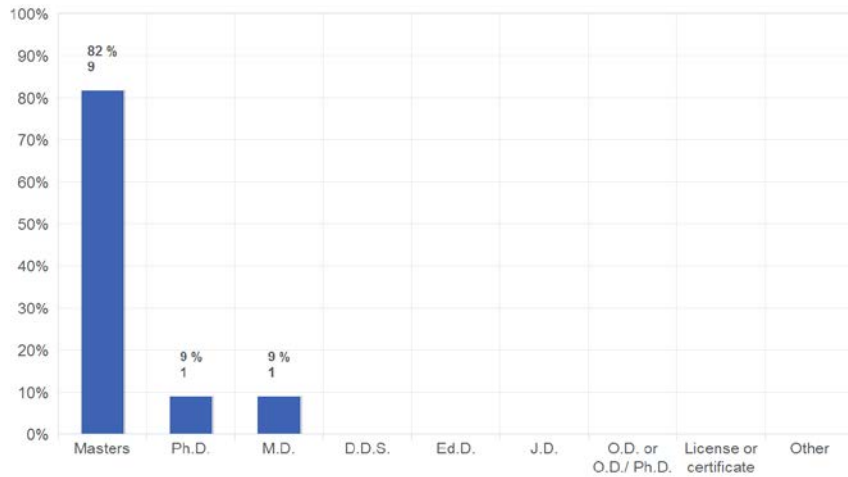

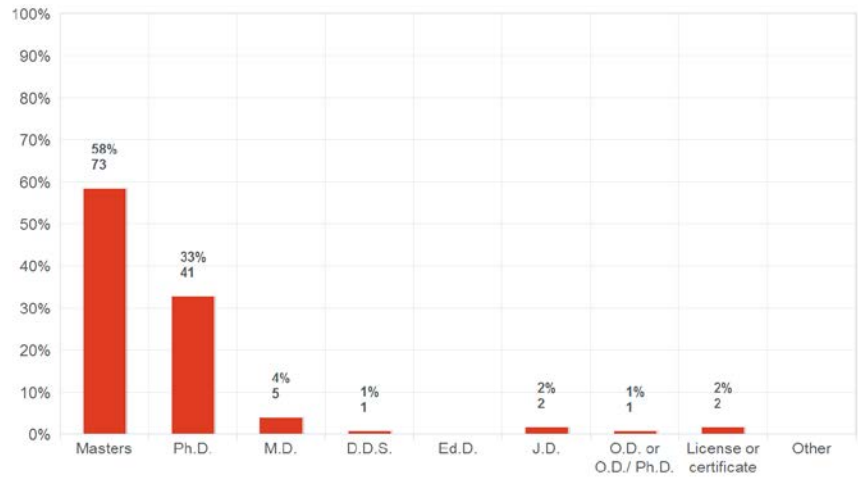
22% of CS Computer Game Design BS degree graduates had plans to pursue graduate education.

Types of Academic Degrees



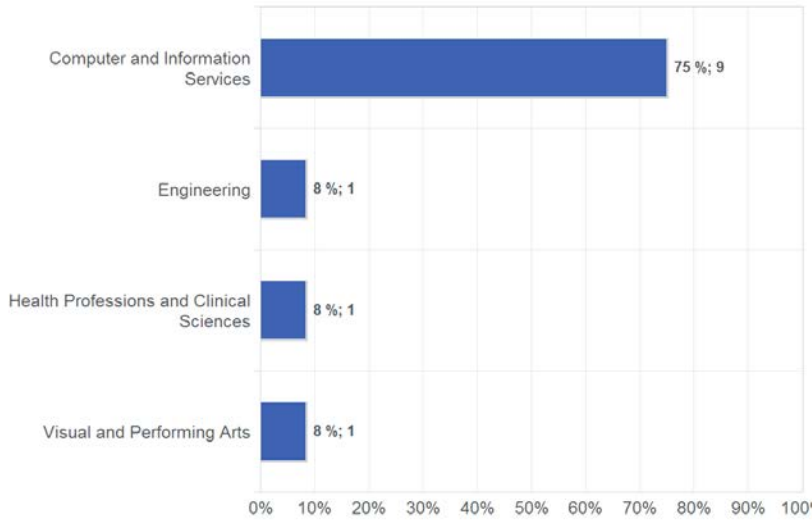

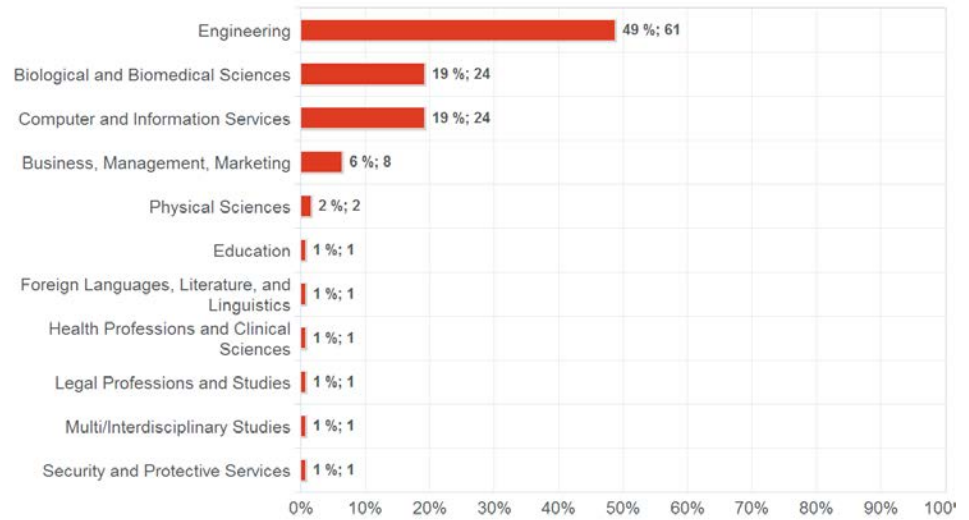

UCSC CS Computer Game Design BS Graduates Most Popular Field of Future Academic Study



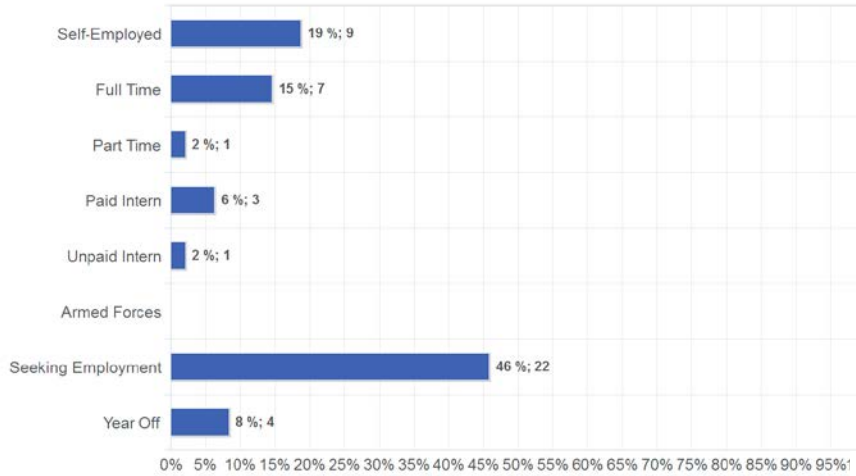

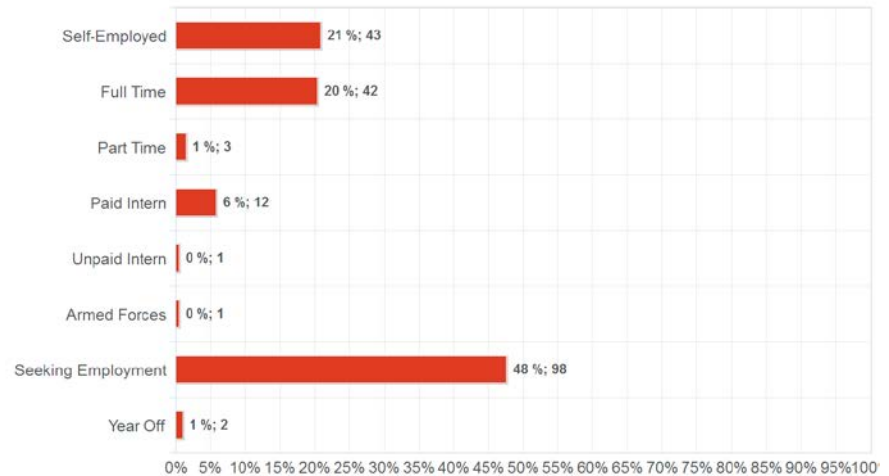
CS Computer Game Design BS graduates were interested in pursuing advanced degrees in several fields, the most popular of which was related to Computer & Information Services (75%).

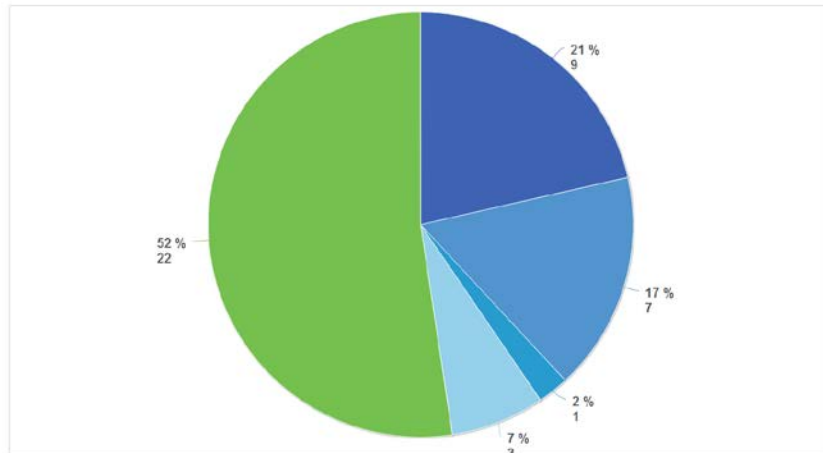
42% of graduates with a BS degree in CS Computer Game Design reported being employed within 6 months of graduation.



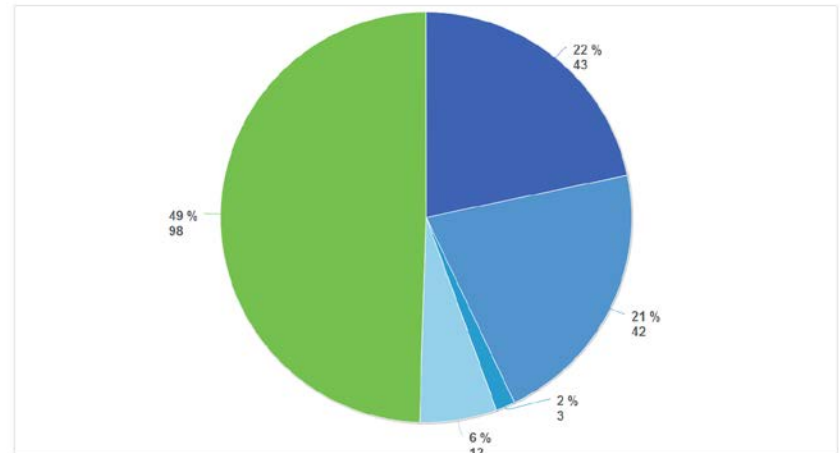

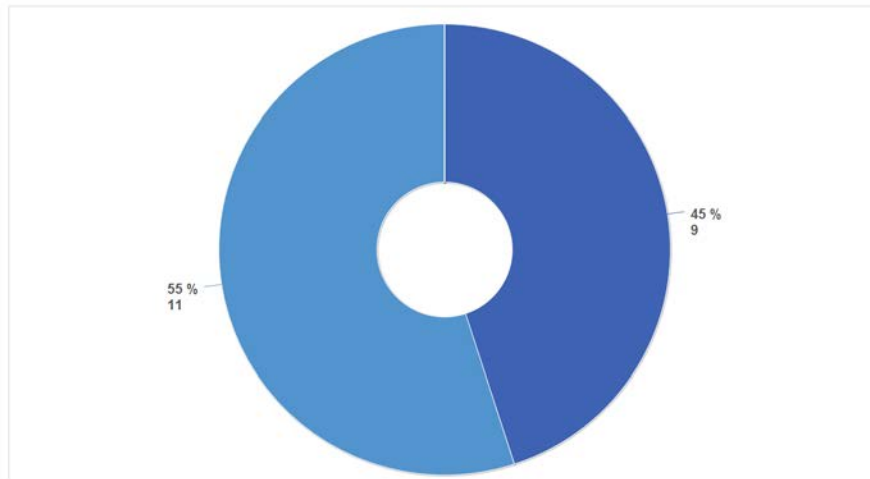

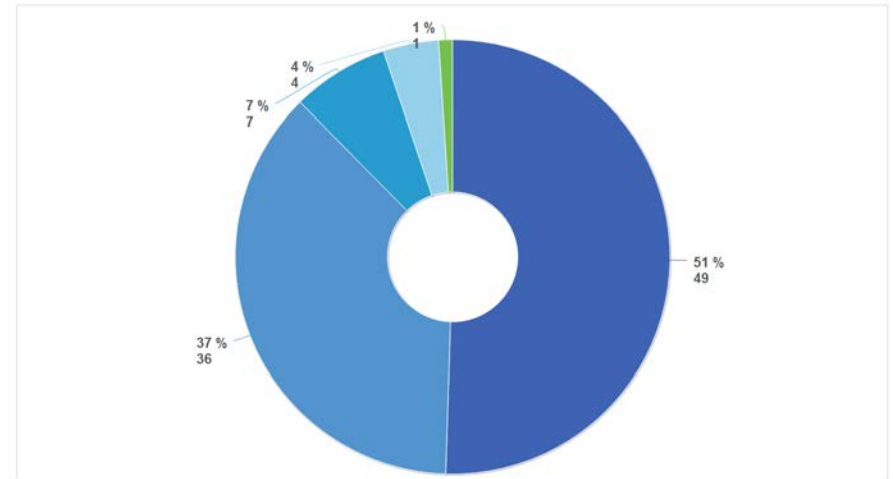
Almost half (47%) of BA graduates reported being employed than seeking employment within 6 months of graduation.

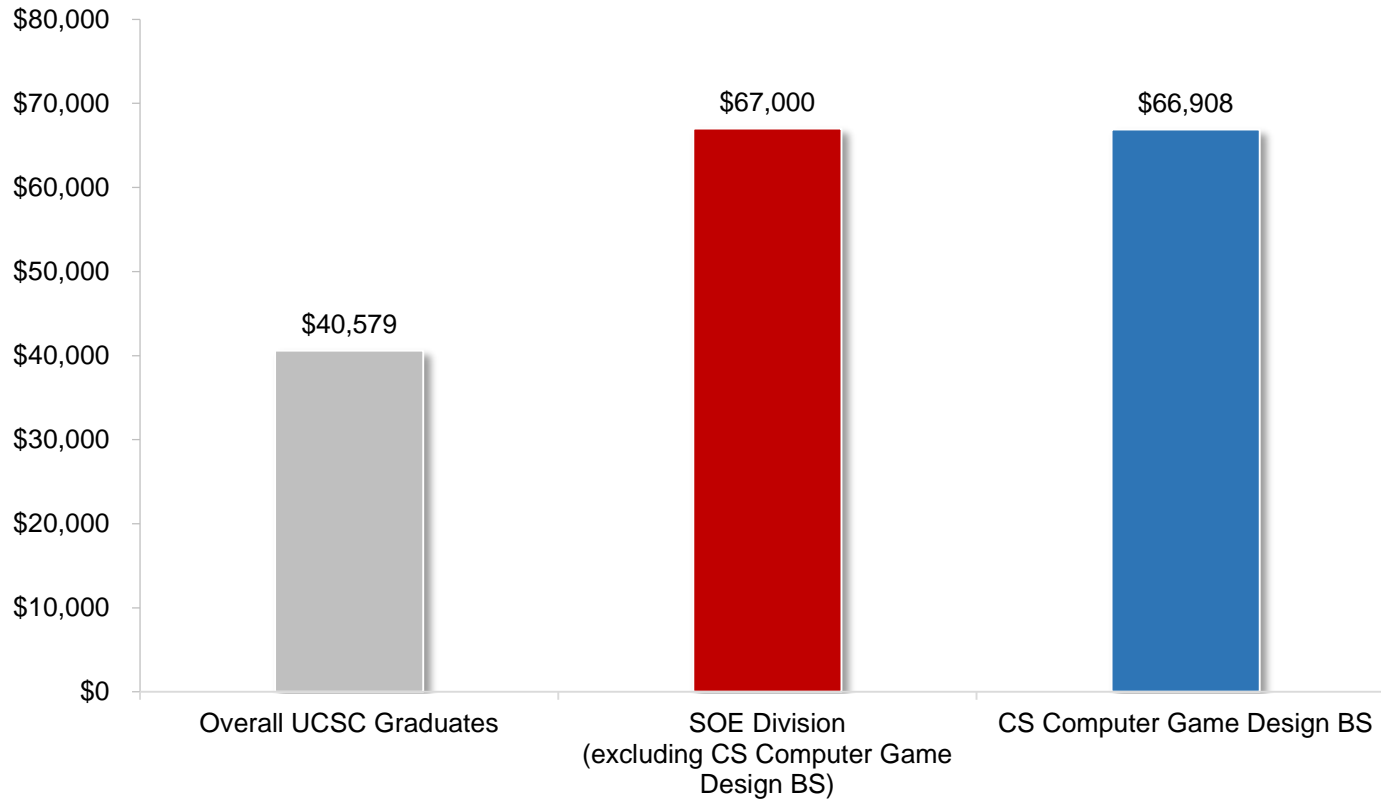

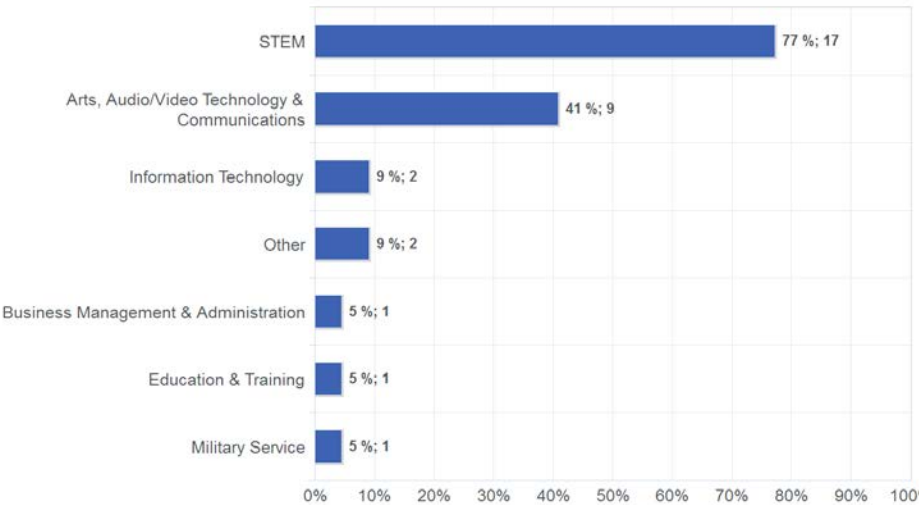


UCSC CS Computer Game Design BS Graduates Median Annual Salary

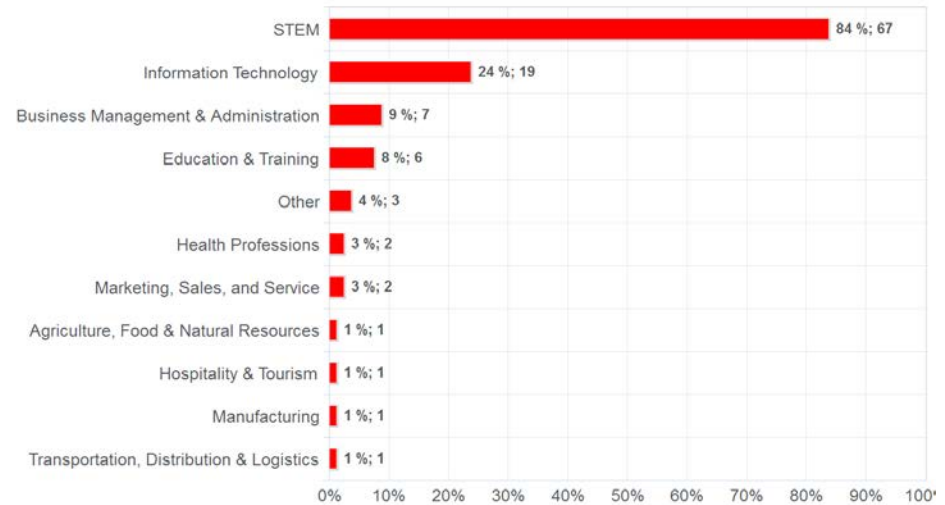


Fifty percent of graduates with a BS degree in CS Computer Game Design reported earning \$66,908 annually or higher within 6 months of graduation.

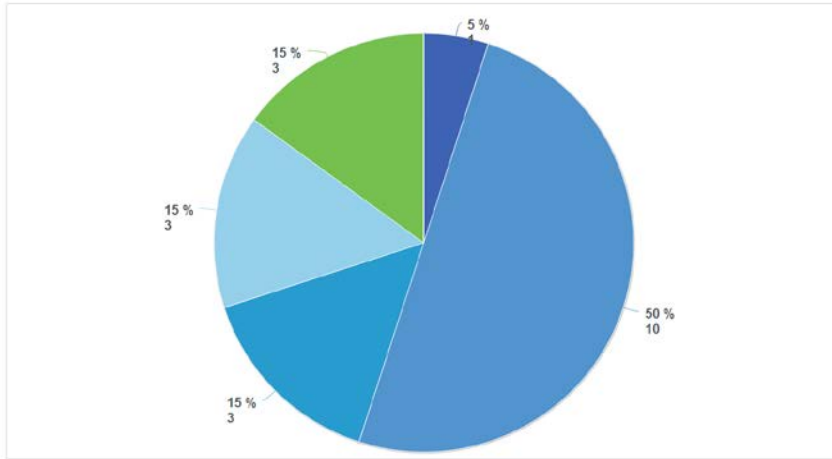

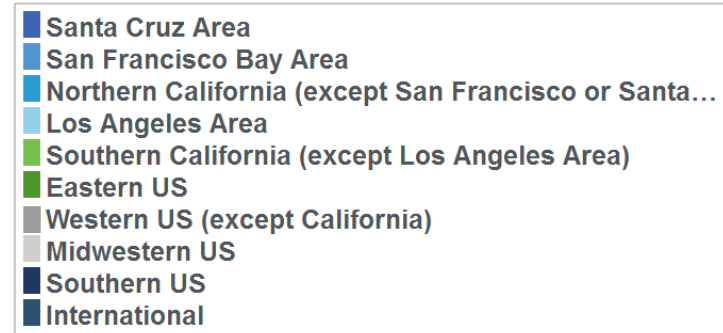
The majority (77%) of CS Computer Game Design BS graduates hoped to have a career in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, & Math) after completing their education.

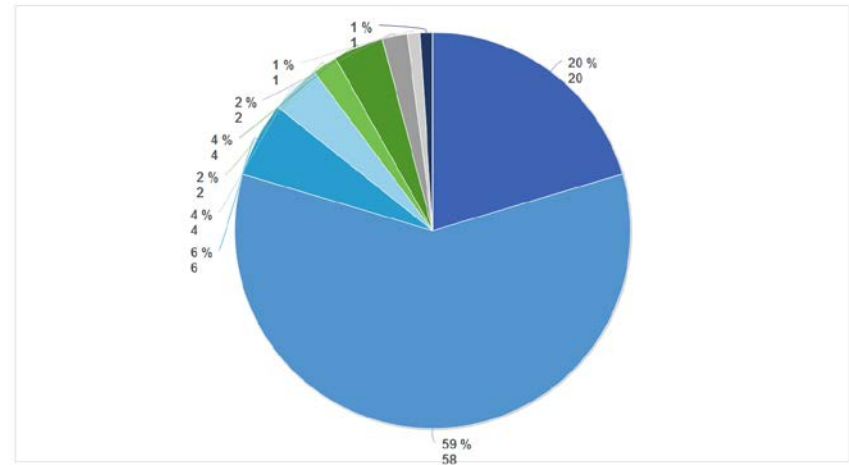
Geographic destinations of those with a job

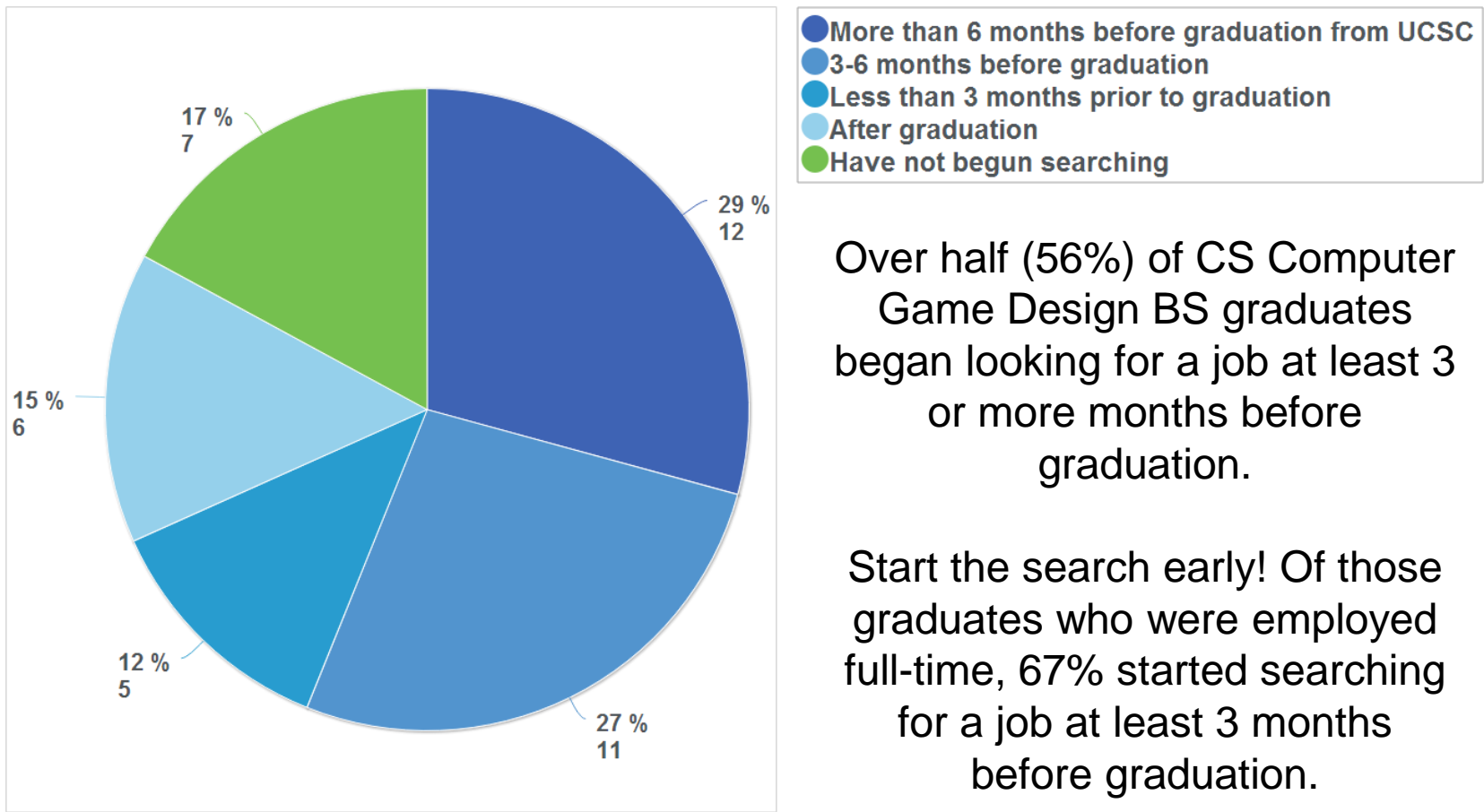
Half (50%) of CS Computer Game Design BS graduates reported that they plan to work in the San Francisco Bay Area.

When did they start looking for a job? (employed & seeking employment)

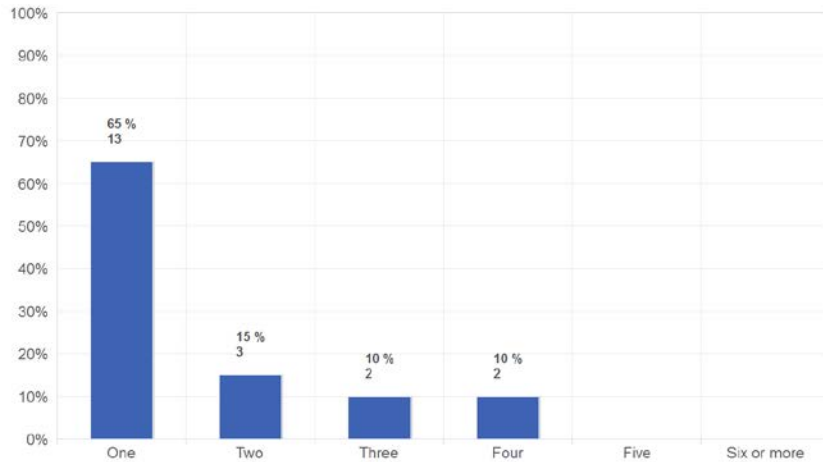


Over half (56%) of CS Computer Game Design BS graduates began looking for a job at least 3 or more months before graduation.

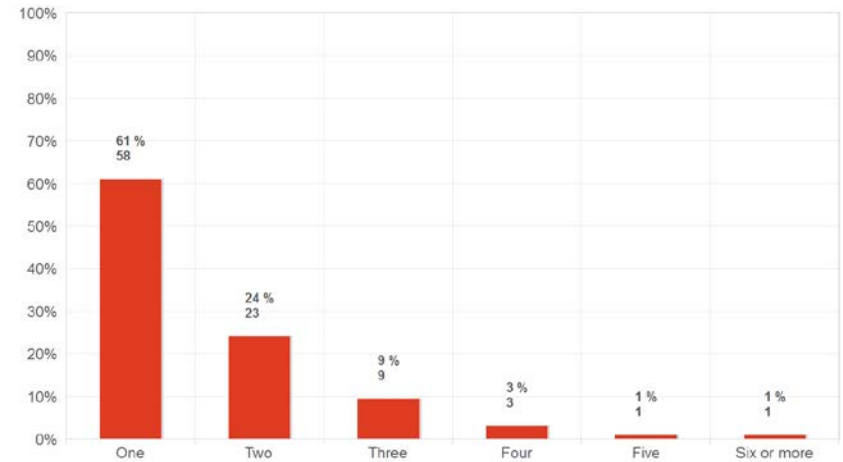
Start the search early! Of those graduates who were employed full-time, 67% started searching for a job at least 3 months before graduation.

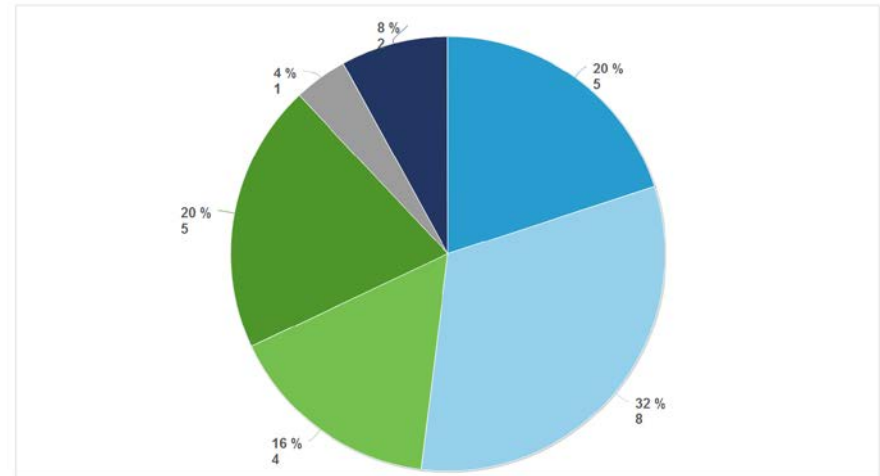

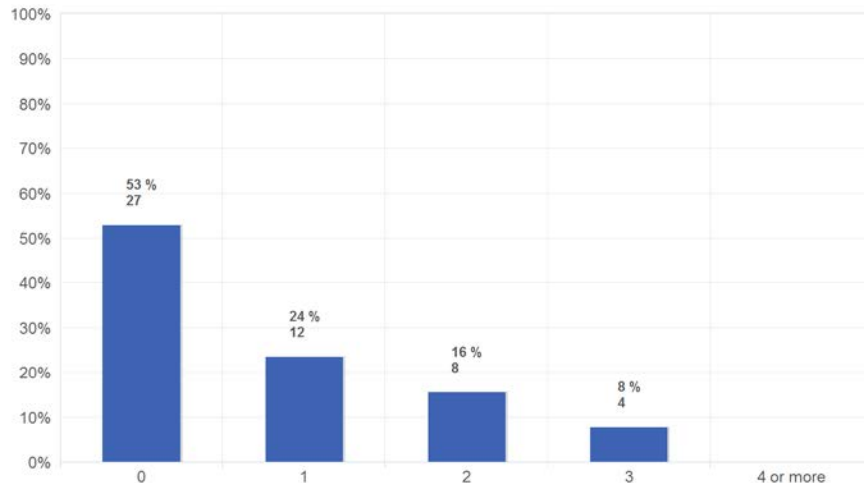
Of those employed, 35% of graduates with a BS degree in CS Computer Game Design received multiple job offers.
