

The survey is being conducted at UC Santa Cruz and other UC campuses. At UC Santa Cruz, the survey has been held <u>every two years since 2007</u>, and since 2021 has been part of a systemwide survey titled the University of California Graduate Student Experience Survey (UCGSES).
