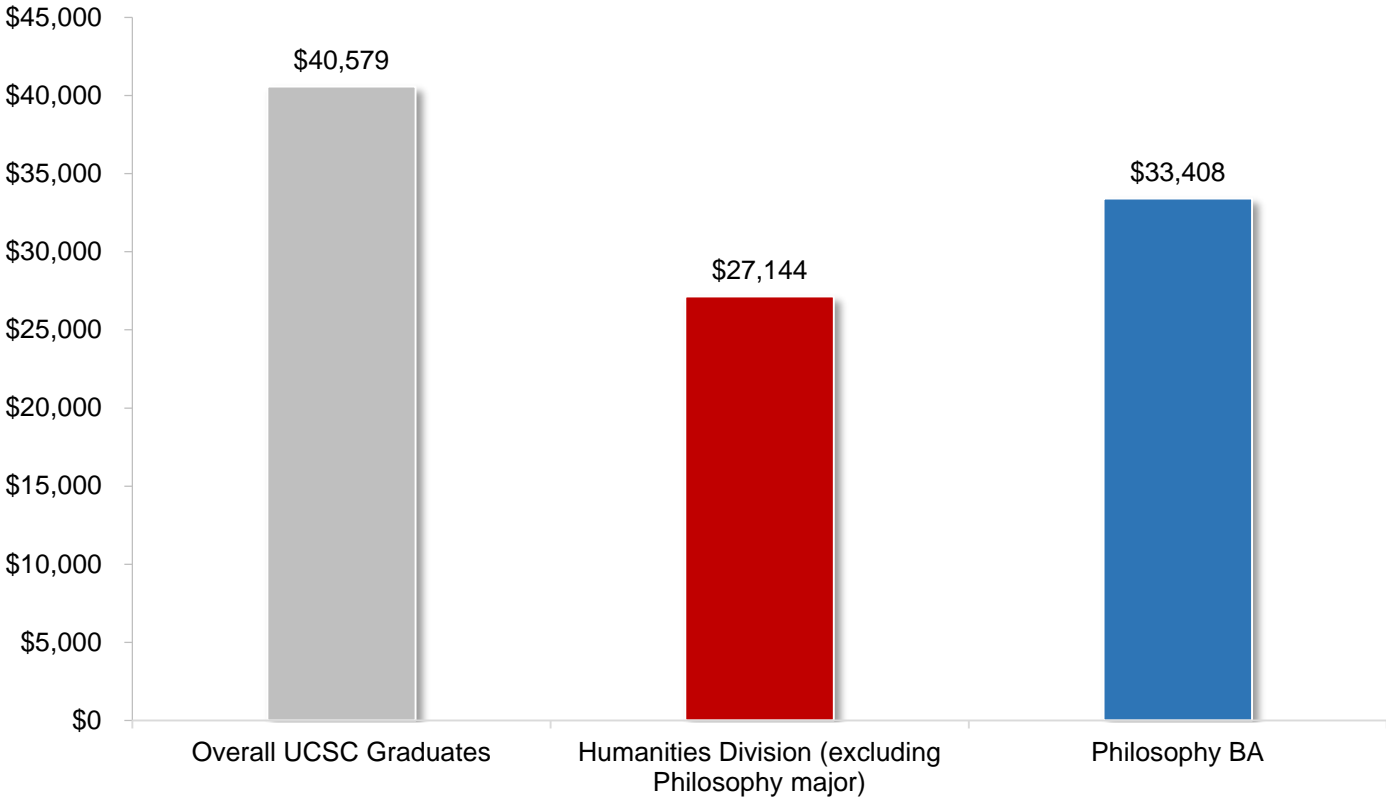
Of those employed, the majority (72%) of BA Philosophy graduates reported working in the Business or Education sector within 6 months of graduation.

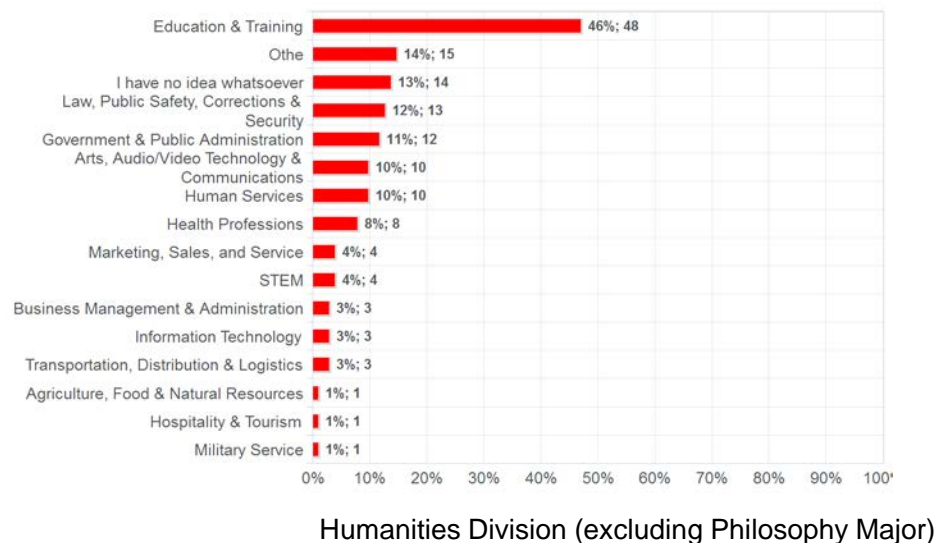
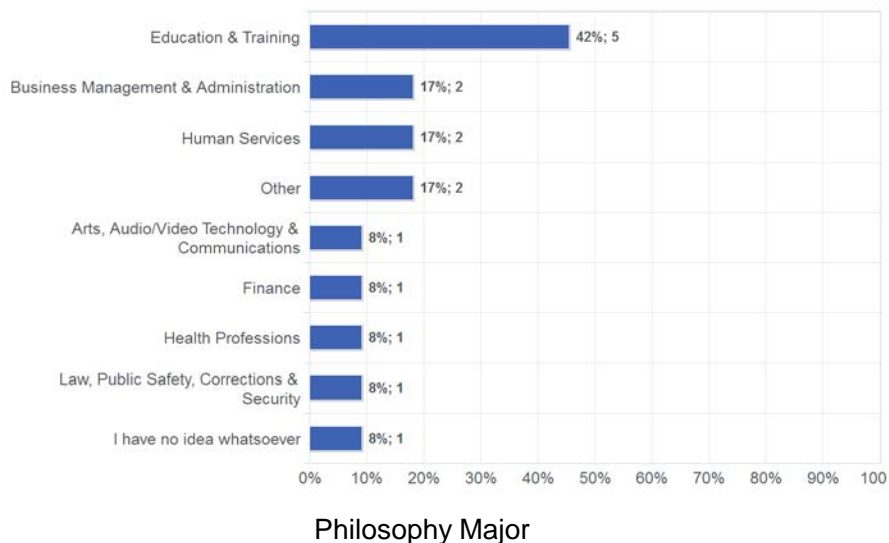
# UCSC Philosophy BA Graduates Median Annual Salary



Half of graduates with a BA degree in Philosophy reported earning \$33,408 annually or higher within 6 months of graduation.



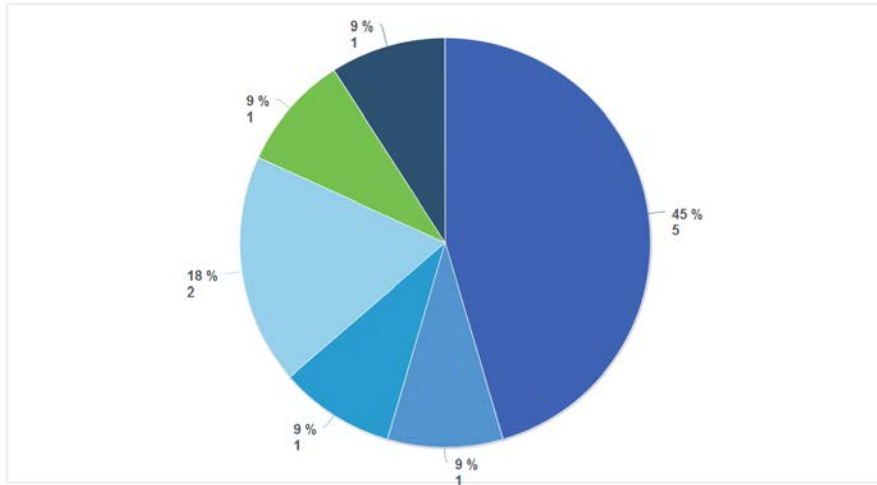
# UCSC Philosophy BA Graduates Future Career Plans



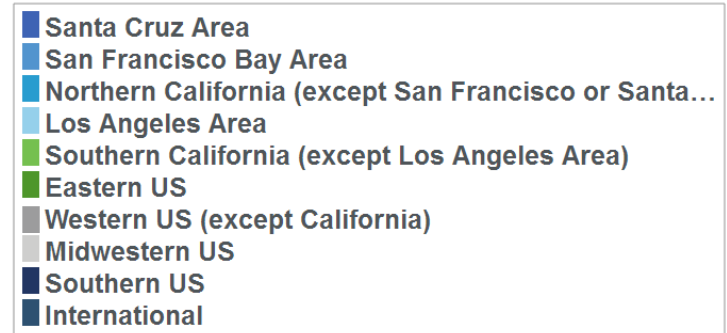
42% of Philosophy BA graduates hoped to have a career in Education & Training after completing their higher education.

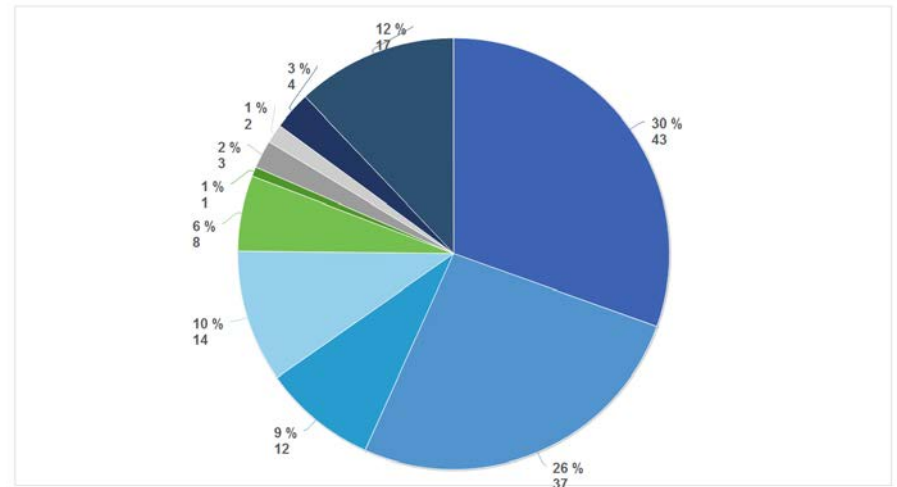
## Geographic destinations of those with jobs

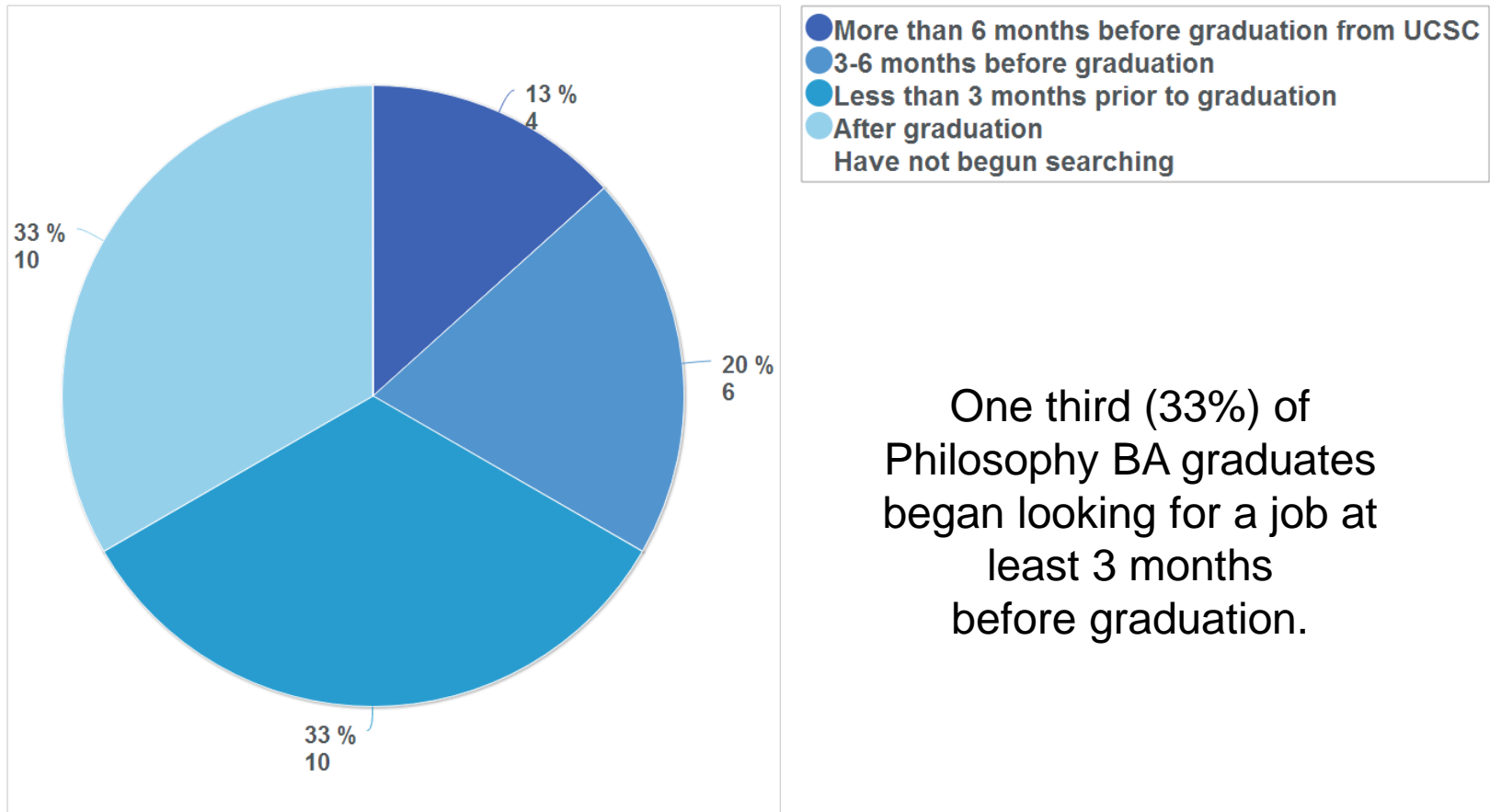
Nearly half (45%) of Philosophy BA graduates plan to work locally in the Santa Cruz Area.

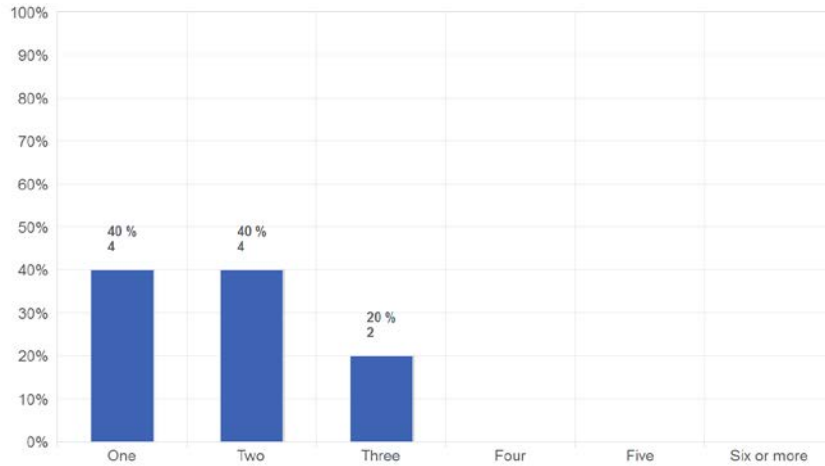
When did they start looking for a job? (employed & seeking employment)



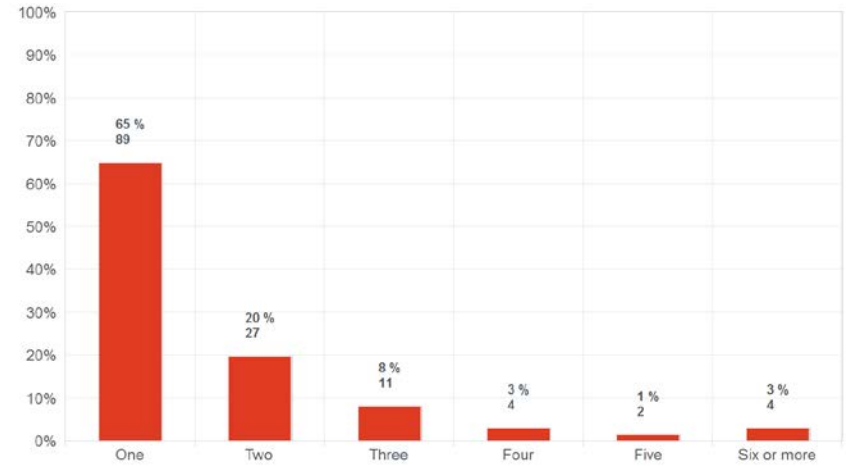
One third (33%) of Philosophy BA graduates began looking for a job at least 3 months before graduation.

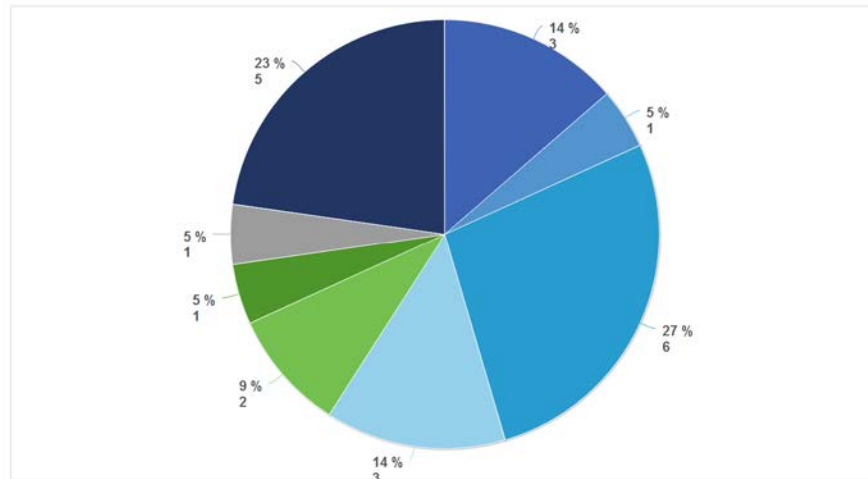

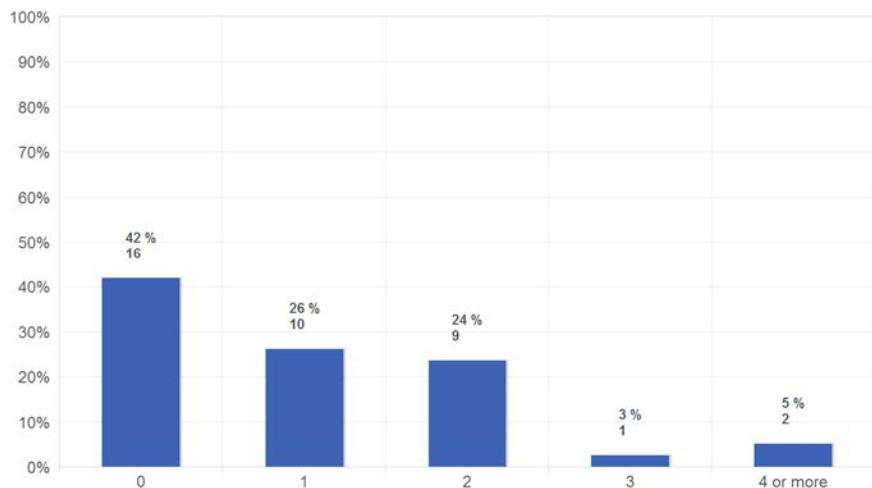
Of those employed, over half (60%) with a BA degree in Philosophy received at least two job offers.

# UCSC Philosophy BA Graduates Internships
