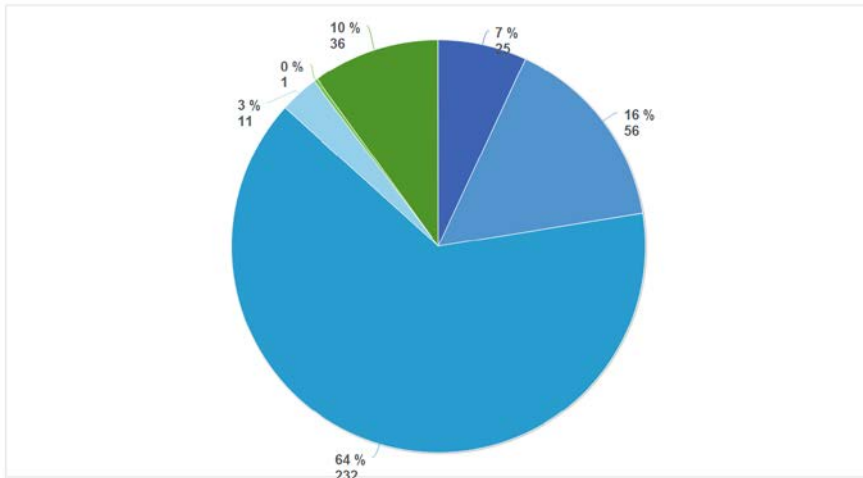
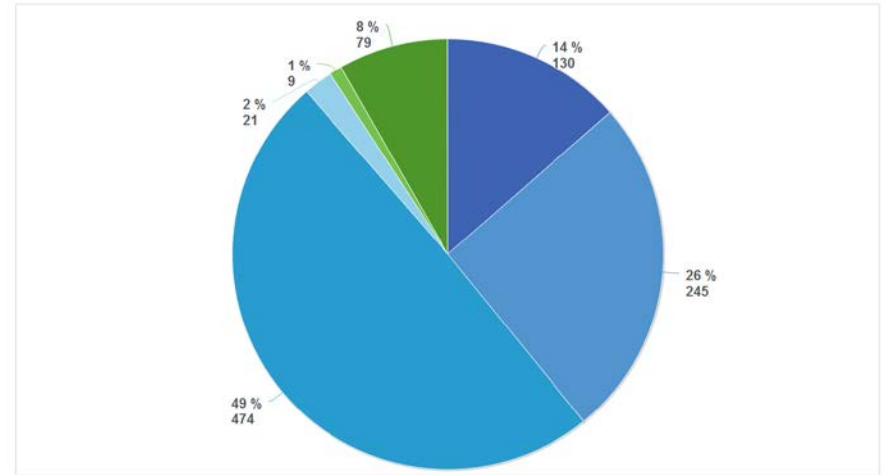


# UCSC Psychology BA Graduates Academic Plans for Graduate Studies

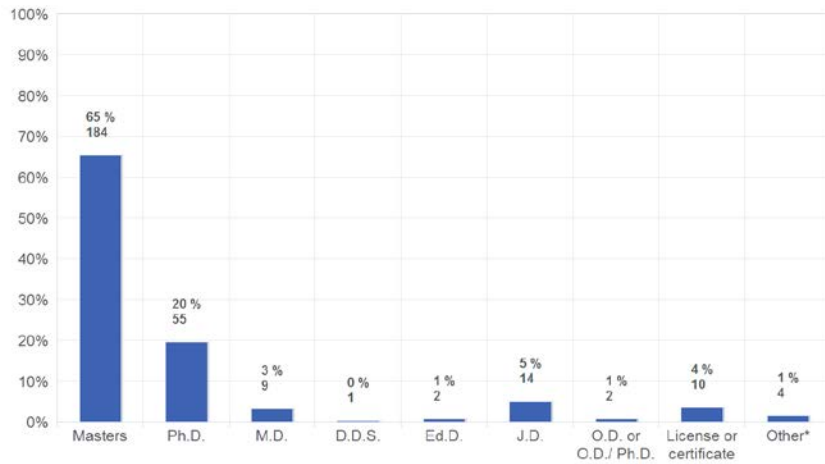

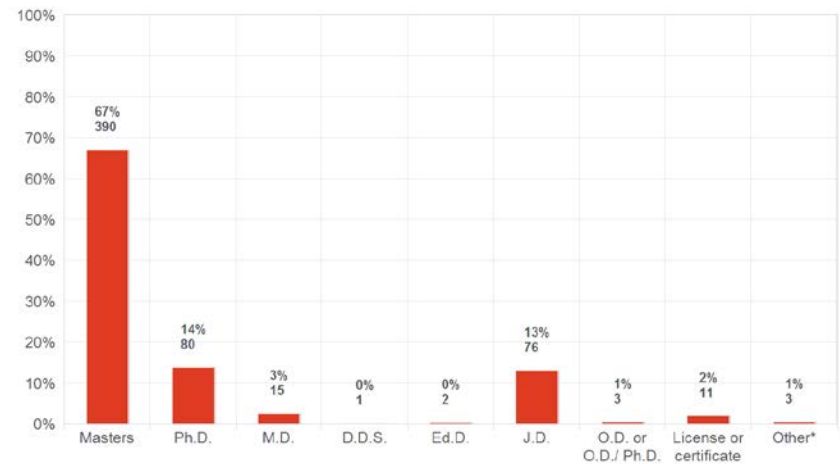
The majority (77%) of Psychology BA degree graduates had plans to pursue graduate education.

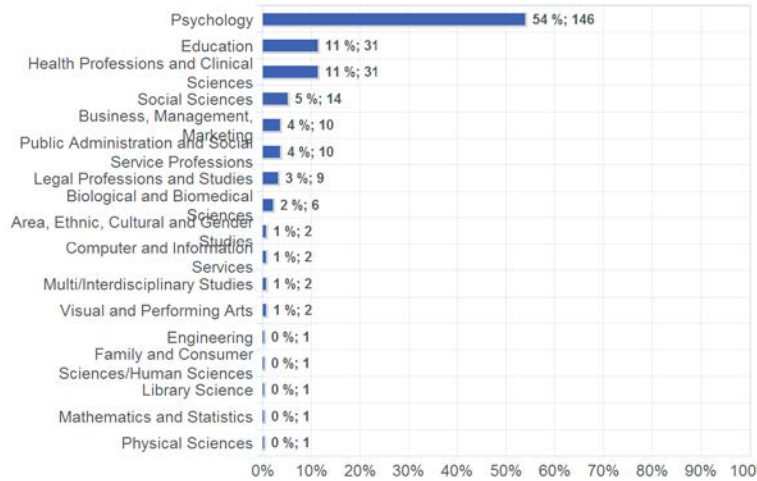

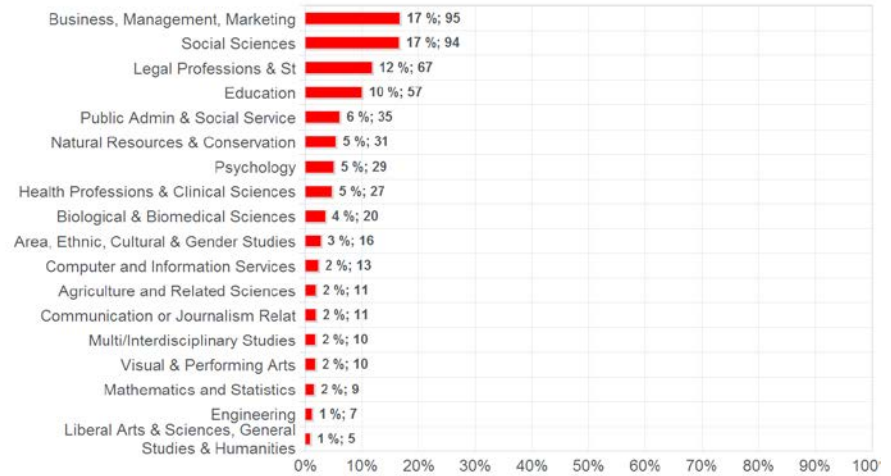
The majority (85%) of graduates with a Psychology Major plan to obtain either a masters degree or PhD.

## Most Popular Field of Future Academic Study



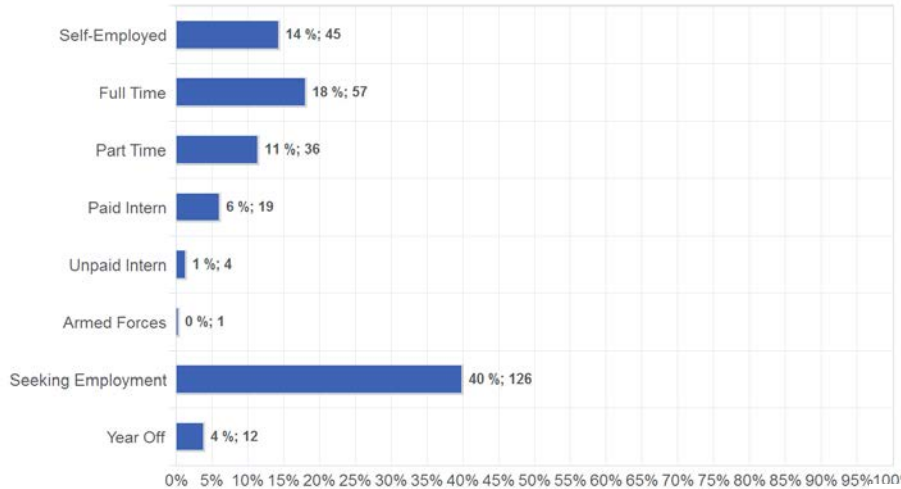

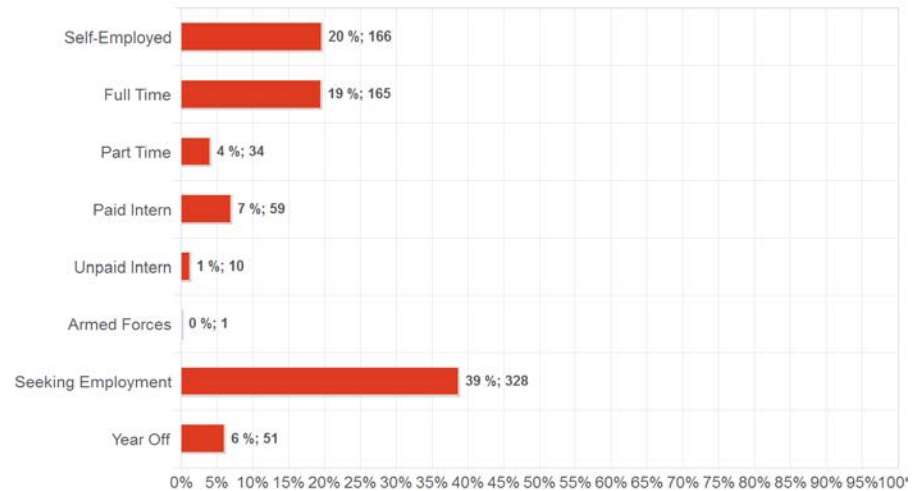
Psychology BA graduates were interested in pursuing advanced degrees in a variety of fields, the most popular of which were related to Psychology (54%).

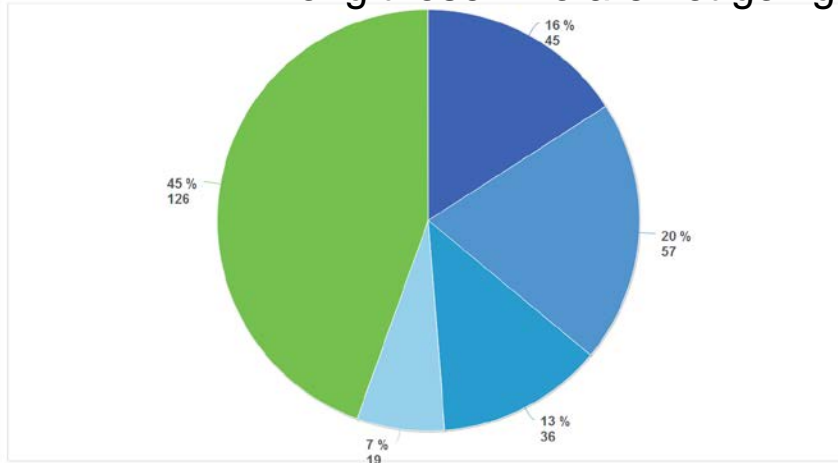
About half (49%) of graduates with a BA degree in Psychology reported being employed within 6 months of graduation.



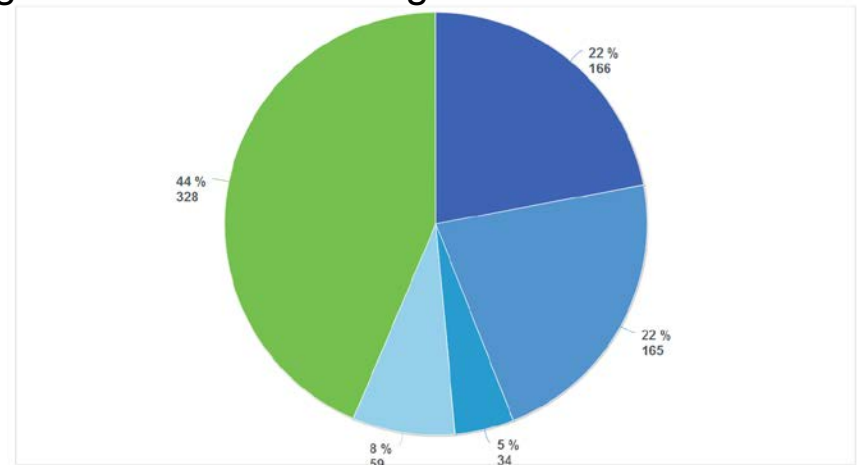

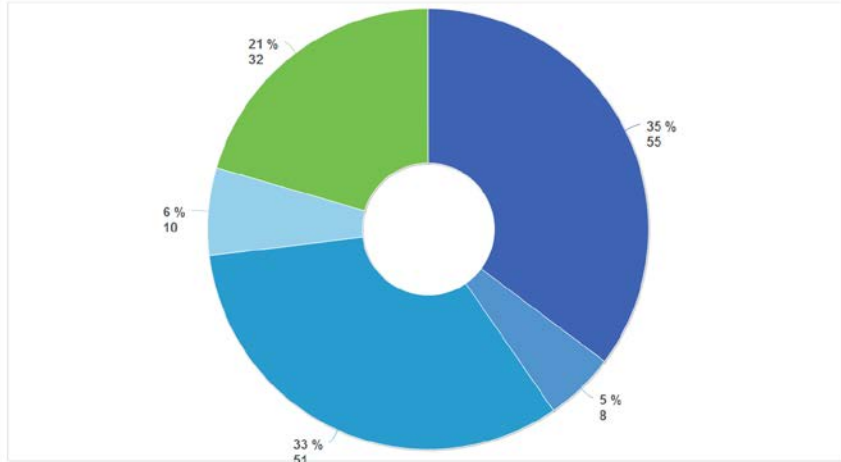

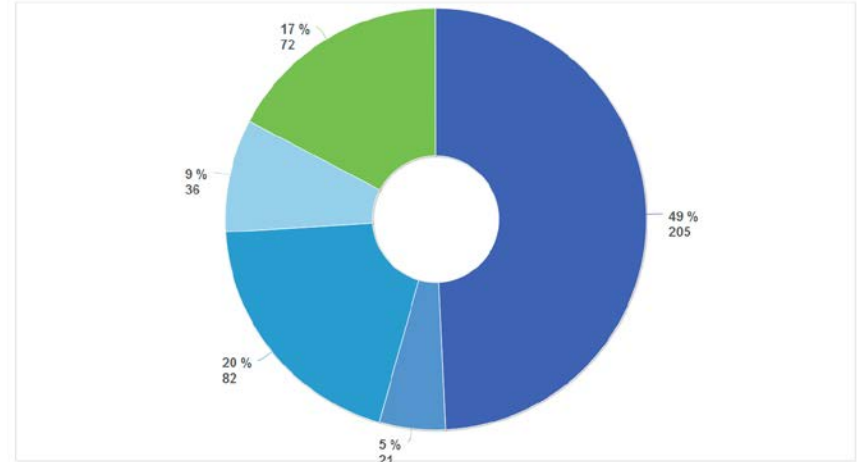
More graduates with a BA degree in Psychology were employed than seeking employment 6 months after graduation.

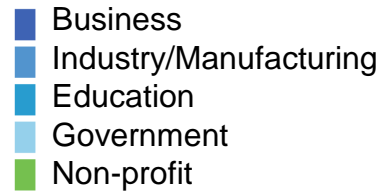
## Sectors where students were employed

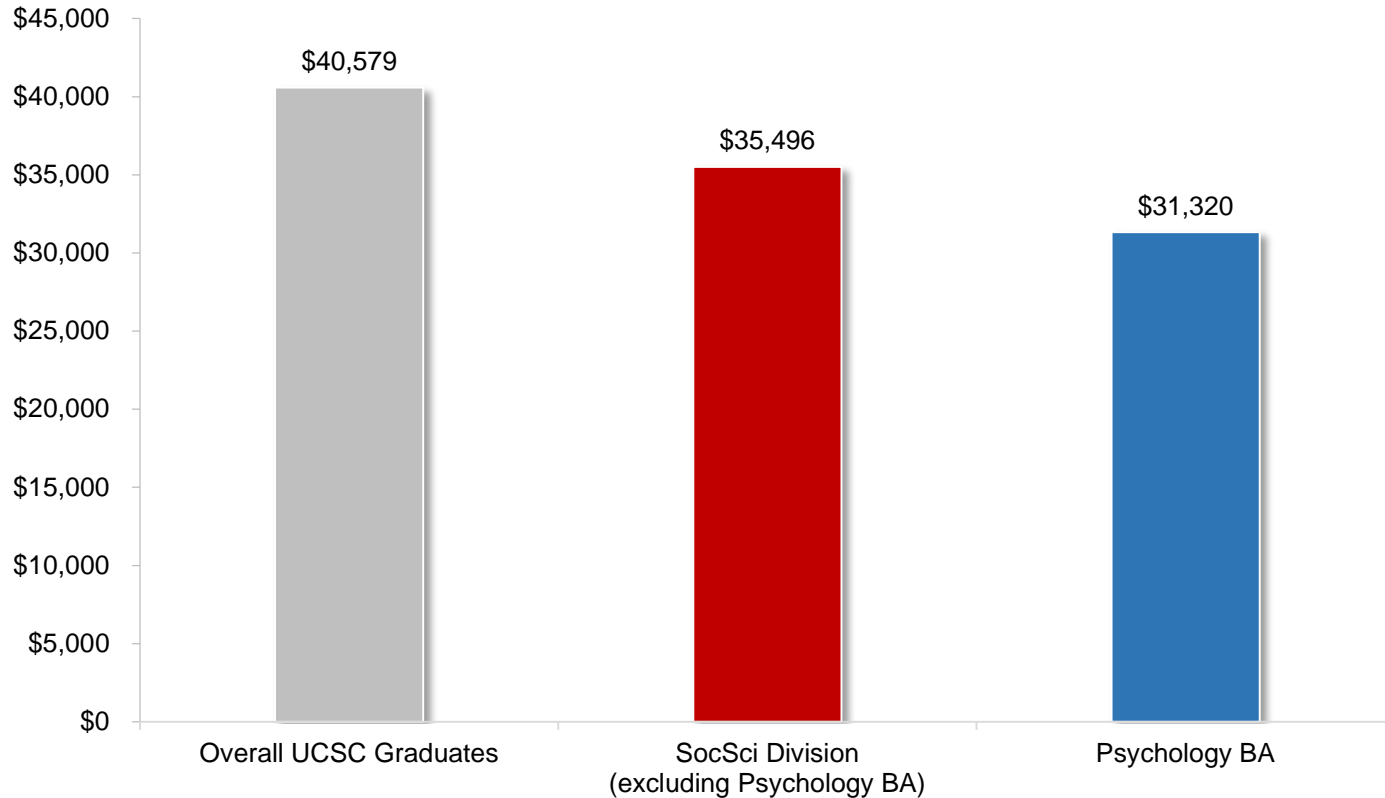


Of those employed, most (68%) of Psychology BA graduates reported working in the Business (35%) or Education (33%) sector within 6 months of graduation.





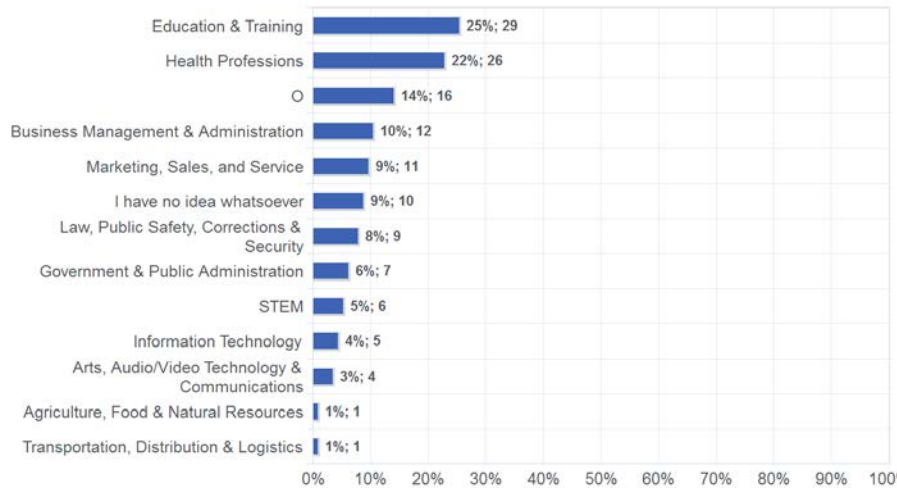
# UCSC Psychology BA Graduates Median Annual Salary



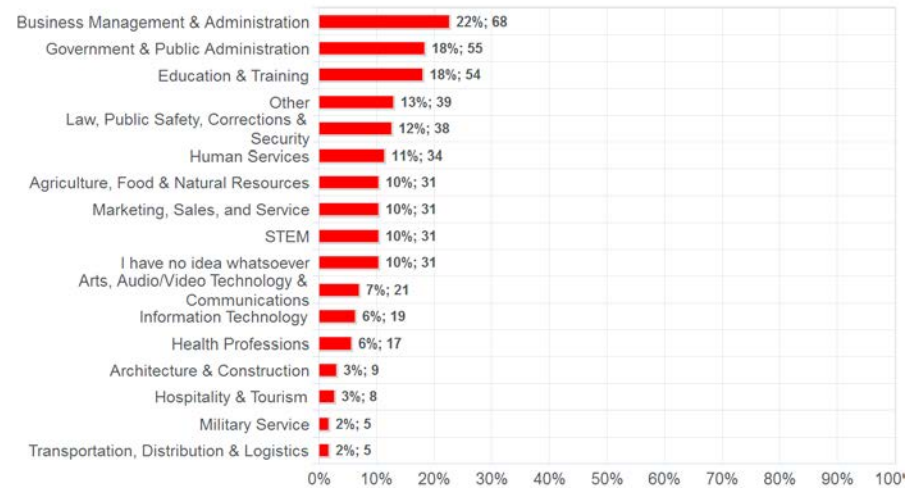
Fifty percent of graduates with a BA degree in Psychology reported earning \$31,320 annually or higher within 6 months of graduation.

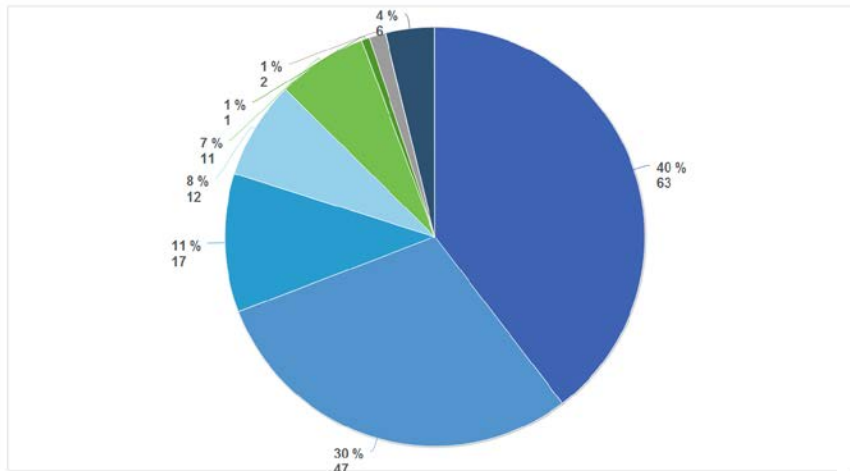

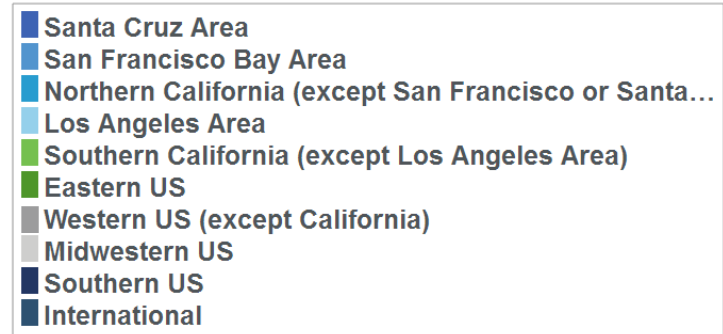

25% of Psychology BA graduates hoped to have a career in Education & Training after completing their education.

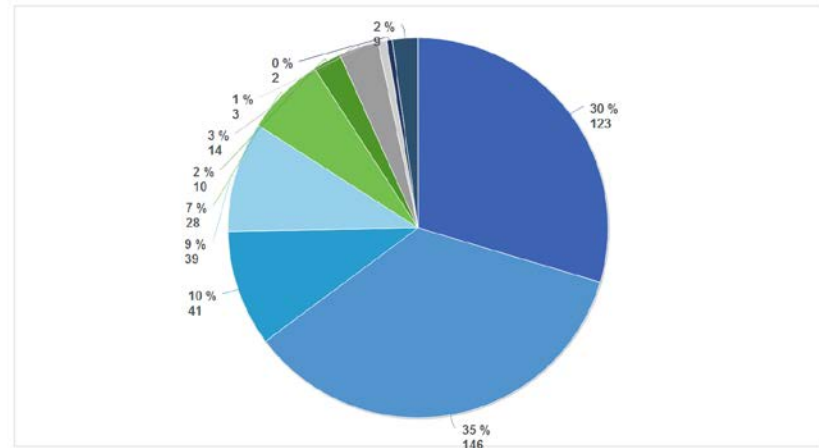
# UCSC Psychology BA Graduates Geographic Destinations

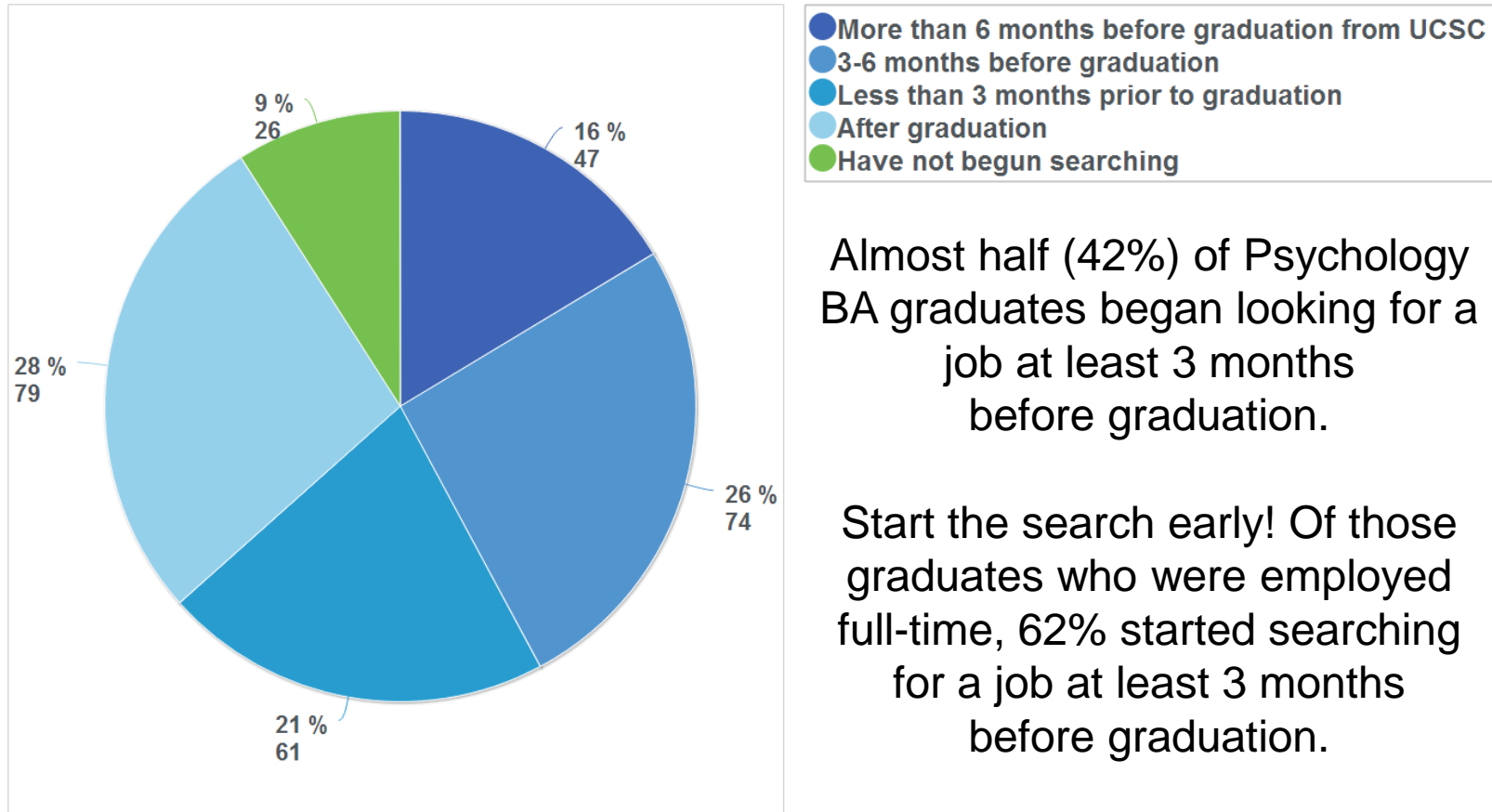
70% of Psychology BA graduates reported that they plan to work locally in the Santa Cruz or San Francisco Bay Area.

When did they start looking for a job? (employed & seeking employment)

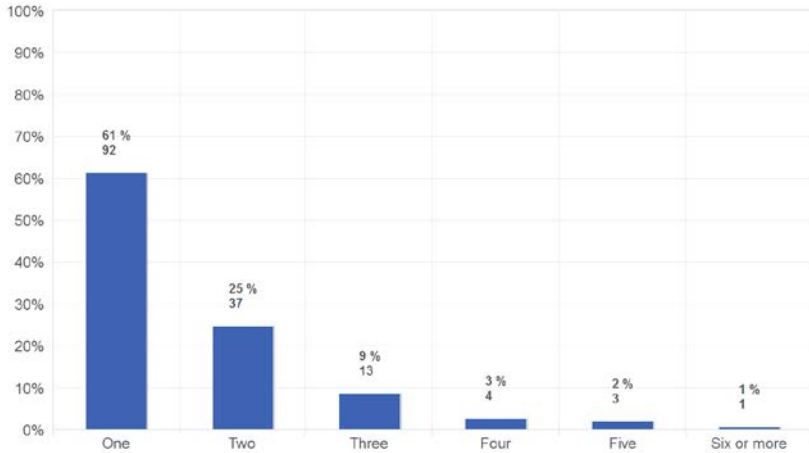


Almost half (42%) of Psychology BA graduates began looking for a job at least 3 months before graduation.

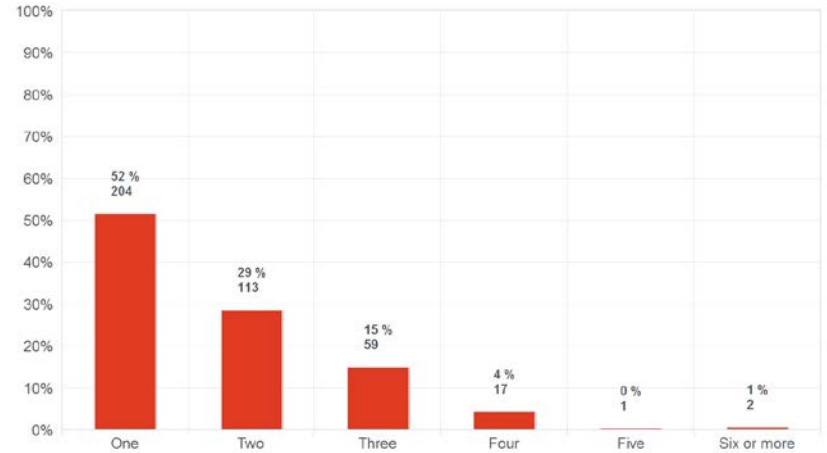
Start the search early! Of those graduates who were employed full-time, 62% started searching for a job at least 3 months before graduation.

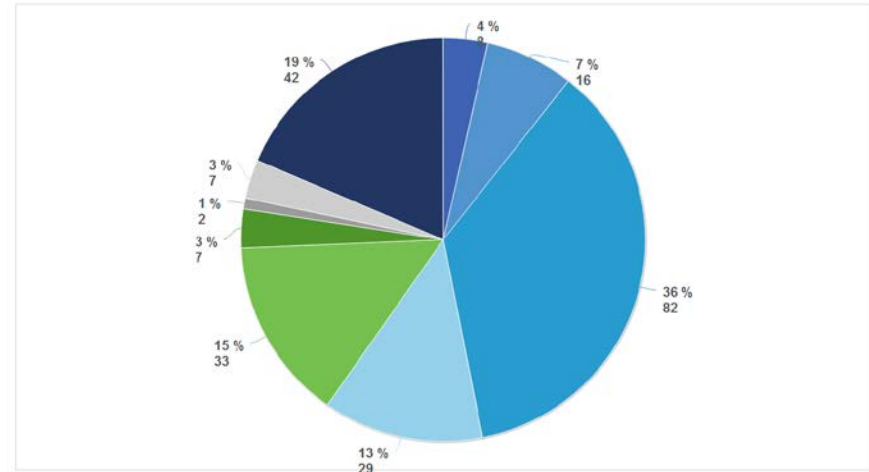

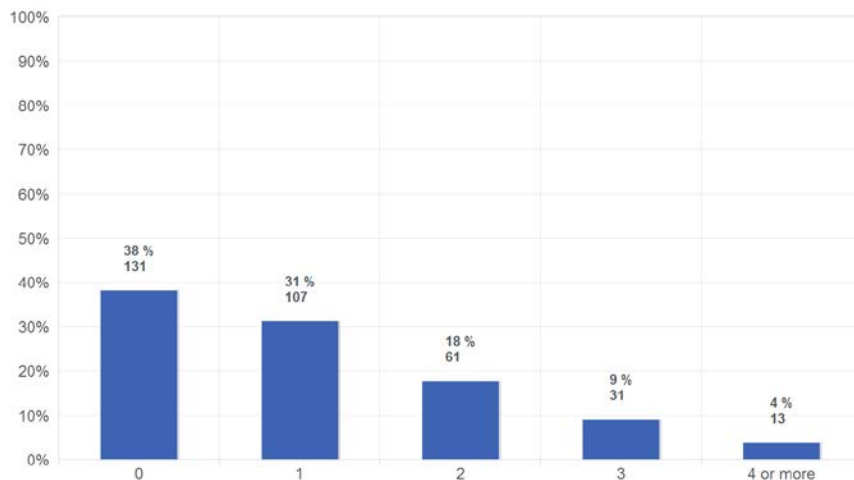
Of those employed, 40% of graduates with a BA degree in Psychology received multiple job offers.
