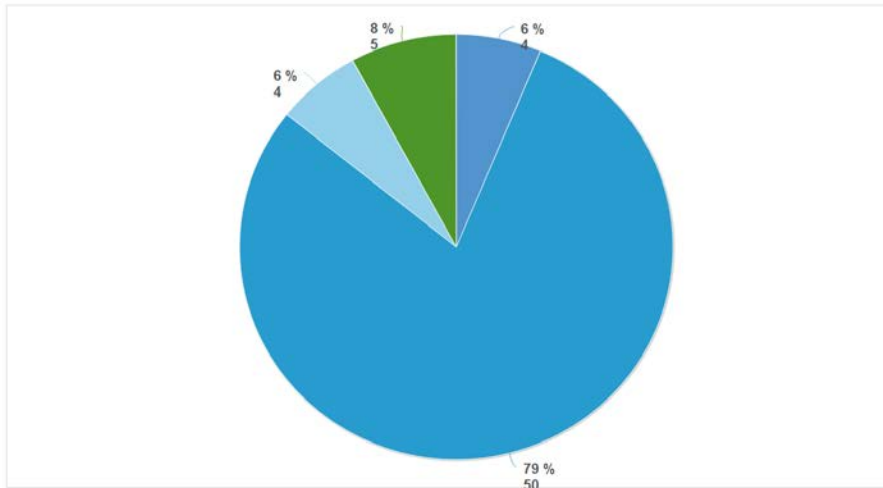
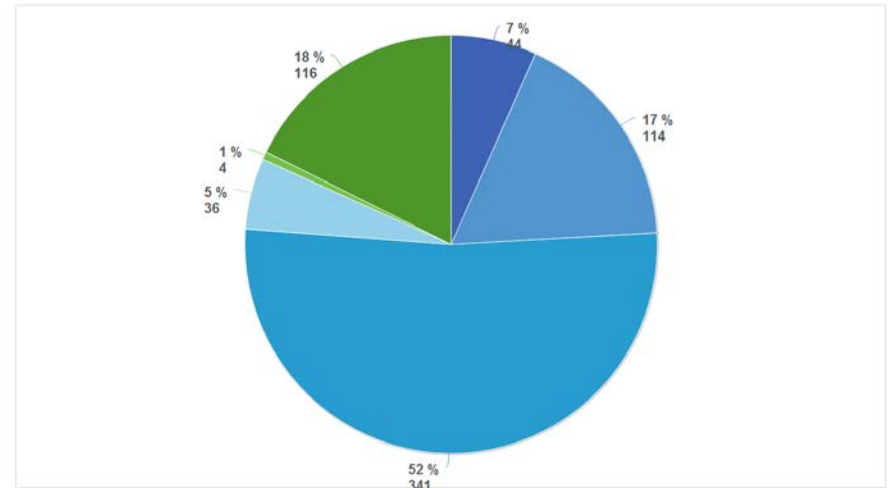


# UCSC Human Biology BS Graduates Academic Plans for Graduate Studies

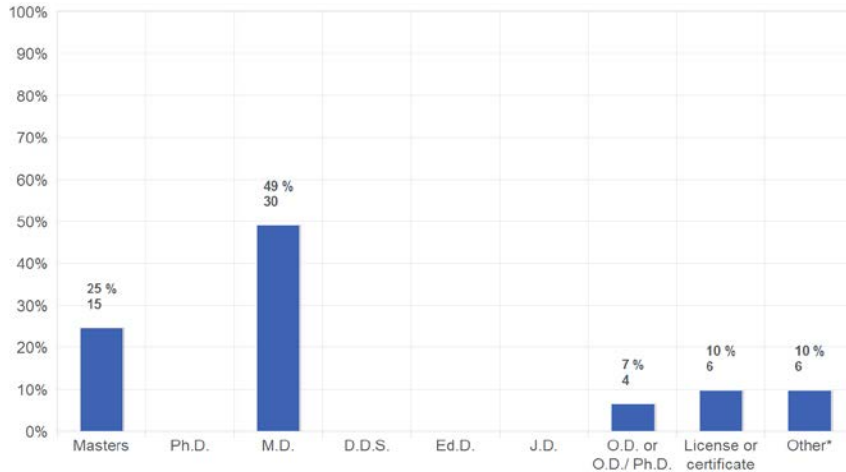

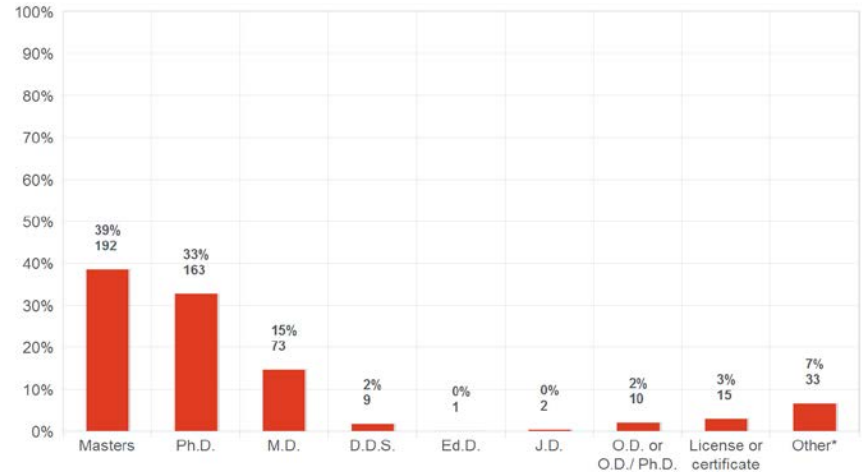
Nearly all (93%) of Human Biology BS degree graduates had plans to pursue graduate education.

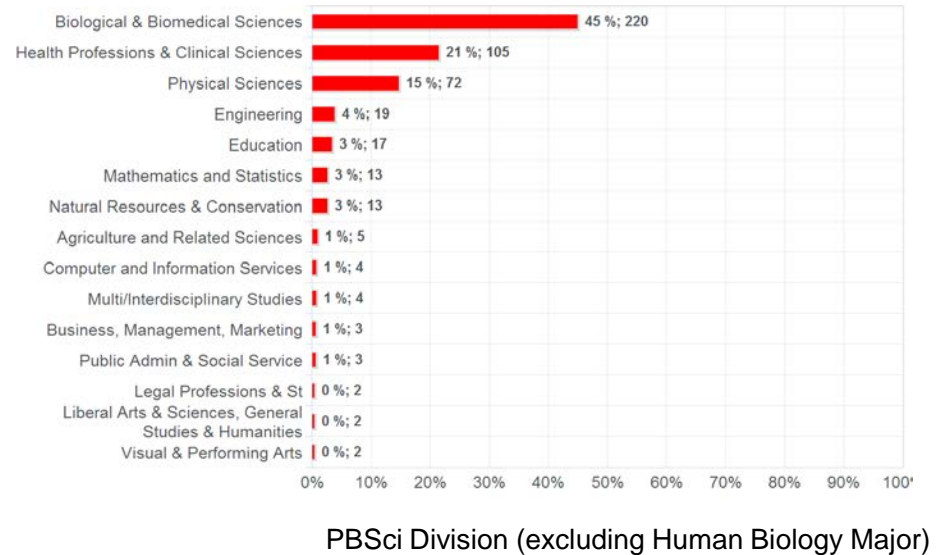
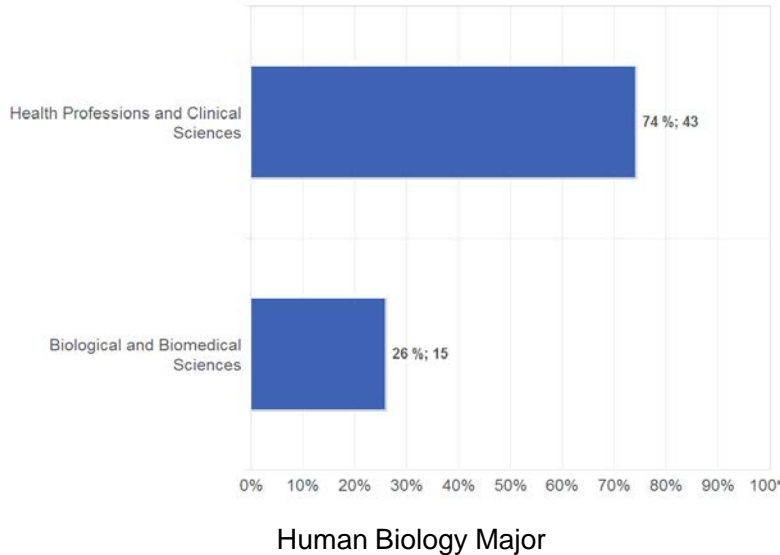

The majority (74%) of graduates with a Human Biology Major plan to obtain either a Masters degree or a MD.

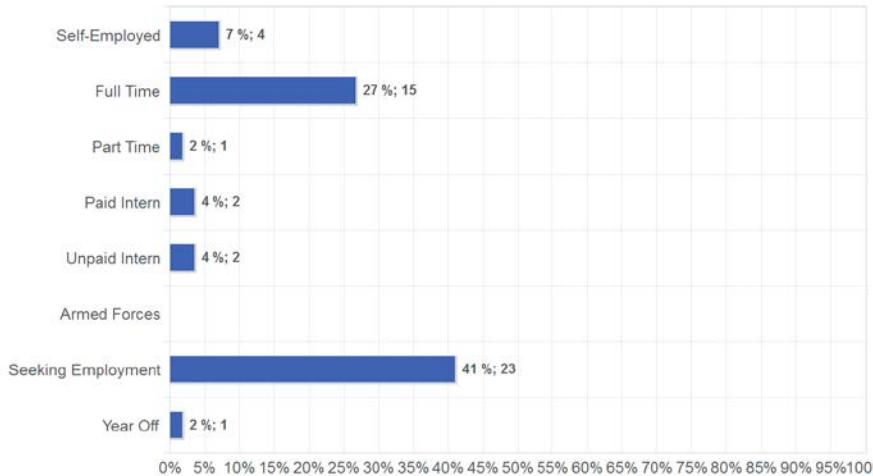
# UCSC Human Biology BS Graduates

## Most Popular Field of Future Academic Study



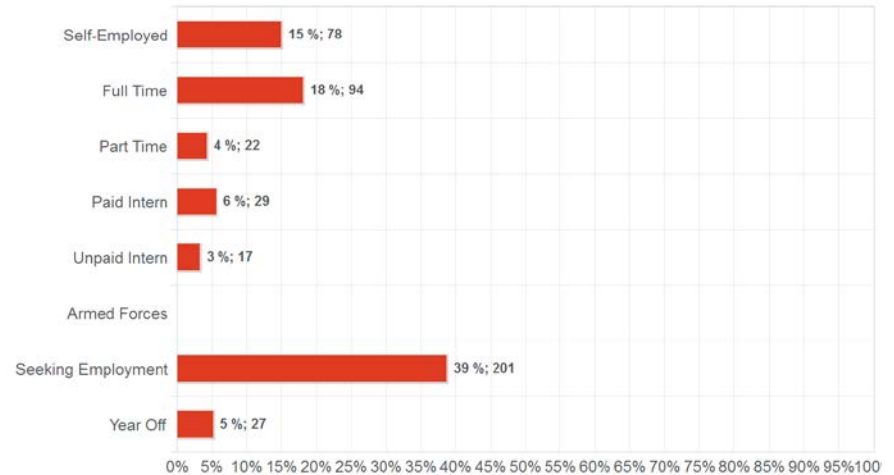

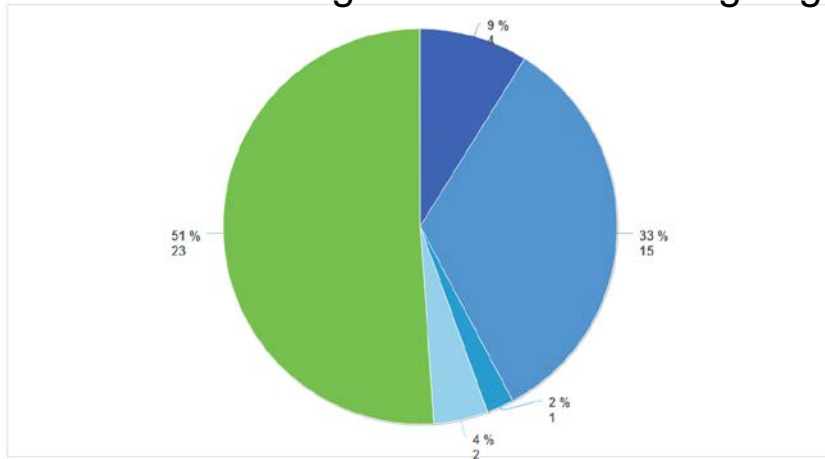
Over a third (40%) of graduates with a BS degree in Human Biology reported being employed within 6 months of graduation.



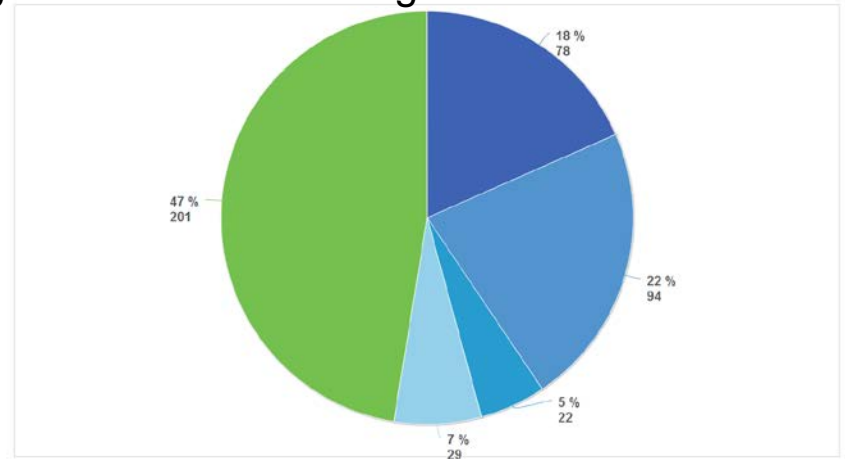

# UCSC Human Biology BS Graduates Employed vs Seeking Employment

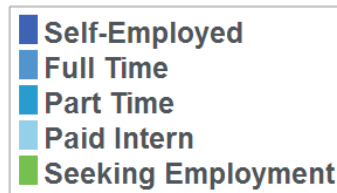
Among those who are not going to graduate school after graduation....

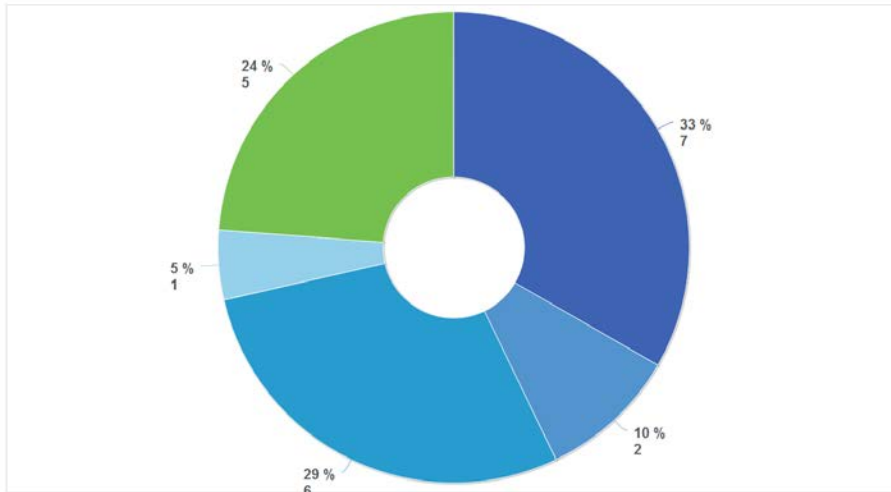

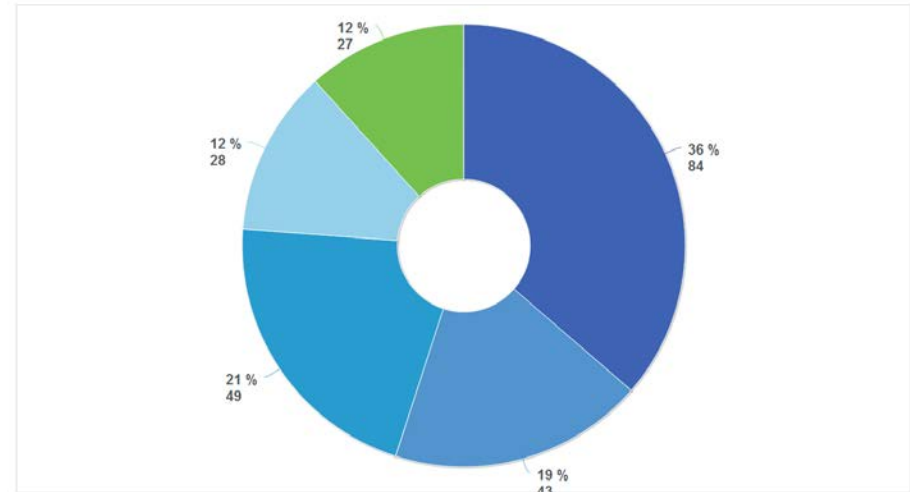


Six months after graduation, roughly the same number of Human Biology BS graduates were employed as were seeking employment.

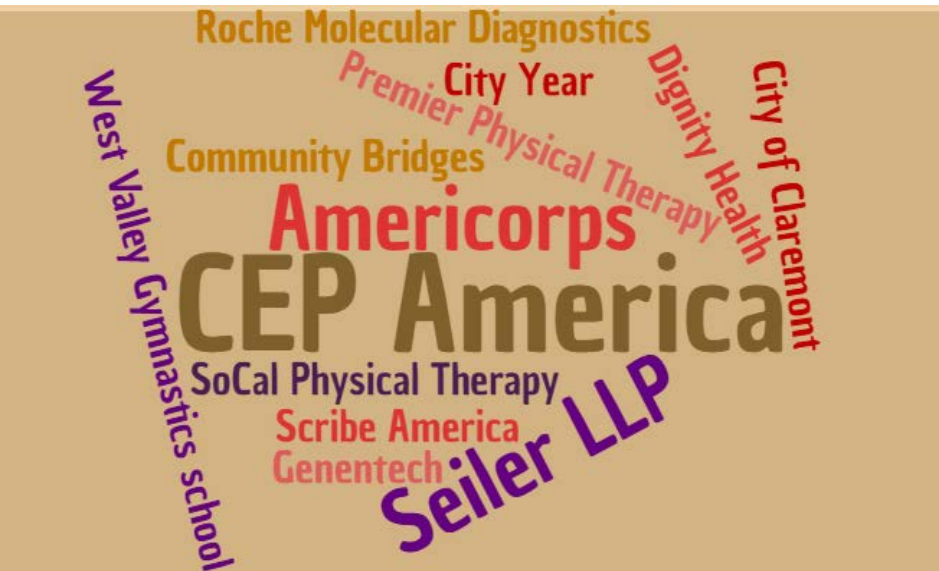

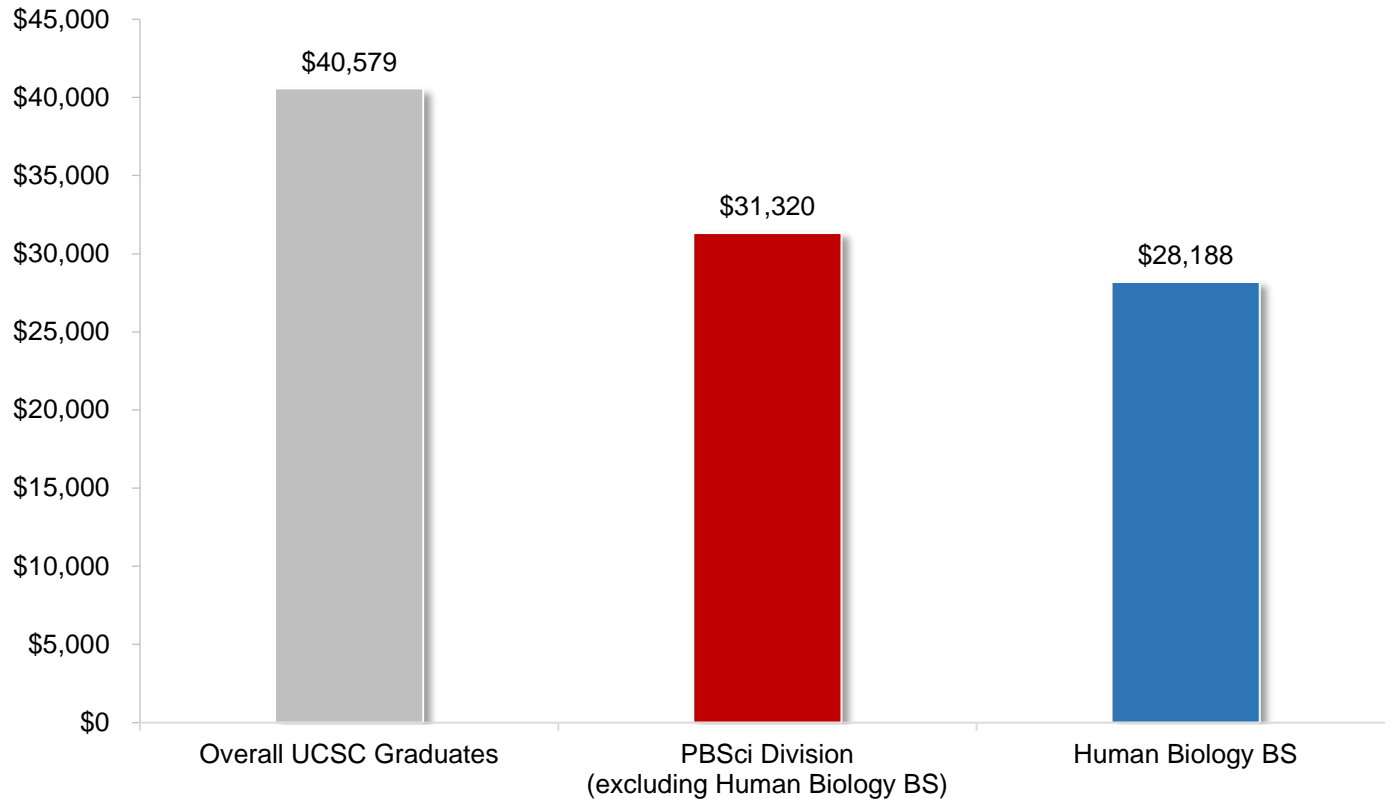


Of those employed, over half (62%) of Human Biology BS graduates reported working in the Business (33%) or Education (29%) sector within 6 months of graduation.

# UCSC Human Biology BS Graduates Median Annual Salary

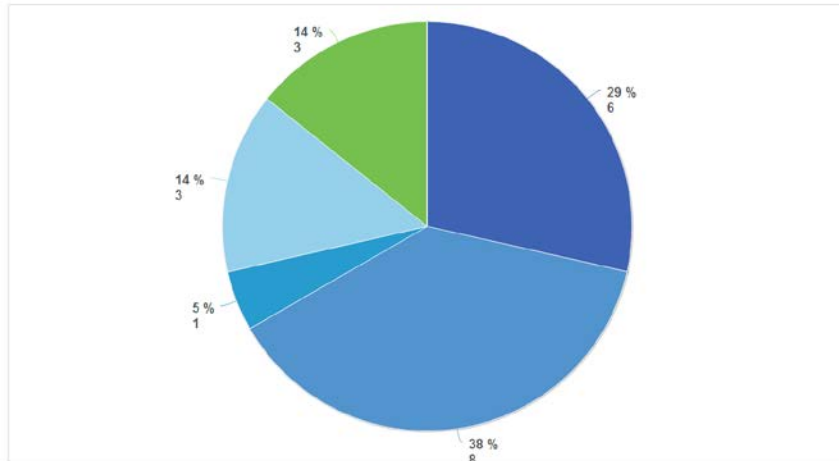


Fifty percent of graduates with a BS degree in Human Biology reported earning \$28,188 annually or higher within 6 months of graduation.



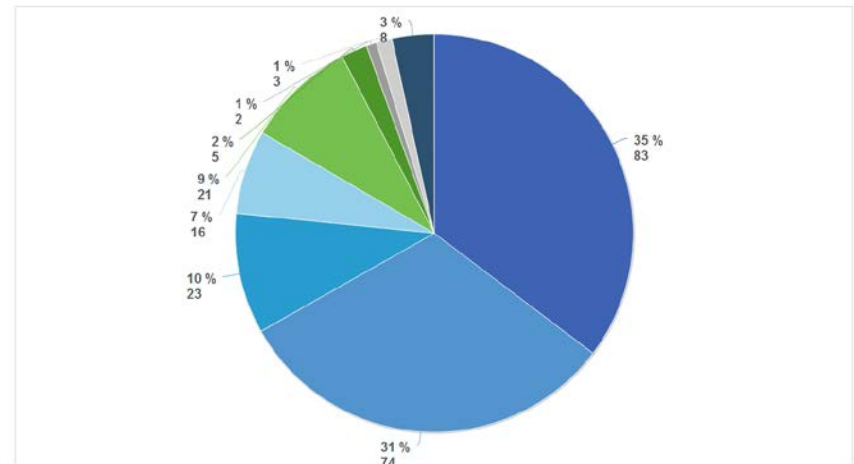
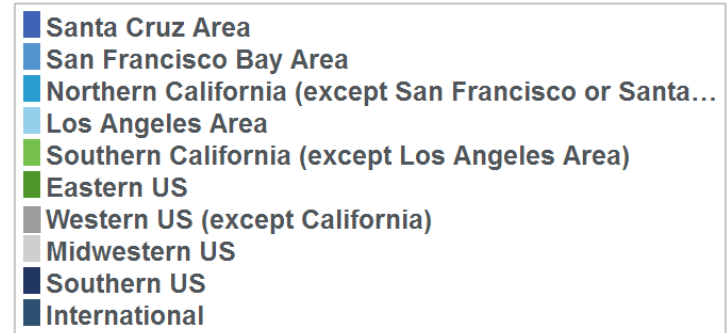

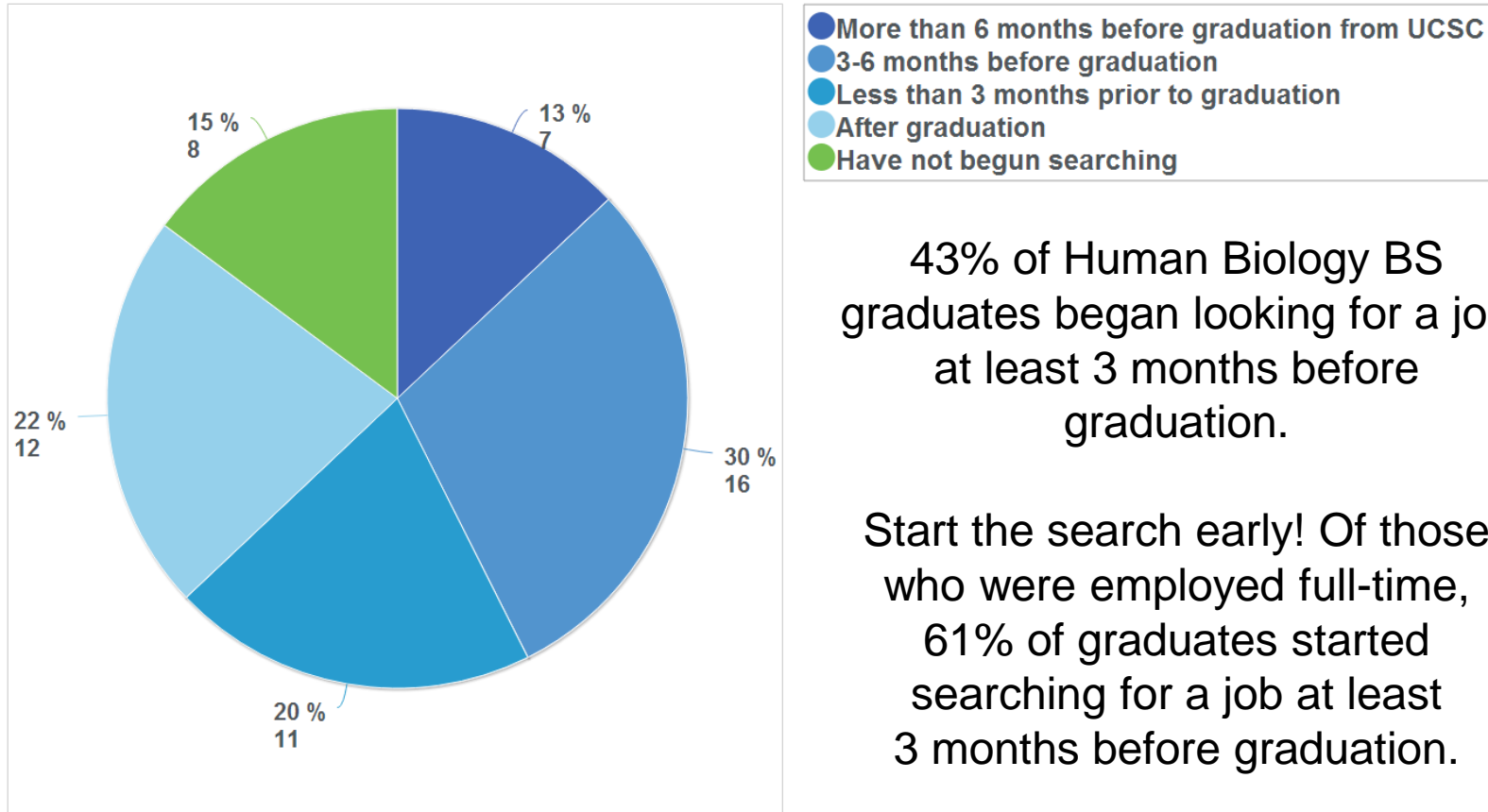
Two-thirds of Human Biology BS graduates plan to work in the Santa Cruz or San Francisco Bay Area.



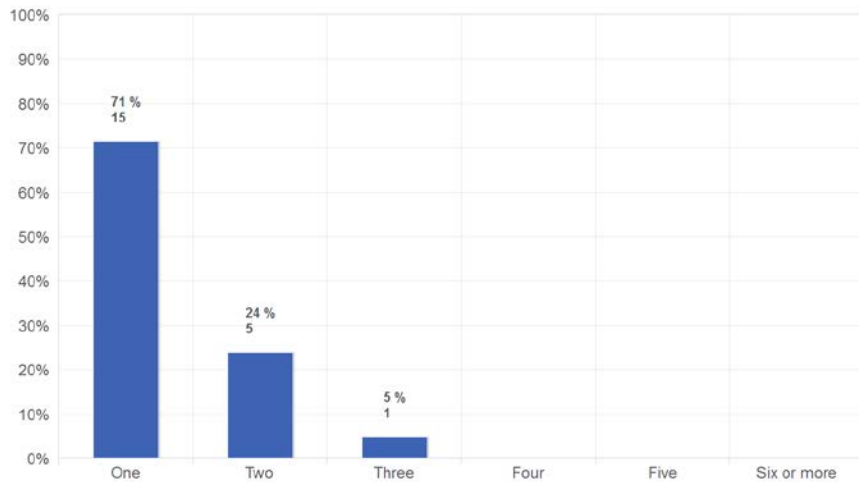

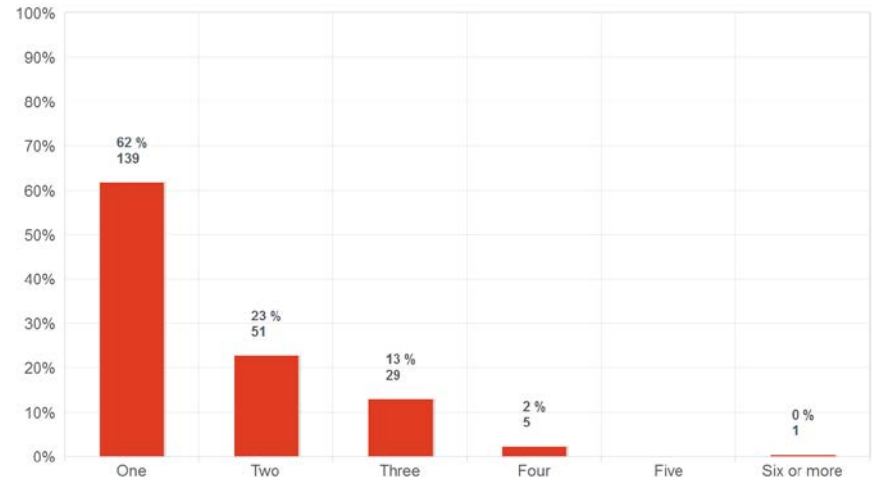
When did they start looking for a job? (employed & seeking employment)

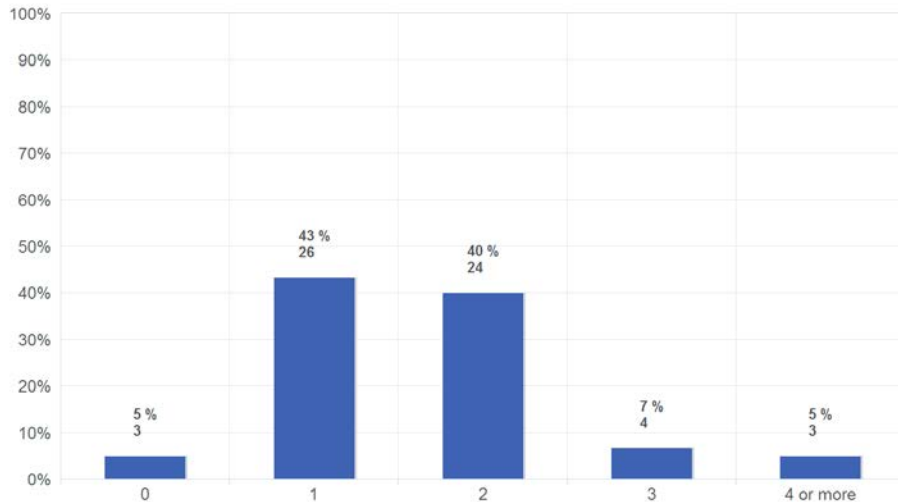
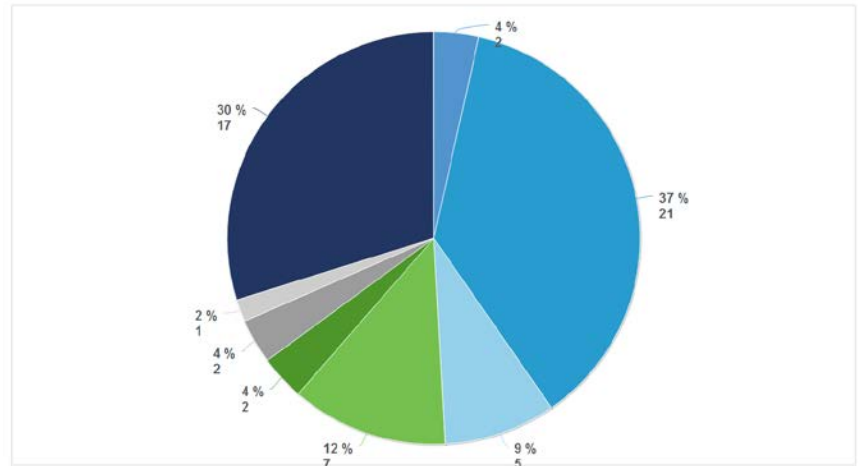
