#### **Cover Letter and Statement of Consent**

## Welcome to the University of California Undergraduate Experience Survey! Please use a computer or tablet to complete the survey.

#### What is the UCUES survey?

The University of California Undergraduate Experience Survey is an online survey administered at UC Santa Cruz and each of the other undergraduate UC campuses. The survey is an important tool for better understanding undergraduates' experiences at UCSC, which will help faculty, campus leaders, and staff improve programs and services for students.

All UCSC undergraduates are invited to participate. UCUES data is used in aggregate form for many campus purposes, such as identifying obstacles to student success, providing student input into academic program reviews, and learning more about students' financial concerns. Survey response data may also be used at an aggregate level for academic research purposes after obtaining the appropriate IRB approval.

#### **Voluntary Participation**
