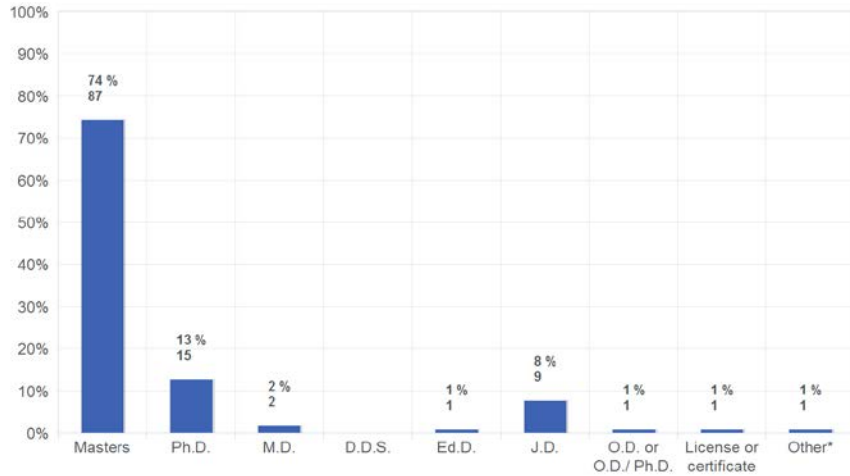

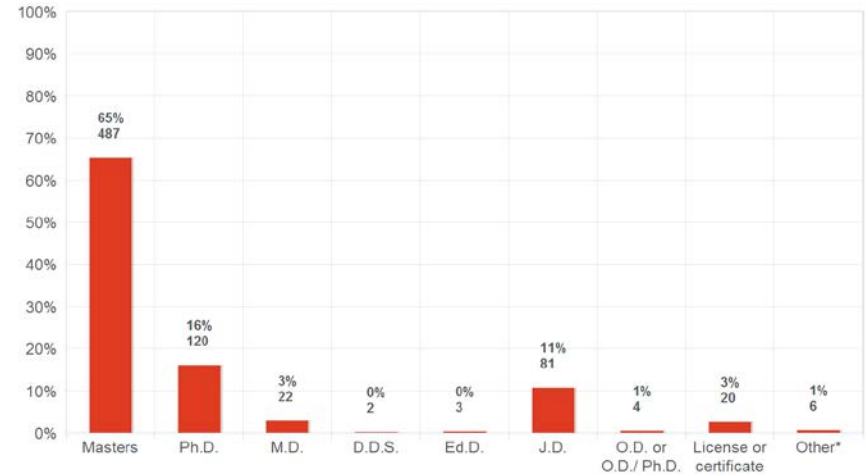
The majority (71%) of Sociology BA degree graduates had plans to pursue graduate education.

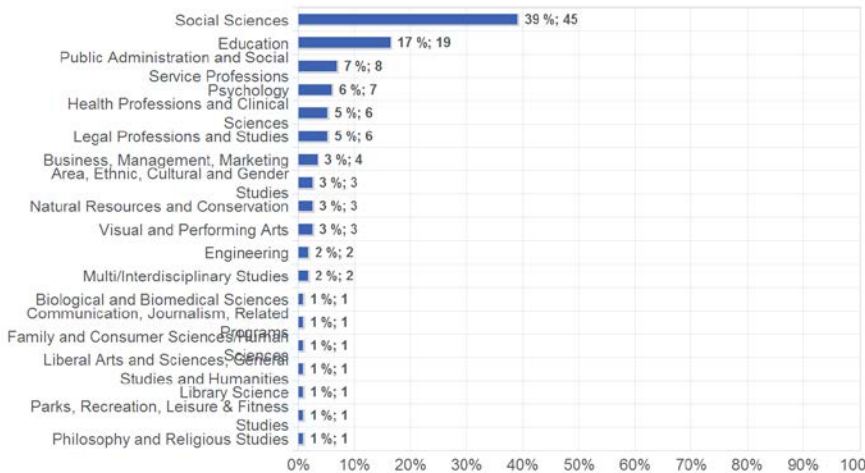

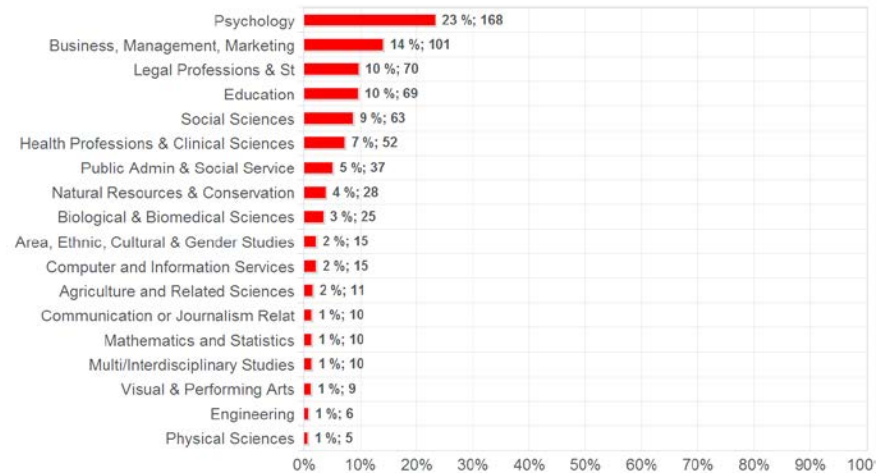
The vast majority (87%) of graduates with a Sociology BA plan to obtain either a Masters degree or PhD.

Most Popular Field of Future Academic Study



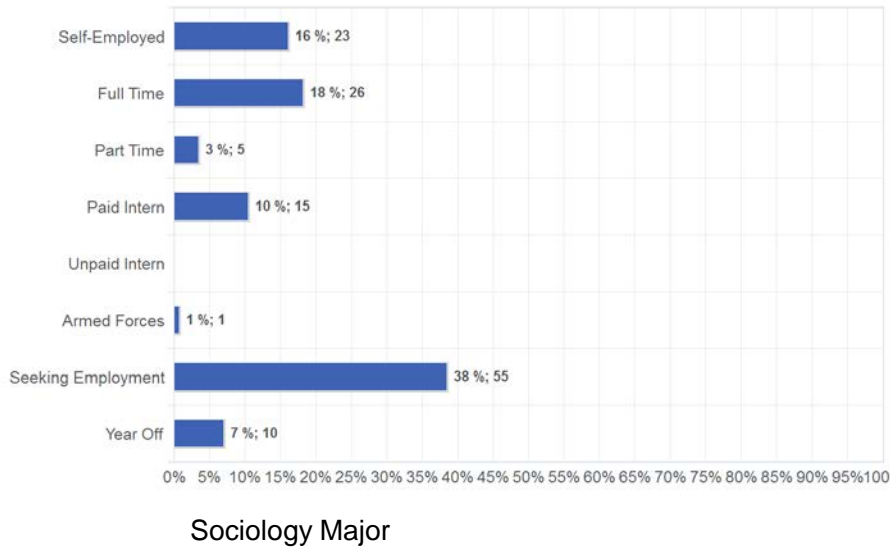

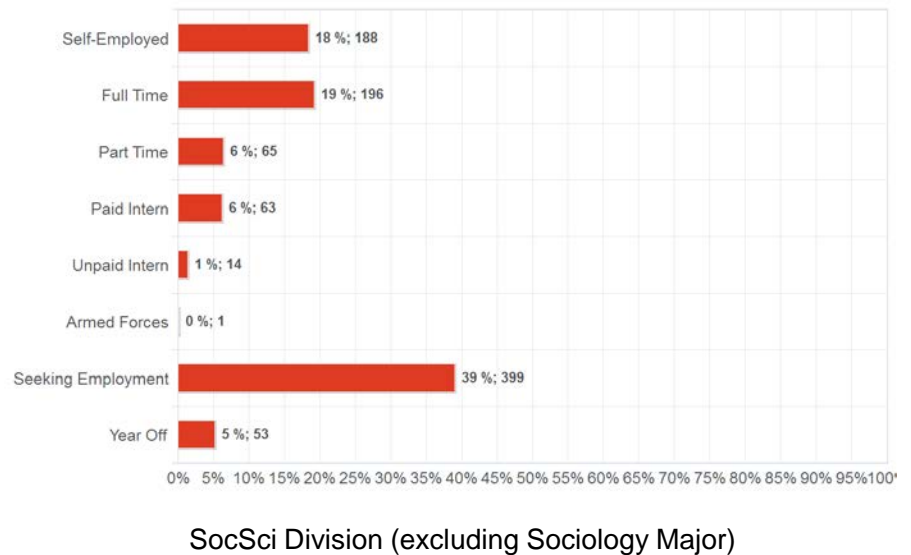

UCSC Sociology BA Graduates Employment Plans

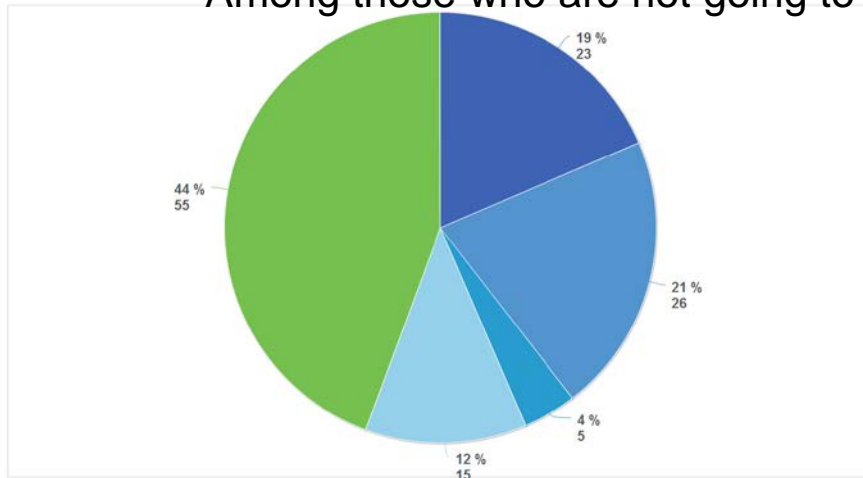


Nearly half (47%) of graduates with a BA degree in Sociology reported being employed within 6 months of graduation.

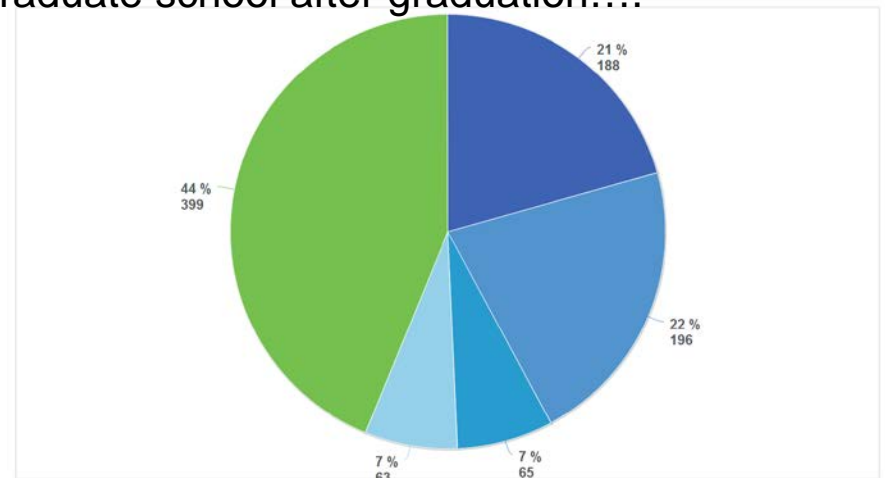


UCSC Sociology BA Graduates Employed vs Seeking Employment

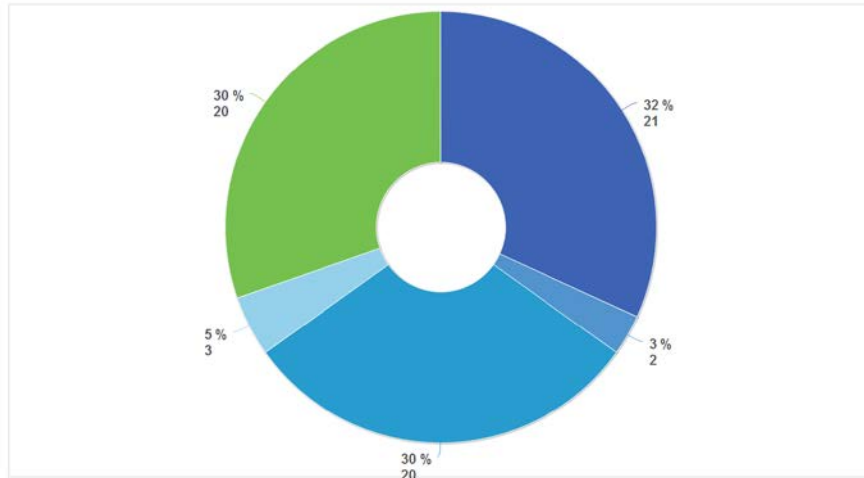

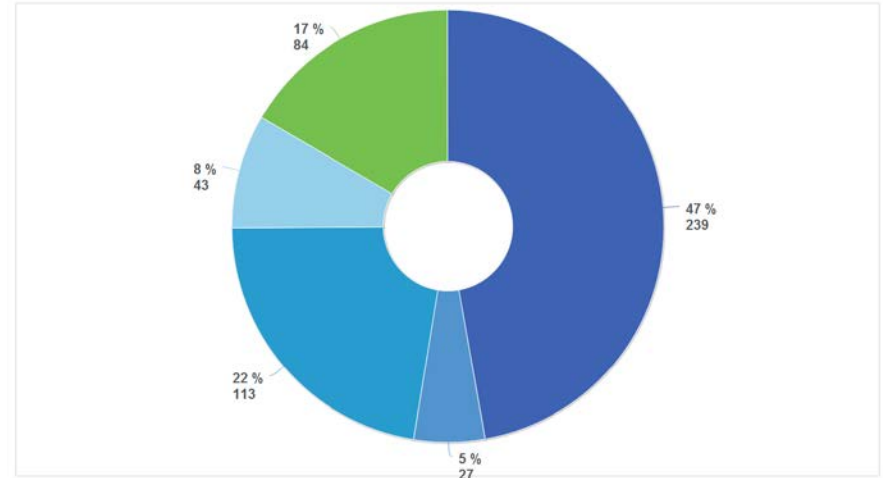
Six months after graduation, more Sociology BA graduates were employed than were seeking employment.

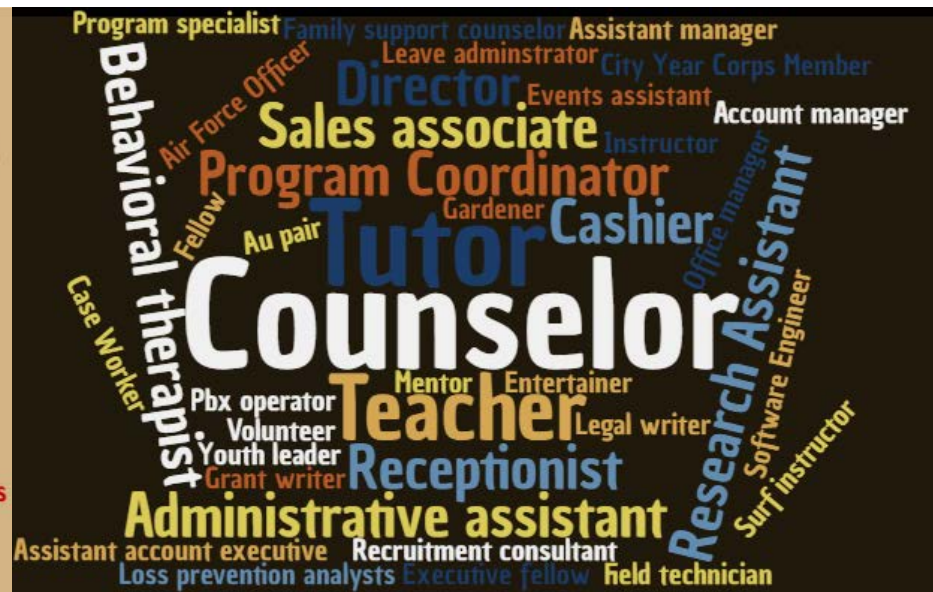

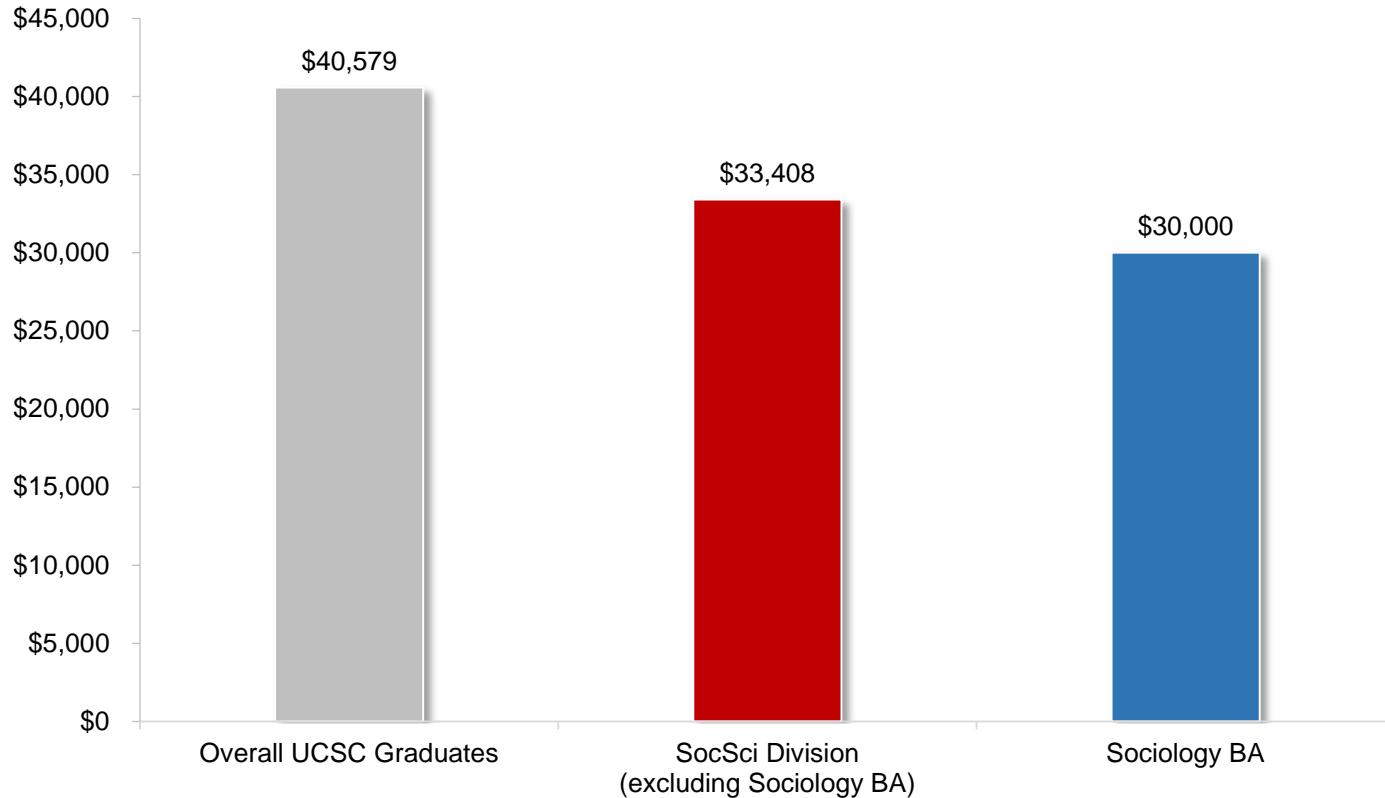

Employers & Job Titles

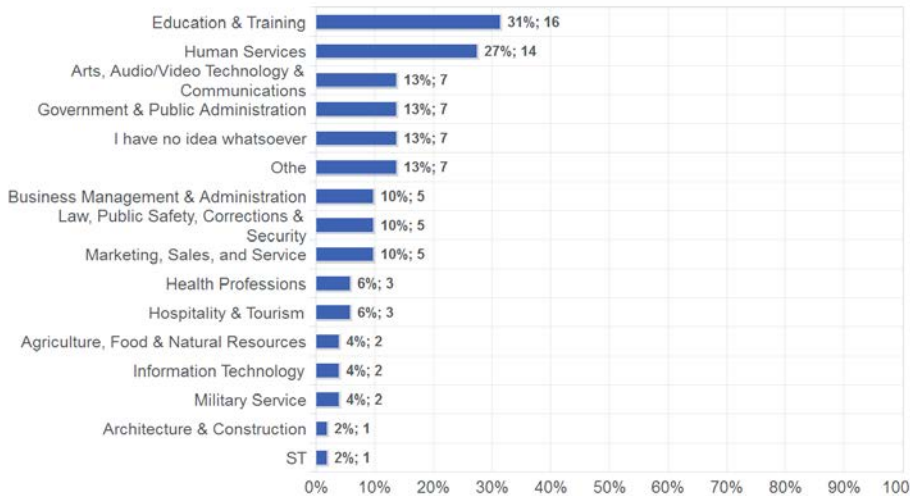


UCSC Sociology BA Graduates Median Annual Salary

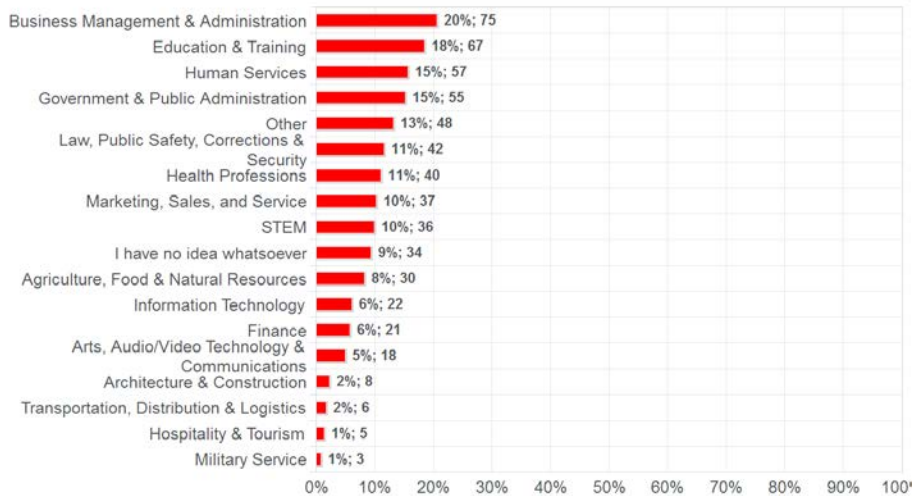


Fifty percent of graduates with a BA degree in Sociology reported earning \$30,000 annually or higher within 6 months of graduation.

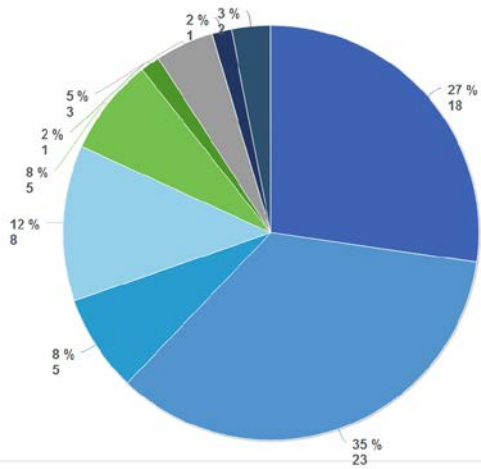

31% of Sociology BA graduates hoped to have a career in Education & Training after completing their education.

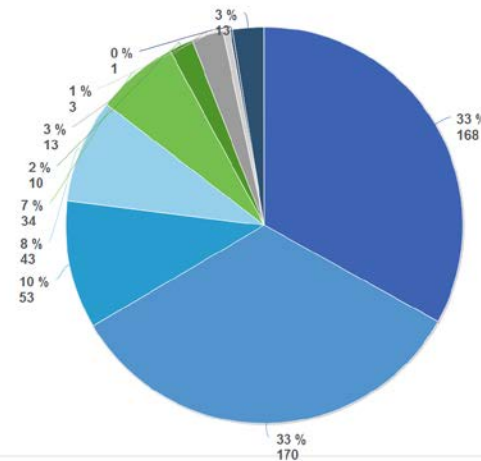
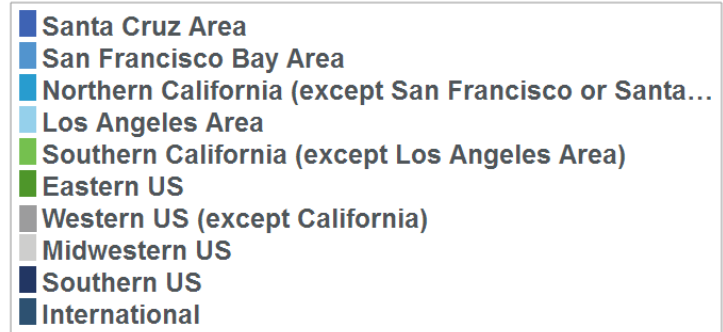

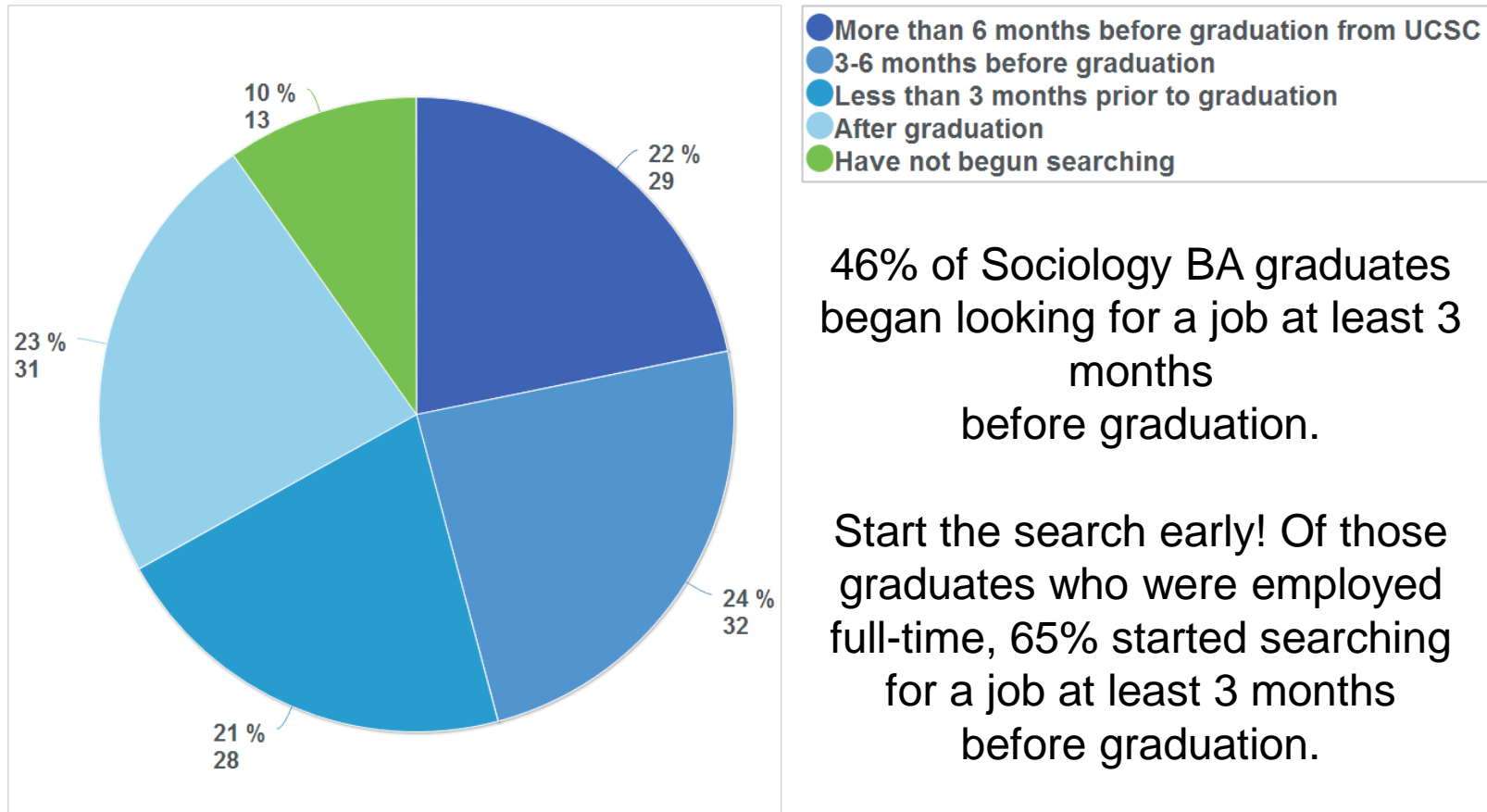
62% of Sociology BA graduates reported that they plan to work in the Santa Cruz or San Francisco Bay Area.

When did they start looking for a job? (employed & seeking employment)

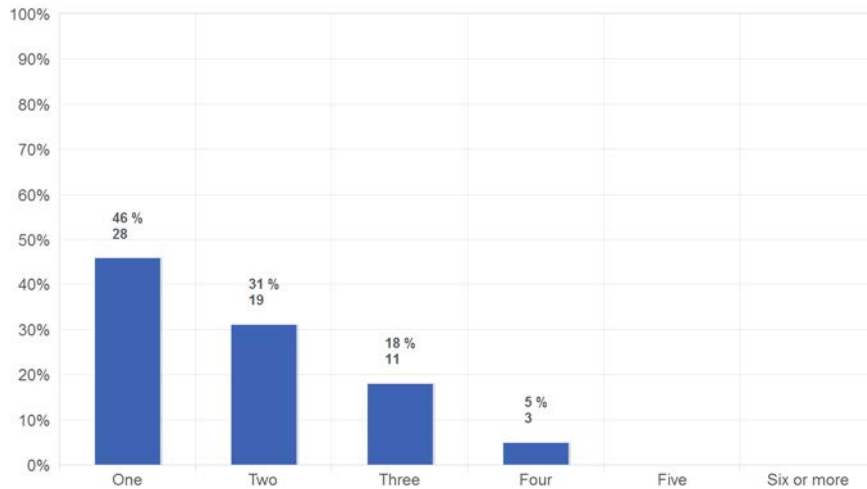


46% of Sociology BA graduates began looking for a job at least 3 months before graduation.

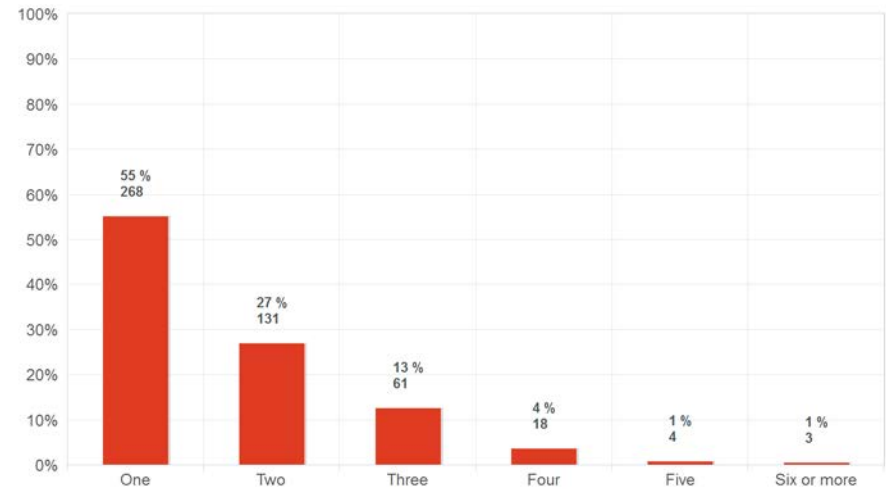
Start the search early! Of those graduates who were employed full-time, 65% started searching for a job at least 3 months before graduation.

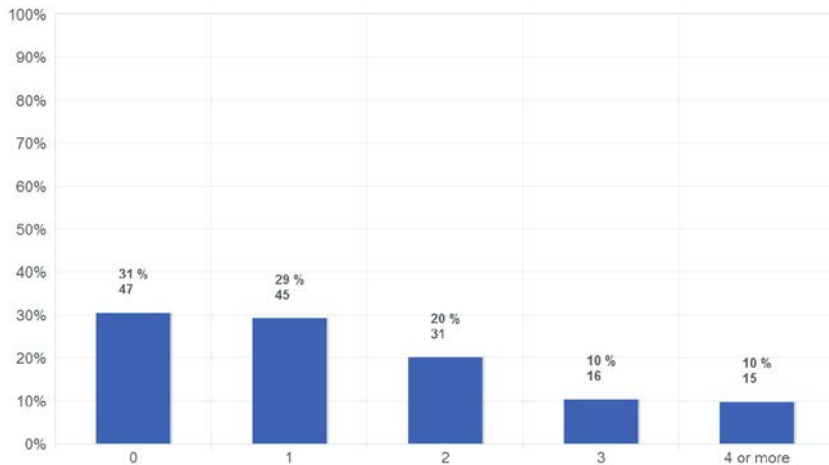
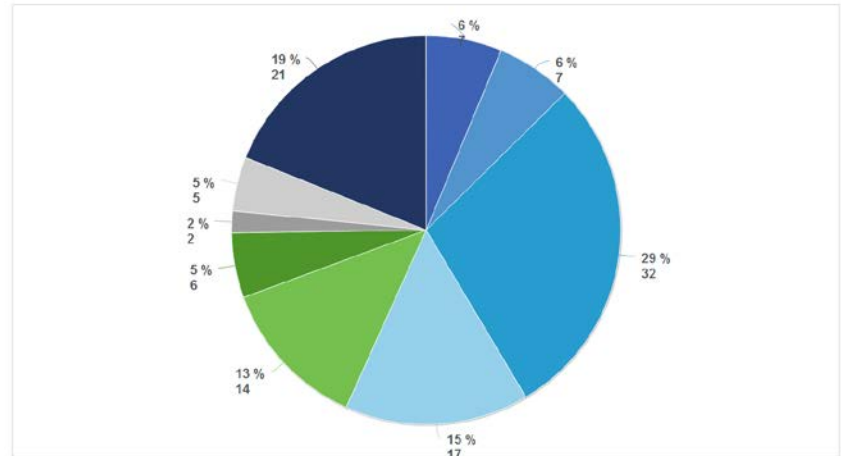


SocSci Division (excluding Sociology Major)

UCSC Sociology BA Graduates Internships

About half (44%) of graduates reported that they found their internship either through networking with UCSC or personal contacts.
